

THE JIM SCHLOSSNAGLE ERA

TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- TCU is the only program to have appeared in each of the last four College World Series
- TCU is one of just two programs to have appeared in the College World Series in five of the last eight years (2010, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017)
- TCU is one of nine programs to appear in 13 of the last 14 regionals and just one of three programs to appear in seven of the last nine super regionals
- TCU is one of just four schools to host a Super Regional for the third time in the last four years
- TCU is one of only two schools to appear in the last four Super Regionals
- TCU has the most wins (615) in the state of Texas since 2004
- TCU's 150 wins the last three seasons are tied for the most in the nation, while the 198 wins over the last four years are second nationally
- TCU's 54 victories in 2010 were the second-most in Division I
- Has 18 total conference championships (9 regular season; 8 tournament titles)
- One of five teams to host seven of the last nine NCAA Regionals
- Finished ranked in the top five five times: No. 3 in 2010, No. 5 in 2014, No. 4 in 2015, No. 3 in 2016 and No. 4 in 2017
- Finished the 2009 season ranked No. 11 and No. 15 in 2012
- Recorded the top 13 win totals in school history, including a school-record 54 wins in 2010 (39, 2004; 41, 2005; 39, 2006; 44, 2008; 40, 2009; 43, 2011; 40, 2012; 48, 2014; 51, 2015; 49, 2016; 50, 2017)
- TCU was one of just seven schools to tally at least 50 wins in 2015 and one of just six in 2017
- TCU won five consecutive conference tournament titles from 2004-08 (2 in C-USA, 3 in MWC)
- Won every conference regular season title as members of the Mountain West
- In seven seasons in the MWC, the Frogs won seven regular season crowns and four tournament titles
- All of the top 10 crowds have come over the last five seasons
- TCU has ranked No. 1 among private schools in attendance each of the last seven seasons
- The Frogs have been in the top 11 in attendance nationally each of the last seven seasons
- Recorded 38 victories against Top-10 teams
- Led the nation in ERA in 2014 with a 2.22 ERA and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA
- TCU's 2.93 ERA over the last four seasons is fifth in the NCAA
- TCU ranks second nationally with 38 shutouts over the last four seasons
- Had a pitcher lead the nation in wins in 2005, 2006 and 2010
- TCU ranks seventh nationally with 416 stolen bases over the last four years

INDIVIDUAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Head coach Jim Schlossnagle was the 2016 Baseball America National Coach of the Year and the 2010 NCBWA National Coach of the Year
- Schlossnagle was the manager of the 2013 Collegiate National Team and was also an assistant coach with USA Baseball in 2006
- Kirk Saarloos was the 2016 D1Baseball.com Assistant Coach of the Year
- Nine Horned Frogs have played for the Collegiate National Team, including three in 2013
- Matt Purke was named the National Freshman Pitcher of the Year in 2010
- Bryan Holaday was the 2010 Johnny Bench Award winner
- Lance Broadway named TCU and Conference USA Male Athlete of the Year in 2005
- Had five conference Freshmen of the Year (Chad Huffman in 2004, Matt Purke in 2010, Preston Morrison, 2012, Connor Wanhanen, 2015, Luken Baker, 2016)
- Had five conference Pitchers of the Year (Lance Broadway, 2005, Jake Arrieta, 2006, Steven Maxwell, 2010, Preston Morrison, 2012/ 2014)
- Had two Conference Player of the Year (Cody Jones, 2015; Evan Skoug, 2017)
- Have had 76 Conference Player/Pitcher/Newcomer of the Week honors
- Had six National Player of the Week honors
- Had 105 All-Conference selections, including 11 honorees in 2007, 12 in 2014 and 14 in 2015
- 45 players named to the conference all-tournament team
- 84 players named to the Conference Academic Honor Roll
- Had a finalist for the Roger Clemens Award, the Brooks Wallace Award and the Dick Howser Trophy
- Has produced 20 Freshman All-Americans
- Has had 20 All-Americans, including three in 2010 and 2014 and four in 2015
- 65 players have been drafted in the MLB draft, including a school-record eight in 2011 and 2015
- Three first-round draft picks: Lance Broadway, 2005; Andrew Cashner, 2008; Brandon Finnegan, 2014
- 17 players have been drafted in the first 200 picks of the draft over the last 14 seasons
- TCU has had 24 players drafted in the first nine rounds of the last 11 drafts
- Has had 13 players appear in a Major League baseball game
- Matt Carpenter (St. Louis Cardinals) is a three-time MLB All-Star at two different positions
- Jake Arrieta was the 2015 National League Cy Young Award winner and a 2016 World Series winner
- Brandon Finnegan made history in 2014 becoming the first player to pitch in both the CWS and the MLB World Series in the same season
