Boy's Basketball Camp Staff

Current TAMIU coaching staff and players will serve as Camp staff.

Shane Rinner: Shane Rinner enters his 2nd season as TAMIU Head Men's Basketball Coach fresh off a winning conference record and a post season Heartland Conference berth. Coach Rinner looks to build on these accomplishments for the Dustdevil program in 2010-2011. Before coming to TAMIU, Rinner spent 6 seasons as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Alaska Anchorage. He helped guide the Seawolves to 4 out of 6 NCAA tournaments and a NCAA Div II Final Four in 2007-2008. A 17 year veteran of collegiate coaching, Rinner has directed summer camps in California, Alaska, Virginia, Iowa, Texas, and Australia.

Bryan Weakley: Bryan Weakley enters his 2nd season as Associate Head Coach for the Dustdevil men's basketball staff. The previous 5 years he coached alongside Shane Rinner as the assistant coach at the University of Alaska Anchorage. Coach Weakley is responsible for recruiting, player development, monitoring academics, scouting, game preparation, and on court coaching.. A former NAIA All American at Biola University, Weakley has a wealth of knowledge when it comes to development of basketball players. Prior to collegiate coaching he owned his own basketball school and also was the developmental coach for the London Towers Professional Basketball team.

Steve Mitchell: Steve Mitchell enters his 2nd season as Assistant Coach for the Dustdevil men's basketball staff. His coaching responsibilities include team travel, scheduling, on court coaching, scouting, and game preparation, and recruiting. A former Academic All American and NCAA Div II tournament participant, Mitchell has worked many basketball camps including the prestigious NBC camps.
