St. John's Set for BIG EAST Championship Semifinal Matchup with Butler

- The two-day, single-elimination championship event will be held at The Ballpark at Rosemont, home of the National Pro Fastpitch (NPF) Chicago Bandits, located in Rosemont, Ill.
- For the Red Storm, this marks the fourth-consecutive year at the BIG EAST Tournament that features a conference title in 2015, while Butler looks to defend its crown from a year ago.
- Last season, St. John's fell short of repeating as the Red Storm dropped a 10-8, extra innings, heartbreaker to Butler.
- The Red Storm is 7-12 all-time at the BIG EAST Championship and has made it to the championship game four times, including three-straight appearances (1990, 2014, 2015, 2016).
- The game will be available live on FOX Sports 2 with Bob Holtzman (PxP) and Dave Bernhard (Color) on the call, while Matt Shoemaker will be covering from the sideline.

STORM TRACKER

- Entering the BIG EAST Championship, St. John's has been red hot riding a seven-game winning streak. In that span, the Johnnies have outscored their opponents 35-to-8 and posted shutouts against Georgetown and Fordham.
- St. John's is averaging 5.76 runs per contest behind a .313 team batting average, while opponents are scoring 3.46 runs on .235 hitting.
- The Red Storm has recorded more hits (+121), runs (+106), doubles (+29) and strikeouts (+96) than its opponents.

SCOUTING REPORT: Seton Hall Pirates (22-22-1, 7-11 BIG EAST)

- The Butler Bulldogs ended the season on a high note sweeping Georgetown in their last BIG EAST series of the regular season (W 9-7, W 4-0, W 7-6).
- The Bulldogs are led by sophomore outfielder Jenna Foreman who ranks second in the conference with a .380 batting average. The Second Team All-BIG EAST selection has 33 runs scored, ranks fourth with 57 hits, and ranks fifth with 14 doubles.
- Junior outfielder Sarah Dixon leads the team with 27 RBIs and ranks seventh with 34 runs scored. Dixon has a .335 batting average behind 52 hits and is tied for third with three triples.
- Leading the Bulldogs in the circle is sophomore pitcher Kaitlin Doud with a 3.43 ERA. The Second Team All-BIG EAST honoree has 102.0 innings of work with 28 strikeouts and is tied for sixth with eight wins.
- In the circle, Butler has an ERA of 4.49 in 327.1 innings of work, which ranks second in the conference. They have struck out 147 with 34 of those batters looking and rank fourth with 23 wins and a second best six saves.
- The Butler Bulldogs are led by head coach Scott Hall. Hall is in his seventh year at the helm, leading the Bulldogs to their most successful season ever in 2016, making an NCAA Tournament appearance after winning the BIG EAST Championship title.

SERIES HISTORY

- St. John's has faced Butler 13 times in its history and is 9-4 all-time against the Bulldogs.
- Earlier in the season, the Red Storm swept three games over Butler in Indianapolis by a combined score of 22-to-7.
- Last season, the Johnnies fell just shy of its second-straight BIG EAST title after dropping a 10-8, 8-inning battle to the Butler in the championship game.

AROUND THE BIG EAST (League play only)

- The top offensive team in the BIG EAST, St. John's leads the league in hitting (.350), runs scored (157), total hits (204), RBIs (140), triples (5), total bases (304). The Red Storm also rank second behind DePaul in slugging (.521) and on base percentage (.421).
- Eight of St. John's starting nine are hitting over .340 in league play led by Lauren Zick and Monique Landini's top-10 batting average.
- Zick (29), Brittany Garcia (21) and Landini are ranked in the top-seven in runs scored, while Gretchen Bowie (26), Savannah Warren (24) and Landini (19) are amongst the top-eight in RBIs.
- The Red Storm are the top-base stealing team in the BIG EAST (38) led by Zick's 24 stolen base, which is eight more than the next player.
- Featuring four pitchers that have appeared in at least six of the team's 21 games, the St. John's staff is ranked either first or second in all major statistical categories.
- The Johnnies sit atop the league in wins (17), strikeouts (135), saves (5), hits allowed (106), runs allowed (72) and extra bases given up (28), while holding the lowest opposing batting average by .070 points at .209. The Team also ranks second in ERA (3.14).
- St. John's is second in fielding percentage (.963) and first in caught stealing behind Kaitlin Mattera's five runners thrown out (second).

In its Last Series (Against Seton Hall)

- St. John's closed out the regular season on fire, winning its seventh-straight game after sweeping Seton Hall at Mike Sheppard, Sr. Field in New Jersey. It was the fifth BIG EAST series sweep for St. John's who closed out its conference slate undefeated on the road.
- Sophomore Madison Morris turned in a brilliant performance against Seton Hall to move to 6-0 in the circle. The Honor Roll recipient struck out a career-high 12 batters en route to a complete-game one hitter to clinch the program's fourth 30-win season.

BIG EAST WEEKLY HONORS

- MAY 8** - Madison Morris and Kystal Puga were named to the weekly Honor Roll after leading the Johnnies to a sweep over Seton Hall. Morris struck out a career-high 12 batters en route to a complete-game one hitter to clinch the program's fourth 30-win season. Puga helped the Red Storm clinch its second BIG EAST Regular-Season title in three seasons last Saturday with a go-ahead two-run homer in the sixth against the Pirates
- MAY 1** - Krystal Puga was named BIG EAST Player of the Week after batting .571 and slugging 1.429. She finished with two home runs, seven RBI and scored five runs. In Game 2, Puga broke the contest open in the second inning with her first-career grand slam. Grace Kramer was named BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week after boasting a 0.70 ERA last week while holding opposing batters to a .063 batting average. The hurler pitched 10.0 innings going 1-0 with a league-high 12 strikeouts.
- APRIL 24** - Madison Morris grabbed a spot on the Honor Roll after going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in St. John's second game against Villanova last weekend. In six innings of work, she allowed zero runs and only two hits while striking out five.
- APRIL 17** - Christina Melendez was named BIG EAST Player of the Week after posting a 1.500 slugging percentage in St. John's series-sweep of Butler, tallying three extra base hits. She batted .625, the sophomore went 5-for-8 at the plate and finished the weekend with four RBIs. McKenzie after sporting a 0.00 ERA throughout St. John's series against Butler, the junior collected two saves and a 9-0 series finale victory in 6.1 innings.
- APRIL 3** - Madison Morris was named BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week after picking up two wins in the circle in relief effort. Morris finished 2-0 with seven strikeouts and held Creighton hitters to a .154 batting average. Gretchen Bowie earned a spot on the Honor Roll after slugging 1.125 with eight RBIs, five runs and two homers to help St. John's sweep the Bluejays and improve to 6-0 in league play. Her performance included two grand slams against Creighton.
- MARCH 27** - Senior Tori Free was named BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week, while Kaitlin Mattera was tabbed to the Weekly Honor Roll. Free clinched the series sweep over Providence in dramatic fashion as the senior tossed her first-career no-hitter and picked up nine strikeouts in the process. Free finished the week with one win and one save over three appearances, recording 17 strikeouts and a 1.20 ERA over 11.2 innings. Reaching base safely eight times in three BIG EAST games against Providence, Mattera batted .750, slugged 1.000 and registered two runs and three RBI.

MARCH 20 - Warren gave St. John's the winning edge in its 9-7 win over Radford with her second-career grand slam in the third inning. Overall, the junior batted .833 (5-for-6) with a home run, four RBIs and two runs scored in the Red Storm's two games against Radford on Sunday.
- MARCH 13** - McKenzie Murray and Savannah Warren earned a spot on the Honor Roll after leading St. John's to a 10-2 victory over Wagner. Murray held the Seahawks' offense in check in the Red Storm's only game of the week as the junior tossed 5.0 innings of scoreless ball to earn the win. Warren helped close out Wagner with a walk-off three-run homer in the sixth to power St. John's to a 10-2 victory.

- MARCH 7** - Batting .462, Christina Melendez registered a hit in every game this past weekend, including a pair of multi-hit performances to earn a spot on the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll. The California native smashed a two-run homer off the scoreboard against Morehead State on Saturday and finished the weekend with four RBIs and four runs in four games this past weekend to go with a .563 on base mark.
- FEB. 27** - Senior Tori Free was named BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week after going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA and 15 strikeouts over 11.0 innings at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, including a complete-game shutout over Bethune-Cookman. Gretchen Bowie was tabbed to the Weekly Honor Roll for the second-straight week in part to her game-winning two-run double to propel the Red Storm to victory over Cal State Fullerton.
- FEB. 20** - Gretchen Bowie and Madison Morris received a spot on the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll. Bowie was only a single shy of the cycle as she went 3-for-3 with a grand slam, triple, double, walk and stolen base against Savannah State to finish the game with four RBIs and three runs scored. Morris was nearly unhittable over 12.2 innings in the circle as she posted a 0.55 ERA and held hitters to a .119 batting average with seven strikeouts.
- FEB. 13** - Kaitlin Mattera, McKenzie Murray and Kaitlyn Wilkens were all named to the conference's first BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll of 2017. In her collegiate debut, Mattera shined against some of the best teams in the country recording a hit in all four games and lead the team with a .667 batting average with three RBIs. Murray was dominant against Delaware in the team's first victory of the year, recording six strikeouts in her 2017 debut. Wilkens helped turn the game against Delaware with a three-run homer in the sixth inning to break a 2-2 tie. Wilkens matched her career-high in hits with a 3-for-3 day at the plate to close out the weekend batting .400 and leading the Johnnies with four RBIs.
