#### ST. JOHN'S OPENS NCAA TOURNAMENT PLAY AGAINST EAST CAROLINA

- Appearing in the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in the past five seasons, the sixth time in the past eight seasons and the 33rd time in program history, a mark that ranks tied for eighth all-time, third-seeded St. John's (35-20) returns to the Charlottesville Regional and Davenport Field for the second-straight season and opens play against second-seeded East Carolina (39-19) at 6 p.m. on June 3.
- St. John's is 59-58 all-time in the NCAA Tournament and has reached the College World Series six times, most recently in 1980.
- Head coach Ed Blankmeyer is leading the Red Storm to the NCAA Tournament for the seventh time. The 16th year skipper is 8-12 in his six previous appearances (1997, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2010).
- The Red Storm advanced to the Charlottesville Regional Finals a season ago. Facing elimination after an opening-game loss to Mississippi (10-5), St. John's rebounded with wins against VCU (8-6) and Mississippi (20-16) to set up a meeting with host Virginia, the No. 1 team in the country. After beating the Cavaliers, 6-5, to force a winner-take-all final, the Red Storm was eliminated, 5-3.

### INSIDE THE SERIES WITH EAST CAROLINA

- St. John's and East Carolina have met just five times a series that dates back to 1997.
- The Red Storm trails the all-time series 2-3, including a 2-2 mark at ECU and an 0-1 record in neutral games.
- St. John's was defeated by ECU, 9-7, when the teams last met on Feb. 27, 2009 as part of the Keith LeClair Classic.

### SCOUTING THE PIRATES

- An at-large selection from Conference USA, East Carolina enters the NCAA Tournament with a 39-19 record.
- Trent Whitehead paces a balanced offense, leading the team in average (.332), doubles (20), slugging percentage (.478) and stolen bases (16-for-22).
- Corey Thompson leads the team in home runs (5) and RBI (45), while Zach Wright has 39 RBI, and Philip Clark and John Wooten add 27 apiece.
- The pitching staff ranks seventh in the country with a 2.58 ERA and also limits the opposition to a .236 batting average.
- Seth Maness (9-3, 1.88) leads the rotation and has four complete games to go along with 76 strikeouts in 96.0 innings.
- Brad Mincey (5-4, 1.55) has a team-high 30 appearances and has 52 strikeouts in 63.2 innings to pace the bullpen.

### PANIK NAMED SEMIFINALIST FOR USA BASEBALL GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD

- First team All-BIG EAST shortstop Joe Panik has been selected as one of 30 semifinalists for the Golden Spikes Award, presented by USA Baseball to the nation's top amateur player.
- A first team All-BIG EAST selection, Panik leads the Red Storm in average (.402), runs (59), home runs (9), slugging percentage (.645) and on-base percentage (.513), and ranks second in RBI (56).
- Panik helped lead St. John's to the finals of the BIG EAST Tournament and garnered BIG EAST All-Tournament Team honors for the second-straight season.

### PANIK, GROVE NAMED TO BIG EAST ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- After helping St. John's reach the Finals of the BIG EAST Tournament, Joe Panik and Kevin Grove were each named to the All-Tournament Team.
- Panik earns a spot on the All-Tournament Team for the second-straight year after batting .471 (8-for-17) with three multi-hit games, six runs, two doubles, three RBI, four stolen bases and a .583 on-base percentage.
- Grove, meanwhile, batted .500 (7-for-14) with one double, one home run (a grand slam), five RBI and a .786 slugging percentage.

### KARMAS BECOMES NEW ALL-TIME HIT KING AT ST. JOHN'S

- Already the school's all-time leader in doubles, Paul Karmas collected a pair of singles in the finals of the BIG EAST Tournament against Seton Hall (May 29) to set a new school-record for hits with 245.
- A fifth-inning single, career-hit No. 244, pulled the first baseman even with Mike Rozema (2001-04) before an eighth-inning single made Karmas the new hit-king.



## GROVE LAUNCHES FIRST-CAREER GRAND SLAM IN BIG EAST TOURNAMENT DEBUT

- Kevin Grove launched his first-career grand slam, an eighth-inning blast that capped a five-run eighth inning, in his first-career BIG EAST Tournament game, an 8-3 win against Cincinnati (May 25).
- Grove went 3-for-4 with four RBI in his tournament debut, tying his career-high in RBI. The outfielder has also registered four RBI at Georgetown (May 15) and at Gardner-Webb (March 12).

## FOUR RED STORM PLAYERS EARN ALL-BIG EAST ACCOLADES

- St. John's had four players earn All-BIG EAST honors, including a conference-best three first team selections.
- Jeremy Baltz, Kyle Hansen and Joe Panik all grabbed first team accolades, while Paul Karmas earned third team honors to become the Red Storm's first three-time All-BIG EAST honoree since Kevin McGerry (1998-2000).
- Baltz picked up first team honors for the second-straight season after finishing the regular season ranked fifth in RBI, while Hansen ranked third in strikeouts and seventh in ERA.
- Panik ranked in the top ten in nearly every offensive category, including average (tied for first), on-base percentage (first), slugging percentage (second), runs (tied for second), RBI (fourth), home runs (tied for fifth), doubles (tied for seventh) and stolen bases (eighth).
- A second team honoree as a rookie and a third team choice as a sophomore, Karmas was fifth in the league with a career-high 19 doubles.

## PANIK GARNERS THIRD TEAM CAPITAL ONE ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA SELECTION

- After earning Academic All-District honors for the second-straight year, Joe Panik has garnered third team Capital One Academic All-America honors as announced by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).
- A Finance major with a 3.78 GPA, Panik is the first St. John's player to earn Academic All-America status since both George Brown and Jeff Grantham in 2008.

## HAGAN EARNS SPOT ON BIG EAST WEEKLY HONOR ROLL

- After tossing 8.0 innings of one-run ball in a 3-1 win against Villanova (May 21), Sean Hagan earned a spot on the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll. The selection to the honor roll marks the first-career conference honor for the sophomore.
- In his first BIG EAST start of the season and his first start since March 29, the lefty had four strikeouts and allowed just five hits, all singles, in a career-high 8.0 innings.
- Hagan retired 10-straight batters at one point in the game and worked three 1-2-3 innings.

## KARMAS GARNERS BIG EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS; NAMED NCBWA PRO-LINE ATHLETIC NATIONAL HITTER OF THE WEEK

- After leading St. John's to a perfect 4-0 week, including a three-game BIG EAST sweep of Georgetown, Paul Karmas has been named BIG EAST Player of the Week and has garnered Pro-Line Athletic National Hitter of the Week honors from the NCBWA.
- The first baseman batted .550 (11-for-20) with three doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.000 slugging percentage.
- Karmas had four multi-hit games and three multi-RBI games, including a five-RBI contest that included a grand slam and a pair of three-RBI performances.

## RED STORM BLASTS SEASON-HIGH SIX HOME RUNS TO COMPLETE SWEEP OF GEORGETOWN

- Four players combined for a season-high six home runs as St. John's completed a series sweep with a 12-2 win against Georgetown (May 15).
- Jeremy Baltz and Kevin Grove had two

home runs apiece, while Joe Panik and Paul Karmas each added one home run. Karmas and Grove had back-to-back home runs in the sixth.

- The six home runs were the most in a game since the Red Storm launched seven in a 17-9 win against Boston College (May 18, 2010).

## GROVE LAUNCHES TWO HOME RUNS TO TIE CAREER-HIGH WITH FOUR-RBI GAME

- Redshirt freshman Kevin Grove posted his first-career multi-home run game and tied a career-high with four RBI in a 12-2 win against Georgetown (May 15).

- Panik, who previously had posted four-hit games on four occasions, had four singles and a double in his first five at-bats before being retired for the first time in the ninth inning.
- The five-hit game was the first for St. John's since Greg Hopkins went 5-for-6 on May 20, 2009 in the BIG EAST Tournament.
- The last six-hit performance for the Red Storm came on April 7, 2009 when Tim Morris was a perfect 6-for-6 at the plate.

## **LOBBAN TOSSES CAREER-HIGH 7.2 INNINGS IN WIN AT NO. 21 GEORGIA TECH**

- Junior Brendan Lobban worked a career-high 7.2 innings and allowed just three runs in a 13-3 win at then-No. 21 Georgia Tech (Feb. 27).
- The lefty had five strikeouts, worked four 1-2-3 innings and allowed just one hit after the third inning. Lobban allowed six hits, four singles, and retired 13 of 14 Yellow Jackets beginning in the third to work into the eighth for the first time in his career.

## **BALTZ TAKES SEASON'S FIRST BIG EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR**

- After helping St. John's score 34 runs in a 2-1 opening weekend at the third annual BIG EAST-Big Ten Challenge, sophomore Jeremy Baltz was named the BIG EAST Player of the Week for the second time in his career.
- Baltz batted .500 (7-for-14) with two doubles, one triple, seven RBI, five runs scored and a .786 slugging percentage. The sophomore had three multi-RBI games and a pair of multi-hit games, including his second-career four-hit game.
- Following a two-RBI day in a season-opening 14-1 win against Minnesota (Feb. 18), Baltz was 2-for-4 with three RBI in a 13-6 triumph against Michigan (Feb. 19). The sophomore was 4-for-5 with two RBI in an 11-inning, 8-7 loss to Ohio State (Feb. 20).

## **ST. JOHN'S TOPS 30 RUNS ON OPENING WEEKEND FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON**

- Paced by 14-1 and 13-6 triumphs against Minnesota (Feb. 18) and Michigan (Feb. 19), respectively, and combined with an 8-7 loss to Ohio State (Feb. 20), St. John's scored 34 runs in three games on opening weekend, marking the third-straight season that the Red Storm has topped 30 runs in the first three games of the year.
- Including a school-record setting 31-run outburst, the Red Storm plated 45 runs in a three-game set at New Orleans to open the 2010 season.
- At the inaugural BIG EAST-Big Ten Challenge in 2009, St. John's scored 15 runs in a season-opening victory against Penn State and added 18 runs in a win against Iowa en route to a 35-run opening weekend tally.

- The lefty allowed just three hits, all singles, and walked one, while adding four strikeouts and limiting the Golden Gophers to a .176 batting average.

## **WICK CLUBS FIRST-CAREER HOME RUN IN COLLEGIATE DEBUT**

- Freshman Rowan Wick connected on his first-career home run in a 14-1 Opening Day win against Minnesota (Feb. 18), which marked his collegiate debut.
- Wick, who was a 19th round draft pick of the Milwaukee Brewers, led off the bottom of the fourth inning with a solo shot that gave St. John's a 3-0 lead.

## **BALTZ NAMED TO PRESEASON GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST**

- Sophomore Jeremy Baltz, the reigning NCBWA Freshman Hitter of the Year and Louisville Slugger Freshman Player of the Year, has been named to the Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List as announced by USA Baseball.
- Baltz is one of 50 players, and one of just six sophomores named to the list for the award that is presented to the by USA Baseball to the top amateur baseball player in the country.
- In addition to being named to the Watch List, Baltz enters the 2011 season as a first team NCBWA Preseason All-American, a second team Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American and a unanimous selection to the All-BIG EAST Preseason Team.

## **ST. JOHN'S RANKED NO. 23 IN BASEBALL AMERICA PRESEASON TOP 25**

## Head Coach Ed Blankmeyer

16th Season at St. John's  
Seton Hall '76

Head coach Ed Blankmeyer is in his 16th season at the helm of the St. John's baseball program. In 15 seasons with the Red Storm, Blankmeyer has posted a 513-305-3 record, won two BIG EAST Tournament crowns, three BIG EAST regular season titles, made six NCAA Regional appearances and 11 BIG EAST Tournament appearances.

St. John's has flourished in every season under the tutelage of Blankmeyer, who has guided St. John's to five 40-win seasons, five 30-win seasons and at least 29 wins in 13 of his 15 seasons. He has been named BIG EAST Coach of the Year four times, ABCA Northeast Region Coach of the Year four times, has had 69 All-BIG EAST selections and has seen 48 of his players drafted and/or signed to professional contracts.

In a season in which Blankmeyer notched his 500th victory, St. John's set a new school-record with 43 wins in 2010 and won a conference-record sixth BIG EAST Tournament crown. The team also made the 33rd NCAA Tournament appearance in program history and reached the Charlottesville Regional finals. The squad was paced by an offense that set new school-records in runs scored (493), hits (750), doubles (150) and RBI (457), and a pitching staff that set a new mark for strikeouts (455). The NCBWA National Freshman Hitter of the Year, the Louisville Slugger Freshman Player of the Year and the BIG EAST Rookie of the Year, Jeremy Baltz became the first consensus All-American in school history after earning All-America honors from Baseball America (first team), the ABCA (second team), Louisville Slugger (second team) and the NCBWA (second team). Baltz, who led the nation's freshmen in both home runs and RBI, and classmate Kyle Hansen, who earned 2010 BIG EAST Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors, each earned Freshman All-America accolades and five players were All-BIG EAST selections. Four players-Daniel Burawa, Bruce Kern, Greg Hopkins and Ryan Cole-were selected in the 2010 MLB Draft, while Red Storm alumni Rob Delaney and Anthony Varvaro each made their MLB debuts.

Blankmeyer spent the summer of 2010 as an assistant coach of the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. The squad finished their summer tour with a 16-3 record and won the silver medal at the V FISU World University Baseball Championships in Tokyo, Japan.

St. John's reached the BIG EAST Tournament for the sixth-straight year in 2009 and finished the season 30-22. A prolific offense set new school-records in batting average (.349), runs scored (473), RBI (440) and doubles (149). Five players earned All-BIG EAST honors and juniors Brian Kemp and Tim Morris were both drafted in the 2009 MLB Draft. Morris earned third team All-America honors, while Joe Panik also earned second team freshman All-America honors from the NCBWA. The team also played in front of the seventh-largest regular season crowd in NCAA baseball history (22,397) in the first-ever game at Citi Field, the new home of the New York Mets.

St. John's posted its fourth-straight 40-win season with a school-record 42 wins in 2008. The squad also won its second-straight BIG EAST regular season crown and earned its second-straight bid to the NCAA Tournament. Eight players earned All-BIG EAST accolades and George Brown became the program's fourth BIG EAST Pitcher of the Year. Brown was also named a second-team All-American, while Paul Karmas earned freshman All-America accolades. For the second season in a row and the third time in four seasons, Blankmeyer earned both BIG EAST and Northeast Region coach of the year honors.

An associate head coach at Seton Hall University for 14 seasons, Blankmeyer was hired on Feb. 1, 1996, just five weeks before the season began, and won BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors after leading the Red Storm to a 26-18 record. The Red Storm finished 14-10 in the BIG EAST Conference, came within two outs of the BIG EAST championship game and finished third in the postseason tournament.

The following season, he guided the Red Storm to its first NCAA Regional appearance in five years and won the school's fifth BIG EAST Tournament Championship. The team finished 35-17 and was 16-7 in the conference, just a half game behind West Virginia for the BIG EAST American Division crown. In addition, the 35 victories were the most by a St. John's team since 1986.

An outstanding second baseman in his own right, Blankmeyer played four seasons at Seton Hall during his college days, hitting .320, with 152 hits and 66 stolen bases. He co-captained the 1976 Pirate team that went on to play in the NCAA Northeast Regional and was the starting second baseman of both the 1974 and 1975 Seton Hall squads that played in the College World Series. He was the Atlantic Collegiate League Most Valuable Player in 1975.

Blankmeyer earned Academic All-America honors during his tour at Seton Hall and graduated in 1976. Following his graduation, he was a 15th-round pick of the Baltimore Orioles. He spent one season in the Orioles farm system before beginning his coaching career. The ultimate compliment came in 1986 when Blankmeyer was honored by Seton Hall, receiving induction into the Pirate Hall of Fame. He has also been inducted into the North Shore High School Hall of Fame.
