RED STORM RETURNS HOME FOR MATCH WITH MARQUETTE

- Following the squad's longest road swing of the season, the St. John's men's soccer team finally returns home to the friendly confines of Belson Stadium on Saturday, playing host to Marquette in a 5:30 p.m. tilt. The contest will serve as the first game of a doubleheader with the St. John's women's soccer team, who will take on Seton Hall at 8 p.m.
- The Johnnies come home to Queens looking to recapture some of their momentum from mid-September, a period that saw the team go unbeaten in five-straight, including four consecutive victories, from Sept. 9-Sept. 23. That stretch was capped with the Red Storm's signature win of the season so far, a 3-0 drubbing of RV/No. 19 Xavier at Belson on Sept. 23. On the campaign, the Johnnies are 3-1-1 in games played in Queens with a goals against average of just 0.38 and three clean sheets.
- Saturday's contest with the Golden Eagles will signal the midway mark of conference play for the Johnnies, the fifth of a nine-game league slate. Entering the weekend, the Red Storm ranks third in the BIG EAST standings with seven points, trailing only a pair of nationally ranked foes in No. 9 Georgetown and No. 20 Butler. Xavier, Villanova and Seton Hall sit in a three-way tie for fourth place behind the Johnnies, as each team sports a conference record of 2-2.
- Since returning to the Red Storm lineup after missing nearly a month with an ankle injury, Harry Cooksley appears to have quickly regained his old form that saw him earn First Team All-BIG EAST honors in 2016. After registering one shot in 48 minutes of action during his return at Butler, Cooksley recorded both of the Red Storm's tallies in a 2-2 draw with Creighton on Friday evening, his first career multi-goal game in Division I. Four days later against Princeton, the senior from London put five of his team-high seven shots on target to lead the offensive attack for St. John's.

QUICK HITS

SCOUTING MARQUETTE

- Marquette enters Saturday's match with a record of 1-8-2 on the season, including a 1-2-1 mark in conference action following a 2-2 draw with Providence last weekend in Milwaukee.
- Four Golden Eagles have scored multiple goals on the season, led by redshirt junior Grant Owens with three tallies in nine appearances.
- Marquette has struggled to keep its opponents off the board, compiling a GAA of 2.08 that ranks last in the conference.

ST. JOHN'S VS. MARQUETTE- THE SERIES

- St. John's and Marquette have met seven times since the Golden Eagles joined the BIG EAST in 2005 with each team claiming two victories and three ties.
- The two squads have played to a scoreless draw in each of their past two meetings and three of the last four contests overall.
- The Johnnies claimed victory in each of the first two games played between the two teams, both of which were 1-0 wins.

COOKSLEY MAKES HIS RETURN

- A First Team All-BIG EAST selection in 2016 and one of only two players in the league to earn unanimous selection to the pre-season all-conference team this summer, Harry Cooksley made his return to the pitch against Butler after missing nearly a month with a high-ankle sprain.
- Suffering the injury late in the second half of the Red Storm's scoreless draw against Hofstra, the London native missed the squad's next five games before registering 48 minutes against the Bulldogs.
- Six days later, the senior from London recorded his first career brace, finding the back of the net twice against Creighton.
- On Tuesday, Cooksley fired off a season-high seven shots, five of which were on target, in the Red Storm's 1-0 loss on the road to Princeton.
- On the campaign, Cooksley has three goals and two assists.

JOHNNIES CLIMB IN THE REGIONAL RANKINGS

- Despite having not won a game in three weeks, the Red Storm is currently enjoying its best position of the season in the United Soccer Coaches Regional Rankings, checking in at seventh in the Great Lakes Region.
- Last season, the Johnnies rose as high as no. 7 in the regional rankings on Oct. 4 following a 1-1 draw against No. 10 Creighton at Belson Stadium.

RED STORM SURGES IN RPI

- The NCAA released its second RPI of the season on Monday and the Red Storm found itself firmly in the conversation for a post-season spot.
- Checking in at no. 54 in the national rankings, St. John's is fifth among BIG EAST teams. Butler leads the league with a no. 12 ranking, followed by Georgetown (15) and Creighton (27) in the top 30. Xavier sits at 52 followed by St. John's (54) and Villanova (75).
- Providence (156), Seton Hall (158), Marquette (165) and DePaul (185) round out the league.

WITHERS RANKS AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

- Despite allowing two goals in the same game for just the second time this season against Creighton, Andrew Withers still ranks near the top of the national standings in a number of statistical categories.
- Through games played on Oct. 11, the Wellington, New Zealand, native's five shutouts rank 23rd in Division I while his 0.73 GAA ranks 21st and his .830 save percentage is good enough for 15th.

ST. JOHN'S AGAINST THE BEST

- Following the team's win over RV/No. 19 Xavier on Sept. 23, the Red Storm now boasts a win over a ranked opponent in two consecutive seasons.
- Last year, the Red Storm topped No. 11/14 Butler, 2-1, at Belson Stadium on Oct. 15 two weeks to the day after earning a point with a 1-1 draw against No. 10/14 Creighton in Queens.

RICUPATI BATTLES INJURY, LOOKS TO BUILD ON HIGH-SCORING 2016

- The team leader in goals last season with six, Filippo Ricupati is looking to find the back of the net with consistency once again in his junior campaign.
- Due to a nagging lower body injury, Ricupati has been limited in his minutes so far in 2017, but has scored twice on the year in back-to-back games against Xavier in Lehigh.
- Ricupati registered his highest minute total of the season against Hofstra (75) and played 50 minutes against Seton Hall in the Red Storm's BIG EAST opener on Sept. 16 before registering

MEDIA POLICIES

All media requests for interviews with St. John's soccer players and coaches should be directed to the Athletic Communications office 24 hours in advance.

The best time for in-season interviews, either in person or on the phone, is prior to or following practice. Interviews conducted prior to or following practice should be held to a brief Q&A session. With advanced notice, interviews with players can be arranged for other hours.

Calling players at home or on mobile phones without permission from the St. John's Athletic Communications office will not be allowed. Residence halls, training rooms and weight rooms are off limits to the media.

The St. John's locker room is closed to the media following the game. The team is allowed the customary 10-minute cooling off period and time with the coaching staff to meet with the team after each game. The St. John's Athletic Communications staff will secure coach and student-athletes for postgame interviews that will be held on the field.

The only pregame interviews allowed on game days will be for St. John's radio, and local or national television productions. No game day interviews will be granted unless specifically requested for televised games.

Credential Requests

Credential requests must be made by sports editors or sports directors on official letterhead no later than five days prior to an event. They should be sent to the Athletic Communications Office, Room 157 Carnesecca Arena, St. John's University, 8000 Utopia Parkway, Queens, NY 11439. They also may be faxed to 718-969-8468 or emailed to stjcommunications@stjohns.edu.

Credentials are not transferable and are subject to immediate revocation if transferred to non-working members of a media outlet.

St. John's University and the NCAA prohibit the issuance of credentials to representatives of an organization that regularly publishes gambling information, such as "tout sheets" or "tip sheets."

Web sites that sponsor "message boards" or "chat rooms" where people are allowed to post anonymous information or rumors are ineligible for credentials or access to media functions. If a news-gathering medium has an online site that sponsors these anonymous forums, they may continue to request credentials under their traditional medium, but will not be granted additional passes or access for online staff.

Telephones

Telephones and working media spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. There are a limited number of telephones available in the Belson Stadium press box.

- 51 minutes against Lehigh and 53 minutes at Butler.
- Of Ricupati six goals in 2016, three were game winners.
- Four of Ricupati's six goals last season came in just two games, as the Milan, Italy, native found the back of the net twice against Holy Cross and Saint Joseph's, making him the first St. John's player to record two multi-goal games in the same season since Andrei Gotsmanov tallied a pair of hat tricks for the Red Storm in 2004.

EARLY AND OFTEN

- As is the case for most teams, a critical component of the Red Storm's success has been getting on the board first.
- Since the beginning of the 2010 season, the Johnnies are 60-4-3 when scoring before their opponent.

RED STORM RETURNERS

- The Red Storm returns a ton of talent from its 2016 squad that turned in the program's best winning percentage since the NCAA Tournament season of 2013.
- The Johnnies welcome back seven players that started at least nine games last season. In addition, St. John's returns its top two goal scorers from last season in Ricupati (five starts) and Cooksley (six starts).

ENSTROM SIGNS ONTO STORM FOR SENIOR SEASON

- A three-year standout at the University of Buffalo, senior defender/midfielder David Enstrom has signed on with the Red Storm for his senior year.
- A First Team All-MAC selection in 2016, Enstrom helped lead the Bulls to a 12-4-3 record and an appearance in MAC Championship game.
- The Stockholm, Sweden, native had two goals and two assists as a junior, including one of each in a 2-1 overtime win for Bufflao in the MAC semifinals.

PLAYERS IN THE PROS

- Under Dave Masur, the St. John's men's soccer program has been a consistent provider of talented athletes to professional leagues all around the world.
- To date, 12 Red Storm alumni have suited up for Major League Soccer teams, with three of those players (Connor Lade- NY Red Bulls, Tim Parker- Vancouver Whitecaps, and Chris Wingert- Real Salt Lake) currently active in the league.
- Former Red Storm keeper Rafi Diaz is currently excelling in the Red Bulls organization as well, taking over the starting job for RB II in the USL.

DR. MASUR DOES IT ALL

- Beginning his 27th season on the sideline at St. John's, Dr. Dave Masur has proven to be one of the nation's most extraordinary leaders over the past quarter century.
- In 26 tries, Masur has been to 20 NCAA Tournaments, has won a league-record nine BIG EAST Championships and has also claimed six regular season conference titles.
- Among active Division I coaches, Masur's 397 career wins rank seventh, while his .680 winning percentage ranks 11th.
- In addition to his duties at the helm of the men's soccer program, Masur is also an associate athletic director at St. John's, serving as a key liason between the department's coaches and administrators while overseeing a number of special projects within the department.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- A program widely known for its ability to attract talent from every corner of the globe, the Red Storm once again has a distinctly international feel in 2017.
- Of the Red Storm's 31 players on the roster, 17 were born outside the United States.
- The Johnnies largest contingents come from England and Italy, both of which produced three members of the Red Storm.
- Canada, Haiti, Iceland and Sweden can each claim two members of the squad, while Spain, Cyprus and New Zealand each sent one native son to Queens.

JANEZIC JOINS STAFF AS ASSISTANT COACH

- In May, David Janezic joined Dr. Dave Masur's staff as an assistant coach.
- Prior to his arrival at St. John's, Janezic had two stints in the Garden State as a Division I assistant coach, working at NJIT before moving over to Fairleigh Dickinson, where he put together a pair of highly-rated recruiting classes.
- Before his time at those institutions, Janezic served as the head coach of Brookdale Community College and helped the Jersey Blues reach the NJCAA Division III National Tournament and finish the season with a record of 18-4-1.
- A standout at Monmouth from 1992-96, Janezic played in both the indoor and outdoor professional ranks after graduation, seeing action with the Philadelphia Kixx and the Central Jersey Riptide.
