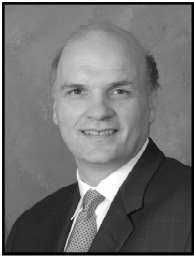

HEAD COACH PHIL MARTELLI



Now in his 12th season as head coach at Saint Joseph's, Phil Martelli has built a program that is consistently one of the top in the conference, a perennial post-season participant and a key player on the national scene.

Martelli turned in another top-notch coaching performance in 2005-06, as the Hawks went from a 10-12 record in February to win the final five games of the regular season, and three straight in the conference tournament, to reach the Atlantic 10 championship for the second year in a row, falling just one point short of the title. The Hawks were rewarded with their sixth consecutive postseason bid, but saw the season come to an end in the NIT Second Round, closing with a 19-14 mark.

Martelli's effort was similar to the previous season where he turned in perhaps a more remarkable coaching job than in 2003-04 when he was the consensus National Coach of the Year. Faced with the loss of two NBA first-round draft picks from the '03-04 squad that went 30-2, the 2004-05 Hawks struggled early on, but Martelli reworked the team's style of play to guide SJU to 21 wins in the calendar year of 2005 to finish 24-12. Saint Joseph's posted the conference's best record (14-2) and won its fifth straight regular-season title to tie the league record. The Hawks garnered the top seed in the conference tournament for the second year in a row and reached the championship game. He was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year for the second straight season and the fourth time in his career. The Hawks earned their fifth consecutive postseason bid and made an exciting six-game run in the NIT, falling on a last-second shot in the championship game. It marked the second time in his career that he guided SJU to the NIT title game.

Martelli's 12-year career record is now 240-138, but more impressively, his teams have gone 141-54 in the previous six seasons, an average of over 23 victories per year. He is now second on SJU's list for coaching victories with 239, having surpassed Hall of Famer Jack Ramsay. Martelli is also fourth in winning percentage (.635) among SJU coaches. Setting the school record for wins in a season in 2004 (30), Martelli has guided SJU to 20 or more victories five times in 11 seasons. He is 123-68 in Atlantic 10 play, which is the most conference wins for any active coach in the A-10. Martelli has also been at his best when it counts the most as his 17 postseason wins (6 NCAA, 11 NIT) are the most in school history, ahead of Ramsay's 12. Martelli ranks first among Hawk coaches with a .680 postseason winning percentage (17-8) and has taken Saint Joseph's to the postseason in six consecutive years, and eight times in his 11 seasons.

Martelli's efforts and the success of the SJU program have been recognized on a consistent basis. In fact, he has earned a Coach of the Year award, whether it be a city, conference or regional honor, in six of his 11 seasons.

In the summer of 2005, Martelli served as the head coach of the USA Men's U21 World Championship Team, which competed at the FIBA U21 World Championship in Argentina, and earned a fifth-place finish. It was the coach's third assignment with USA Basketball.

In 2003-04, Martelli guided a focused and unselfish squad that became the most compelling story in college basketball with its undefeated regular season, a number-one national ranking and number-one seed in the NCAA Tournament. Led by consensus National Player of the Year Jameer Nelson, the Hawks advanced to the Elite Eight.

After 10 years as an assistant at SJU, Martelli was named the school's 14th head coach in 1995 and is just the third non-alumnus to hold the position. Martelli burst onto the scene in his first season (1995-96) and took the squad to the NIT championship game.

Prior to his arrival at SJU, Martelli spent seven years as head basketball coach at Bishop Kenrick High School. At Kenrick, he led his team to six straight Catholic League playoff appearances, a school record, and still owns the school's all-time mark for wins with 108. Martelli began his career as the junior varsity coach at Cardinal O'Hara High in Springfield, PA, for the 1976-77 season. He moved on the following year to become an assistant at his alma mater, where he helped guide Widener to the NCAA Division III Final Four. After that season, he accepted the head job at Kenrick.

As a player, the St. Joseph's Prep graduate was part of Widener's NCAA Tournament teams in both 1974-75 and 1975-76, serving as team co-captain as a senior.

Martelli and his wife Judy, a former basketball player with the legendary Immaculata College teams, have three children. Philip, Jr., a 2003 SJU graduate, is an assistant basketball coach at Niagara University, Jimmy is an assistant coach at Randolph-Macon College, and Elizabeth is a sophomore attending Saint Joseph's.

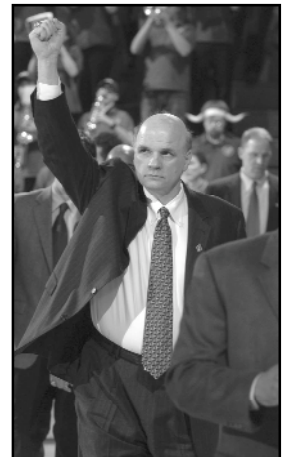
MARTELLI YEAR-BY-YEAR

VERSUS THE COLONIALS: SJU split the series with GW this year, as each team won on its home court. In the first game in Washington, Saint Joseph's dominated from the start, but committed key turnovers down the stretch. The Colonials went on an 18-3 run in the final 6:56 as the Hawks went without a field goal during that time and committed four of their 20 turnovers. **Pat Calathes** started the game making his first six shots en route to a then career-high 21 points.

In Philadelphia, the game was close the entire way, with nine ties and eight lead changes. The Hawks broke a 52-52 tie at 5:03 by scoring seven straight and came up with some big defensive rebounds down the stretch. Calathes had 17 points and **Darrin Govens** scored 16.

NOTICING NIVINS: **Ahmad Nivins** registered his second straight double-double with the 18 point-10 rebound effort against Temple. In the last five games, the sophomore is averaging 21.0 points and 9.8 rebounds. He hit 6-of-10 shots while playing all 40 minutes against the Owls. It was his first significant game in Atlantic 10 Tournament play as last year, he missed the semifinal and final with a sprained ankle. Nivins had only scored four points in the opening round and quarterfinal wins in 2006.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Against Temple, the Hawks led for a brief moment in the first half and then trailed most of the game, by as much as nine points. SJU made its comeback at the right time, and took its lead for good with 1:05 to on a pair of free throws by **Jawan Carter**. The Hawks then won the game from the foul line, making 9-of-10 in the last 1:05, led by 4-of-4 from **Pat Calathes**. It was the second largest margin overcome for a win this season, with the biggest deficit being 13 points in the win at at Charlotte.

OFF THE BENCH: With **Darrin Govens'** return to the starting five, **Jawan Carter** came off the bench for the fifth time this year and piloted the Hawks' comeback. Carter scored all 13 of his points in the second half as SJU rallied from a nine-point deficit. The freshman had four points in a 6-0 run that cut the deficit. He then hit a 3-pointer at 3:07 to pull the Hawks within 56-54, and then made 3-of-4 free throws in the final minute.

HE'S BACK: **Darrin Govens** made his return to the starting lineup after missing close to three games with the sprained ankle. The freshman played 24 minutes scoring eight points, marking the first time he has not scored double figures in a game that he's started.

FROM THE LINE: Although the Hawks have had their ups and downs with the free throw shooting all year, they came through with a 79.3 percent effort against Temple. That included a 16-for-19 performance in the second half.

STAYING OVER: The Hawks are looking to make another long run in the A-10 Tournament. Counting tonight's game, SJU will have played nine tournament games in the past three years. In 2005, Saint Joseph's started in the quarterfinals and advanced to the championship game, losing to GW. In 2006, the Hawks played in the opening round and moved to the title game, falling to Xavier by one point. In these three years, SJU is 6-2 in the conference tournament.

MARTELLI IN MARCH: It's not secret that **Phil Martelli's** teams tend to play their best in the latter part of the season. In the last four seasons (counting this one), the Hawks are 19-7 in the month of March. SJU is now 1-1 thus far this year. The best March run was actually a 9-2 record in 2004-05 when SJU advanced to the A-10 Tournament final then went on to reach the NIT championship game.

RUBBER GAME: Having already played Temple three times this season, the Hawks will now meet GW for the third time, with the teams having split the season series. Here's the list of occasions when the Hawks have met an opponent three times since '96-97, with the outcomes:
