Beginning her first season on Hawk Hill, **Alexis Berg** brings several years of experience to Saint Joseph's. She served as assistant coach at Ohio Northern from 2004-05 where she coached both hitting and infielding, while spending time recruiting and conducting several

youth camps. Prior to that, she spent three years, 2001-03, as a head coach for the annual Tiffin University Fall Classic.

On the field, Berg excelled as a player at Tiffin University. A three-year starter at third base, she helped lead Tiffin to consecutive AMC Championships (2002 and 2003) and three straight AMC Regional Finals (2001-03). As a junior, she was named to the Louisville Slugger/NFCA NAIA All-Great Lakes Region Team and All-AMC First Team. Berg twice earned both AMC and NAIA Scholar-Athlete honors, as well as being named a 2003 NFCA All-American Scholar-Athlete.

JAIME DACEY

Jaime Dacey enters her first year as a Division I assistant coach. A four-year standout at Shippensburg, she led her team to two NCAA Division II National Championships and three Regional Tournaments. Dacey finished her collegiate career the program's leader in career batting average (.420), triples (23), RBIs (156) and is tied for first in career stolen bases (49). A multiple First Team All-PSAC and First Team All-Region, she additionally ranked first among Shippensburg's single-season leaders in hits (78), triples (11), RBIs (58), and slugging percentage (.852). She also earned ASA Women's Majors Fastpitch All-American in both 2004 and 2005 after helping Storm USA to a second and third place finish in 2004 and 2005, respectively. Dacey also is a current member of the Philadelphia Force of the National Pro Fastpitch League.

TERRI ADAMS

A familiar face around the Atlantic 10, **Terri Adams** comes to Hawk Hill after spending the previous season at Fordham University.

In her lone season with the Rams as an assistant coach, Adams helped them to a 37-23

overall record, a 13-5 finish in the Atlantic 10 and a berth in the conference tournament. Working primarily with the pitchers, Adams helped Fordham finish fourth in the A-10 in earned run average (3.05) and second in strikeouts (322).

Prior to joining the Rams, Adams spent nine months helping establish the expansion Philadelphia Force of the National Pro Fastpitch league. Serving as assistant coach and director of player personnel, Coach Adams began her Division I coaching career as an assistant coach at city-rival Temple University from 1998 to 2005. Working with the Owls, she helped them to a 175-208 overall record and a 76-54 mark in the A-10 over eight seasons. From 2000-04, Temple advanced to five straight Atlantic 10 Tournaments, won the 2004 Atlantic 10 Championship and the program's first ever berth in the NCAA Tournament. That same season, Adams coached pitcher Kim Watkins to A-10 Pitcher of the Year, A-10 First Team and All-Mid-Atlantic Region honors.

She also spent nine years coaching the Lehigh Valley Renegades, helping them collect six Pennsylvania ASA State Championships and eight berths in the ASA National Tournament.
