THIS WEEK

Saint Louis' defense of its Atlantic 10 Championship crown begins on Friday, Nov. 16, when the third-seeded Billikens take on No. 6 George Washington at 4 p.m. (CT) in the first round of the 26th annual A-10 Volleyball Championship at Halton Arena in Charlotte, N.C. SLU, which will be looking for a second-straight NCAA Tournament berth as well, enters the tournament with 12 wins in its last 13 matches. This season, the Bills are 4-3 against the tournament field with two losses to #16 Dayton and one at Xavier.

LAST TIME OUT

The Billikens (22-6, 10-3 A-10) capped their second-straight 20-win campaign with a pair of road victories last weekend. SLU downed Pitt 3-1 in non-conference action last Friday before dispatching A-10 foe Duquesne 3-1 in the regular-season finale on Saturday.

BILLS IN THE TOURNEY

This will be Saint Louis' second appearance in the A-10 Championship after failing to qualify in 2005, its first season in the league. Last year, the third-seeded Billikens rattled off three wins in three days to capture the first A-10 Championship title in program history. SLU opened the tournament with a 3-0 win over No. 6 Fordham. Then the Bills downed No. 2 Temple 3-1 to advance to the title match. Saint Louis turned away host Dayton, this time 3-1, for the second time in a little over a week to earn the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, also a first for the Billiken volleyball program. **Sammi McCloud** was selected as Most Outstanding Player at the championship, while **Whitney Behrens** and **Whitney Roth** each earned a spot on the All-Championship team.

SCOUTING THE COLONIALS

George Washington (13-16, 5-8) earned a spot in the A-10 Championship after finishing in a tie for second place with Fordham and Charlotte in the East Division of the league. The Colonials, who qualified for the tournament for the first time in the last three seasons, are the No. 6 seed since Fordham swept them during the regular season. GW is coming off a 3-1 win over the 49ers in the regular-season finale. Senior outside hitter Janine Brown leads the squad with 4.53 kills and 3.60 digs per game. In 2007 A-10 contests, Brown ranks third in the league with 4.29 kills per game. Head coach Jojit Coronel owns a 119-114 career and GW record. The Billikens easily handled the Colonials 30-17, 30-18, 30-18 in Washington, D.C., on Oct. 21. SLU leads the all-time series 4-1 with its only loss coming in the series opener in 1992. The Bills were shut out in that match 3-0. This season the Colonials are 1-6 against the A-10 Championship field.

TWICE AS NICE

For the second time in head coach Anne Kordes' tenure, the Billikens have reached the 20-win plateau after finishing the regular season with a 22-6 ledger. In 2006, Saint Louis finished with a 22-9 record. SLU has achieved 16 20-win campaigns since the program began in 1975. The Bills have finished with a program-record 31 victories four times.

SCOUTING THE MUSKETEERS

If the Billikens get by GW, Xavier (22-8, 11-2), which earned a first-round bye as the No. 2 seed, awaits them in the semifinals. Saint Louis halted the Musketeers' nine-match win streak, and handed them their first conference loss of the season, with a 30-20, 30-28, 30-24 victory on Oct. 26 in St. Louis. XU finished just ahead of the Billikens in the West Division race with two losses, one to #16 Dayton and the other to Saint Louis. Senior middle blocker Jill Quayle leads the squad with 3.82 kills and 1.34 blocks per game. Through matches on Nov. 4, Quayle ranked 11th in NCAA Division I with a .410 hitting percentage. Sophomore outside hitter Kelly Ruth trails with 3.47 kills per game and boasts a team-best 3.68 digs per game. In A-10 matches, Quayle ranks second with a .445 hitting percentage and is sixth with 3.88 kills per game. Head coach Floyd Deaton is 373-216 in 18 seasons at Xavier. The Billikens hold a narrow 11-9 lead in the all-time series. The Musketeers downed Saint Louis 30-25, 31-29, 30-26 on Sept. 22, less than 24 hours after the Bills dropped a 3-2 heartbreaker at #18 Dayton in the A-10 opener. SLU returned the favor on Oct. 26 when it downed XU 3-0. The Musketeers are 5-2 against the tournament field this season.

THE A-10 FIELD

In other first-round A-10 Championship action, fourth-seeded Temple takes on No. 5 Fordham at 6:30 p.m. (CT). The Owls (14-17, 9-4), who finished first in the East Division, have won the league championship four times, last in 2002. Fordham (15-19, 5-8) is making its second-straight appearance in the A-10 Championship after finishing in a three-way tie in the East this season. #16 Dayton (28-1, 12-1), the nation's winningest team this season, earned the championship's top seed after putting together the best record in either division this season. The Flyers, who have won four of the last five championships, earned a first-round bye as the result of the No. 1 seed.

SIMPLY THE BEST

The Billikens' .257 hitting percentage this season is the best offensive clip in program history. The previous standard of .254 was established by the 1983 squad. Additionally, SLU's 20.89 points per game in 2007 is a program record. The 1998 team held the previous mark of 20.50.

AMONG THE DIVISION I ELITE

Through matches as of Nov. 4, two Billikens are ranked among the top 25 Division I statistical leaders. **Bridget Fonke** is 19th with 0.61 aces per game, and **Whitney Roth** is 24th with 12.88 assists per game.

LEAGUE LEADERS

With regular-season action complete, two Billikens are statistical leaders in the A-10. **Whitney Roth** leads the league with 13.07 assists per game, while **Bridget Fonke** is first in points per game (5.16). Meanwhile, **Sutton Lasater** ranks second in hitting percentage (.352) and blocks per game (1.24). As a team, SLU leads the A-10 with a .257 hitting percentage, 14.98 assists per game, 2.68 blocks per game and 16.29 kills per game. The Bills rank second to Dayton in opponent hitting percentage (.167) and service aces per game (1.92).

KICKIN' IT UP A NOTCH

After missing five early regular-season matches due to injury, **Sammi McCloud** took her game to another level when A-10 action began. In conference-only matches, the sophomore outside hitter ranks fourth in the league with 4.11 kills per game and is sixth with 4.52 points per game.

A LITTLE ASSIST-ANCE

Sophomore setter **Whitney Roth** is well on her way to breaking the school record of 3,284 career assists. As a freshman last season, she shattered SLU's single-season assists record (1,528). With the 2007 regular season complete, she ranks fifth on the single-season chart with 1,334 assists. Roth also ranks third on the career assist list with 2,862, needing only 55 to overtake Sandy Kittel's 2,916 assists for second place.

IN ELITE COMPANY

Senior **Sutton Lasater** is just the fourth Billiken in school history to compile more than 1,000 kills and 500 blocks for her career. Former Billiken standouts Julie Tretten (1994-97), Colleen Hunter (1999-2002) and Laura Risley (1996-99) are the only other SLU players to accomplish the feat. Lasater enters the A-10 Championship with 1,167 kills and 522 blocks.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Saint Louis players have compiled 19 double-doubles this season. The feat was most recently accomplished by **Sammi McCloud** (21 kills, 18 digs) in the Billikens' 3-1 win at Duquesne on Nov. 10. **Whitney Roth** leads the charge with 10 double-doubles in 2007 while McCloud has eight and **Bridget Fonke** has one. McCloud is also the last Billiken to tally a triple-double. In 2006, she had 11 kills, 10 digs and 10 assists against Southeast Missouri State. Roth flirted with a triple-double with 46 assists, 12 digs and seven kills in a win over IUPUI earlier this season.

WITNESS TO HISTORY

Fans in attendance at Saint Louis' match against Connecticut on Sept. 8 witnessed the highest-scoring game in school history. The Billikens scored 37 points to the Huskies' 35 for the match victory in game four.

HOME SWEET HOME

SLU, which went 8-1 at home in 2007, completed its tenure at the Bauman-Eberhardt Center on Nov. 1 with a 3-0 win over Duquesne. Since 1988, the Billikens are 164-83 at the facility for a .664 win percentage. SLU's longest winning streak at the Bauman-Eberhardt Center was 15 matches from Sept. 3, 1988 to Sept. 2, 1989. The Bills were unbeaten in 12 matches at home in 1988. Starting in 2008, Saint Louis will play its home matches at Chaifetz Arena, currently under construction on the eastern edge of the SLU campus at the corner of Laclede and Compton avenues.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM

In 2007, when Saint Louis' matches go three games the Billikens are 14-2. SLU has also captured wins in five of its seven four-game matches. Meanwhile, the Bills are also 3-2 when forced to play five games with both losses coming against ranked teams - then-#23 LSU and then-#18 Dayton.

TOP 10 ATTENDANCE

The crowd of 632 fans at SLU's match against Xavier on Oct. 26 was the ninth-largest volleyball crowd in Bauman-Eberhardt history. The largest crowd to witness a match at the Bauman-Eberhardt Center was on Nov. 12, 2004, when 1,137 people watched the Billikens take on TCU. Four of the top 10 attendance marks have occurred since Anne Kordes became head coach prior to the 2004 season.

SMOKIN' ACES

SLU has aced the competition 194 times this season, twice as many times as its been aced by the competition (97). The Billikens are serving up 1.92 aces per game while the competition is at just 0.96 per game. Their 194 aces rank 12th on SLU's single-season aces list.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The road hasn't been kind to Saint Louis this season, but it has gotten a little nicer as the season has progressed. All but one of the Billikens' losses this season have come at their opponent's facility. The Bills hope that works in their favor at this week's A-10 Championship in Charlotte this week as the 49ers did not qualify for the tournament so all game will be at a neutral site. SLU is 8-5 on the road, 6-0 when taking on an opponent at a neutral site and 8-1 at home in 2007.

WILDCAT CLASSIC

SLU downed Western Michigan 3-0 before easily handling Drake by the same score at the Wildcat Classic in Evanston, Ill. But the Billikens struggled against host Northwestern in the tournament finale. They dropped the first game 30-26 before the Wildcats handed them a 30-15 loss, their worst defeat of the season. The Bills rallied for a 30-28 win in game three before succumbing 30-20 for a second-place finish. Middle blocker **Sutton Lasater** and setter **Whitney Roth** were named to the All-Tournament team.

SANTO BENTO VOLLEYBALL INVITATIONAL

Saint Louis captured its home opener and then some when it won all three of its matches at its Santo Bento Volleyball Invitational. The Bills defeated SEMO, IUPUI and unbeaten UConn to win the tournament title. The last time SLU won its home opener was 2005's shut out of Oakland in the Billiken Invitational. **Sutton Lasater** and **Bridget Fonke** garnered All-Tournament team accolades, while **Whitney Behrens** was named MVP.

RADISSON HOTEL INVITATIONAL

The Billikens won three matches in less than 24 hours to capture the title of the Radisson Hotel Invitational. Saint Louis downed host Bradley in three games to open the tournament. Then Montana presented a monumental challenge for the Bills, who were without two key players due to injury. After dropping the first two games, SLU rallied to win three straight for their first come-from-behind win of the season. Saint Louis completed the tournament with a 3-0 win over Western Illinois. Libero **Whitney Behrens** garnered tournament MVP honors, while outside hitter **Bridget Fonke** and setter **Whitney Roth** each earned their second All-Tournament team honors of the season.

MIZUNO TIGER CLASSIC

SLU enjoyed an exceptional start to the season at the Mizuno Tiger Classic in Baton Rouge, La. The Bills shattered the school record for hitting percentage with a .532 effort in the season-opening 3-0 win over Louisiana-Monroe. The previous record of .453 was established in 1995. SLU then easily handled New Orleans 3-0 before facing #23 LSU in the finale. The match went back and forth with the Tigers and Billikens splitting four games to force a fifth. LSU hit .533 to SLU's .053 in game five for the 15-7 game and 3-2 match victory. SLU's **Bridget Fonke** and **Whitney Roth** were named to the All-Tournament team.

COACH ANNE KORDES

Head coach **Anne Kordes** is in her fourth season as head coach and has compiled a 73-48 record. In 2006, she led the Billikens to the program's first NCAA Tournament berth and was selected as the A-10 Coach of the Year. The Billikens won the A-10 Championship and a share of the 2006 A-10 regular-season title, the first for the program since 1989. Kordes has coached two All-Americans, the Northeast Region Freshman of the Year, three All-Region picks, four All-Conference first-team selections, five conference All-Rookie selections and one league Rookie of the Year. In addition, under Kordes, the Billikens have had one Academic All-District selection.

GRIN & BEHR IT

Sophomore libero **Whitney Behrens** (St. Louis, Mo. / Incarnate Word) registered 14 digs and two assists in the Duquesne victory ... posted a match-high tying 13 digs with an assist at Pitt.

BENT BUT NOT BOKEN

Freshman outside hitter **Megan Boken** (Wheaton, Ill. / St. Francis) collected six digs and an assist at Duquesne ... had five digs, two assists and a kill in the win at Pitt.

MERRY CHRISTMAN

Junior middle blocker **Lauren Christman** (Oak Brook, Ill. / Hinsdale Central) turned in five kills, four blocks, three assists and two digs in the win at Duquesne ... posted seven kills, five blocks and two digs in the Pitt victory.
