## Storylines for the Season

\* The 2012 Season marks the 25th Anniversary of the 1987 CWS Champion team. During Memorial Day Weekend against Cal, which is coached by former champion shortstop David Esquer, the Cardinal will host the players from both the 1987 and 1988 teams in a pregame ceremony on Saturday. Dinner will follow.

\* The heavily dominant junior class features three potential first round picks, according to Baseball America, in projected No. 1 pick RHP Mark Appel, two-year starting infielder Kenny Diekroeger (No. 6) and Cape Cod Batting Champion 3B Stephen Piscotty (No. 36). The other high potential junior picks include LHP Brett Mooneyham (9-10 record in two years as a starter), two-sport standout Tyler Gaffney (.327 career average) and one of the nation's top defensive outfielders in Jake Stewart (.249 in 100 career games)

\* The Cardinal returns seven everyday starters to a team that reached the Super Regionals in 2011. The front end of the rotation will feature 2010 strikeout leader LHP Brett Mooneyham (9-10, 4.67 ERA) and potential No. 1 pick RHP Mark Appel (6-7, 3.02 ERA).

\* The outfield will be the same for the second-straight year in Tyler Gaffney (LF), Jake Stewart (CF) and Austin Wilson (RF). The infield could also remain similar in Stephen Piscotty (3B), Kenny Diekroeger (SS), Lonnie Kauppila (2B) and Brian Ragira (1B).

\* The team will have to find a closer after first round pick Chris Reed (6-2, 9 saves, 2.56 ERA) was drafted by the Dodgers. Two of the team's last three closers have been first round picks (Drew Storen is currently the closer for the Nationals after getting drafted in 2009). The bullpen also lost reliable arms LHP Scott Snodgrass and RHP Danny Sandbrink to the draft as well. Dean McArdle and Brian Busick are both former starters, while LHP John Hochstatter, LHP Spenser Linney and RHP David Schmidt are the freshmen

\* After four-year starter Zach Jones (three at catcher) was drafted following graduation, Stanford needs a new catcher. Some potential candidates included converted infielder Eric Smith, Christian Griffiths, who missed last year with a shoulder injury, junior backup Trevor Penny and Houston freshman Wayne Taylor, a 14th round pick.

\* The team's non-conference home schedule features Vanderbilt, Rice and Texas after the Cardinal visited all three last year. Utah joins the Pac-12 and makes it an 11-team league.
