SEASON STORYLINES

- Several websites and media outlets have TCU in their "Way too Early" 2017-18 rankings: Yahoo! 17, USA Today 22, SI: 24, SB Nation: 29
- TCU returns all five starters and its top six scorers from last season's team that won seven of its last eight games and the 2017 NIT
- TCU returns 79 percent of its scoring and 79 percent of its rebounding from last season's team
- One season after winning its first postseason tournament, TCU will try to make the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1998
 - Since 1985, 58 percent of the teams that won the NIT made the NCAA Tournament the following season
- Desmond Bane (USA) and Lat Mayen (Australia) were invited to their country's U19 training camp during the summer
- TCU got a jump-start to the season when it took a 10-day trip to Australia, Aug. 5-16.
 - The squad went 5-0, while visiting Melbourne and Sydney. Australia native Kouat Noi led the team in scoring with 14.0 ppg.
- On July 27, TCU was ranked No. 9 in ESPN's Summer Preseason BPI Rankings.

BEST OF 2016-17

- TCU defeated an AP No. 1 team for the first time in school history when it beat No. 1 Kansas on March 9.
- TCU finished eighth in the Big 12, the highest in its five seasons in the league. TCU was picked 10th in the preseason poll.
- TCU's 24 wins ties for the second-most in a season (1951-52: 24-4, 1986-87: 24-7). It's the most wins in a season since the 1997-98 season (27-6).
- TCU reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since 21 wins in the 2004-05 season.
- TCU won a postseason game for the first time since 2012 and obtained its first NIT win and postseason road win since 2005.
- TCU's home average attendance of 6,127 was the second-best in school history and the most since 6,341, the school record set in 1986-87. It's total attendance of a 128,658 was the most in school history.
