**At A Glance**

St. Bonaventure will try snap an 11-game road losing streak in its first ever appearance in Sojka Pavilion against Bucknell. The Bison have won eight of their last nine at home and are 29-17 all-time at Sojka Pavilion. The Bonnies have won six-straight against the Bison and have a 6-1 lead in the all-time series. A win would also give the Bonnies their first winning streak of the young season.

**Last Time Out: Freshmen key in win over Colgate**

With the Bonnies struggling to get anything going early, strong defense and the play of freshmen **Andrea Doneth** and **Dana Mitchell** ignited a game-changing 21-6 run to help the Bonnies cruise over the final 20 minutes to 70-49 win over Colgate last Saturday afternoon at the Reilly Center. The freshmen duo combined to score 13 points, including 10-straight, during the run that helped the Bonnies overcome a seven-point deficit to take a 30-22 lead into halftime. Making her first collegiate start, Doneth filled up the stat sheet with a team-high 15 points, five assists, four steals and three rebounds in 35 minutes of action. 11 of Mitchell's 13 points came in the first half.

**1,000-Point & 500-Rebound Club**

In 33 years of St. Bonaventure women's basketball only six players have ever compiled 1,000 points and 500 rebounds during their career. Senior **Audrey Latendresse** is just 197 points and 76 rebounds away from joining this prestigious list.

### Scouting the Bison

Bucknell enters tonight's contest with a 4-3 record, including a perfect 2-0 mark at home. Two of the Bison's three losses have come to Atlantic 10 members Richmond and Saint Joseph's with the third coming at Michigan State. Hope Foster has been just short of dominating through the first seven games as the junior averages a team-high 16.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 5.9 blocks per game. Senior Lindsey Hollobaugh is the only other Bison averaging in double-figures at 13.4 points per game.

### Bonnies Versus the Patriot League

The Brown and White will play their second consecutive game against a Patriot League opponent and own a 20-10 all-time record against Patriot League, including a 6-1 mark against Bucknell. St. Bonaventure defeated Colgate, 70-49, last Saturday at the Reilly Center.

### Front Line Force

It has been apparent since the season opener that the Bonnies' frontcourt is going to be the team's strong point this season. A four-player rotation of senior **Audrey Latendresse**, sophomores **Ashley Edwards** and **Erica Schiefen** and freshman **Dana Mitchell** have combined to score 61 percent (40.9 per game) of the team's points and 64 percent (25.9 per game) of the rebounds over the first six games. Latendresse leads the way at the offensive end with 14.5 points per game, while Edwards is averaging a team-high 8.5 boards. Mitchell ranks third on the team in both points (10.2) and rebounds (6.0).

### Aud-Trey

Senior post player **Audrey Latendresse** has opposing defenses scratching their heads as she has shown there is more to her game than battling inside. Latendresse has developed a deadly shooting touch from the outside and ranks second on team with 10 three-pointers. She also ranks among the A-10 leaders in three-point percentage (.417/9th) and three-pointers per game (1.7/t-12th). Over two games at the St. Bona Shootout, she knocked down 7-of-11 shots from beyond the arc en route to being named to the All-Tournament team for third-straight season. Latendresse is tied for ninth place in the Bona record books with 67 career trifectas.

### Window Cleaners

Despite being undersized, the Bonnies have used hustle and quickness to gather a league-best 40.7 rebounds per game. St. Bonaventure has dramatically improved last seasons -4.7 rebounding margin per game by outrebounding four of its first six opponents for a +8.7 margin. Sophomore **Ashley Edwards** heads the Bona window cleaners with a team-high 8.5 rebounds per game, a figure that ranks third in the conference.

A Tale of Two Halves

The Bonnies have overcome some slow starts this season with tremendous second half play. During the first six games St. Bonaventure is averaging 41 points in the second half, while outscoring the opposition 245-205 after halftime. The Bonnies are shooting 49.7 percent (80-161) from the field and 79 percent (71-90) from the foul line during the final 20 minutes of regulation.

No Sophomore Slump

After turning in one of the most productive freshman campaigns in program history, sophomore **Ashley Edwards** is determined to make sure people recognize that last year wasn't a fluke. Standing 5-foot-11, Edwards is the leading returning rebounder in the A-10 and is back at it again this season. The Philadelphia, Pa. native has already registered a pair of double-doubles and has led the Bonnies in rebounding in four of the first six games. Edwards' team-high 8.5 boards per game ranks third in the conference, while her 10.7 points per game are second on the team. Her major improvement has come in the shooting

department where she has raised last year's 39 percent shooting percentage to the league's seventh best percentage at 56 (24-43).

Taking Charge

Senior **Audrey Latendresse** has endured her share of bumps and bruises during her four seasons. Latendresse has perfected the art of taking a charge and has taken 93 charges in her career, including seven already this season. She took 40 last season, 36 as a junior and 10 as a freshman.

A Lil' Bit Of This, A Lil' Bit Of That

Over her first few collegiate games, freshman **Andrea Doneth** has proved that her game is anything but one-dimensional. The East Lansing, Michigan native is averaging 6.8 points, 3.8 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.8 steals per game. Her team-high 11 steals rank 10th in the A-10, while her .864 free throw percentage is seventh. Doneth's strong play earned her the nod from head coach **Jim Crowley** for her first career start. She didn't disappoint, as she filled up the box score with a team-high 15 points, five

assists, four steals and three rebounds in a win over Colgate.

Living Up to the Hype

Prior to even stepping foot on the St. Bonaventure campus, freshman **Dana Mitchell** was being portrayed as one of the most decorated recruits in program history. After her first 22 minutes in the Brown and White uniform, it was obvious that the 2006 *Philadelphia Inquirer* Female Athlete of the Year was more than just hype. Playing in her first collegiate game, Mitchell scored a game-high 17 points and tied for the team lead with seven boards in just 22 minutes during a season-opening win over Siena. For her effort against the Saints, she was named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week. Mitchell, who stands 6-foot-1, ranks fifth among conference freshmen in scoring (10.2) and fourth in rebounding (6.0).

The A Team

Last season, post players **Audrey Latendresse** and **Ashley Edwards** showed that they were one of the up and coming tandems in the conference. This season, the frontcourt duo is out to prove they are. Through six games this season, Edwards and Latendresse have combined to average 25.2 points and 15.3 rebounds per game while shooting 52 percent (59-114) from the field. On Nov. 19 against Columbia, Edwards (14 points & 12 rebounds) and Latendresse (18 points & 13 rebounds) became just third Bonnie duo in the last 10 years to each record a double-double in the same game. Edwards has already totaled two double-doubles this season, tying her total from last season, while Latendresse now has five in her career. They have combined to lead the team in rebounding all six games and scoring three times.
