## NO. 1 SEED ON THE LINE AS STANFORD VISITS UCLA



**STANFORD** (20-1 Overall/6-0 MPSF) travels to UCLA for a Saturday (Apr. 21) regular season finale, with the winner to receive an MPSF Tournament No. 1 seed the following weekend in Palo Alto. The Cardinal comes off their 31<sup>st</sup> straight win over rival California, 11-5 last Saturday. They led 3-0 after one quarter and were not caught. Kiley Neushul put away a game-high five goals, Kaley Dodson added two, and Kate Baldoni collected 10 saves in the cage.



**UCLA** (18-2 Overall/5-1 MPSF) picked up two non-conference road wins last weekend, 10-6 at No. 6 UC Irvine and 7-6 in overtime at No. 7 Loyola Marymount. Sarah Orozco nailed a second OT penalty shot for the win at LMU, while Caitlin Dement had 12 saves. Playing for a No. 1 seed and a regular season title Saturday, UCLA is 1-1 vs. Stanford this year. The Cardinal took a 9-5 home decision on Feb. 5, while the Bruins prevailed 5-4 in Irvine on Feb. 26.



**ARIZONA STATE** (23-5 Overall/4-3 MPSF) secured the four seed for the MPSF Tournament, by virtue of an 11-6 home win over Hawaii, as well as a California loss to Stanford. The Sun Devils won the tiebreaker for higher seeding over the Bears, due to the conference win head-to-head. Annabelle Carter had four goals and Janeta Hutchinson had 13 saves. ASU topped Cal Baptist (12-4) to close the regular season in game two of the doubleheader.



**SAN JOSE STATE** (18-10 Overall/2-5 MPSF) won all four games in the Santa Clara Invitational this past weekend, taking out CSU Bakersfield (10-5), Sonoma State (16-6), Colorado State (13-5), and host Santa Clara (13-6). Anna Natalizio combined for 12 goals over the four wins. The Spartans visit UC Davis Saturday (Apr. 21) before facing USC in the MPSF Quarterfinals (Apr. 27).



**SAN DIEGO STATE** (20-9 Overall/1-6 MPSF) secured its ninth straight 20-win season with a pair of convincing wins in Orange, CA, defeating Redlands (12-5) and host Chapman (22-2). Leanne Ford delivered six goals against Chapman, as did Amber Pezzolla against Redlands, each good for single-game Aztec highs this year. San Diego State visits nearby rival UC San Diego Friday (Apr. 20), before taking the seven seed to the conference tournament.



**HAWAII** (10-12 Overall/0-7 MPSF) won three of four in its trip to the mainland to close the regular season this past weekend, defeating Cal Baptist (9-7) in Tempe, AZ, as well as Occidental (15-9), and host Claremont (9-3). The Rainbow Wahine will play the winner of Saturday's UCLA-Stanford game in the 1-8 quarterfinal to start the MPSF Tournament.



**CALIFORNIA** (17-7 Overall/4-3 MPSF) was defeated 11-5 at No. 1 Stanford to close the regular season last Saturday. The outcome, coupled with ASU's season-ending win, translates into the MPSF Tournament five seed for the Bears. Cal and ASU will face off in a quarterfinal game on the 27<sup>th</sup>. Dana Ochsner scored twice in the finale.



**USC** (18-4 Overall/5-2 MPSF) held off San Jose State on Apr. 6, 8-5, before being edged in overtime at Stanford. Flora Bolonyai had 10 saves in the win, while Kaleigh Gilchrist led seven Trojan scorers with two goals. Maddy Rosenthal had a hat trick in the loss. USC, off last week, has one to play in the regular season in a non-conference game vs. CSU Bakersfield on Apr. 21. The Trojans will then be the two or three seed in the MPSF Tournament.

## KILEY NEUSHUL KAP 7 MPSF PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**Stanford** freshman **Kiley Neushul** (Goleta, CA/Dos Pueblos HS) scored five goals in the 11-5 win over No. 4 California Saturday, as the Cardinal clinched a top-two seed for the MPSF Championship Tournament. Neushul scored Stanford's first two goals of the game, and three of the team's first six, as the team raced out to a 6-0 lead within the game's first 12 minutes. She would add goals in the third and fourth to help hold off a late Cal charge. *Also Nominated: Caitlin Dement (UCLA); Anna Natalizio (SJSU); Amber Pezzolla (SDSU); Alicia Brightwell (ASU)*
