SHOWDOWN SATURDAY AS NATION'S TOP FOUR COLLIDE



CALIFORNIA (14-2 Overall, 2-0 MPSF) received three goals apiece from Luka and Aleksa Saponjic in last Saturday's 14-6 decision at Long Beach State. Justin Parsons collected 10 saves in the cage. Friday, a 4-1 third quarter was the difference at UCLA en route to an 8-5 win. Zach Greenwood and Ivan Rackov each scored twice while Parsons had 11 saves. Saturday's showdown against USC is the lone game of the week for the Bears.



USC (11-2 Overall, 2-0 MPSF) posted a pair of dominant home wins last week over Long Beach State (14-3) in MPSF play and Loyola Marymount (13-3). Kostas Genidounias' hat trick led a group of 10 scorers vs. the Lions. Six players scored two apiece vs. the 49ers. The Trojans visit California Saturday (Oct. 15) in a battle of MPSF unbeatens. This is the first meeting between the two teams since the national championship game last year.



STANFORD (9-2 overall, 2-0 MPSF) won two conference games at home, 9-5 over Pepperdine and 6-5 over UC Santa Barbara. Sunday, the Cardinal came back from a 4-2 halftime deficit to the Gauchos, allowing just one second half goal. Jacob Smith scored the second of his two goals with four seconds left in regulation, following his steal with 30 seconds left. Ryan Kent netted a hat trick vs. the Waves. No. 1 Stanford hosts UCLA Saturday.



UCLA (11-3 Overall, 1-1 MPSF) split a pair of MPSF contests to begin conference play, falling at home to Cal (8-5) before bouncing back at UC Irvine (18-6). Josh Samuels nailed a shot from beyond half tank vs. Cal. Brett Hays, Paul Reynolds, and Griffin White scored hat tricks in the road win Sunday, as the Bruins accumulated their highest scoring effort in an MPSF game since 1994. UCLA prepares for visits to top-ranked Stanford and Santa Clara.



UC IRVINE (12-7 Overall, 0-2 MPSF) head coach Marc Hunt picked up his 100th career win following a 19-1 outcome over Occidental Saturday at La Verne. The Anteaters also dominated Whittier, 21-4. Mitch Wise combined for nine goals in the two wins, including a career-high tying six vs. OXY. Trent Baxter posted a hat trick in each game. MPSF action continues at home Friday against Pepperdine.



PACIFIC (9-5 Overall, 0-0 MPSF) doubled up at nearby opponent UC Davis, 10-5 last Friday, a game in which the Tigers never trailed. Balazs Erdelyi and Goran Tomasevic each recorded a hat trick, as the former chipped in his eighth consecutive multi-goal outing. Alex Malkis picked up 10 saves in goal, holding the Aggies to their lowest scoring output of the year. The Tigers' MPSF opener is Sunday (Oct. 16) at Pepperdine.



UC SANTA BARBARA (11-6 Overall, 0-1 MPSF) came within seconds of taking No. 1 Stanford to overtime in its MPSF opener Sunday. Eric Van De Mortel was the leading Gaucho scorer with two goals, the second of which put his team up 5-4 with just 2:03 remaining. UCSB visits UC San Diego Friday (Oct. 14) in its final non-conference regular season contest. The Gauchos won the Oct. 1 meeting at the SoCal Tourney, 15-9.



PEPPERDINE (8-6 Overall, 0-1 MPSF) split in Northern California over the weekend, dropping its MPSF opener at top-ranked Stanford (9-5), before recovering at Santa Clara (12-6). The Waves led wire-to-wire against the Broncos, led by Danny White's hat trick. Andrew Milcovich also posted three goals in the loss. Pepperdine has two conference games on tap this week, at UC Irvine Friday, followed by the home opener vs. Pacific Sunday.



LONG BEACH STATE (11-5 Overall, 0-2 MPSF) Dan Matulis and Nick Rascon scored two goals apiece in the home loss to California Saturday. The 49ers played their MPSF opener at USC last Thursday, falling 14-3. The Beach will now step outside the conference when hosting UC San Diego Wednesday (Oct. 12) and Concordia Saturday (Oct. 15).

JUSTIN PARSONS KAP7 MPSF PLAYER OF THE WEEK



California junior goalkeeper **Justin Parsons** (San Diego, CA/Coronado HS) helped the Bears to a 3-0 mark this past week as his squad outscored its opponents 40-19, including going 2-0 versus the MPSF. Parsons recorded 11 saves in an 8-5 win at No. 3 UCLA, 10 saves in a 14-6 win at Long Beach State and five saves in two quarters in an 18-8 victory at No. 9 UC San Diego. The five goals allowed to the Bruins was about seven less than their season average.
