

## Saint Mary's College Intercollegiate Athletics Charitable Donation Request Form



The Saint Mary's College Athletic Department has a limited number of autographed balls (basketballs, baseballs, soccer balls, volleyballs, etc.) for the purpose of donating to charity auctions (non-profit entities) within the Bay or greater Northern California area. Tickets are also available for donation, and if approved, will be provided free of charge.

The Saint Mary's College Athletic Department must receive ALL requests four (4) weeks prior to the event or desired receipt date. However, please note that submission of a request DOES NOT guarantee fulfillment. Please fill out the Donation Request Form below. All requests will be reviewed for compliance with SMC, WCC and NCAA regulations. You will be notified if your request has been approved via email or phone. Once requests are approved, please mail a check for \$25 (made out to Saint Mary's College Athletics) to cover the cost of the ball (If requesting tickets, no payment is necessary) to:

Due to NCAA compliance issues, please do not send personal items to anyone in the Saint Mary's College Athletic Department (including coaches, administrators and student-athletes) to be autographed by either coaches or student-athletes. Requests for autographed PERSONAL items such as a T-shirt, ball, magazine, photo, letter, etc. sent via email, direct mail, phone or in-person will not be fulfilled. Any item received by the Saint Mary's Athletic Department (via mail or hand delivery) will be returned unsigned.

Coaches and student-athletes will continue to sign autographs at various Athletic Department sponsored events, such as Youth Days, Meet the Players, etc. Fans are encouraged to utilize these events to have a personal item autographed by a Saint Mary's College student athlete, team or coach. Please note that items signed on these occasions must be personalized (signed specifically to the name of the person requesting the autograph or the name of the person for whom the requestor is getting the autograph).

Saint Mary's College Athletics reserves the right to deny requests for any donations item at any time. Additionally, Saint Mary's reserves the right to request the return of any item that may appear for sale or is being used in any way that may be considered in violation of NCAA regulations.
