2016-17 TENNESSEE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES OF INTEREST

TEAM

- Tennessee returns four starters from last year's squad, which wound up 22-14 but made its way to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- UT played its best basketball at the end of the season, winning six of seven before falling in the Sioux Falls Regional Championship game to Syracuse after losing point guard Jordan Reynolds (head injury) in the Sweet 16 win over Ohio State and seeing Bashaara Graves and Andraya Carter each suffer broken fingers in that regional semifinal game as well.
- The Big Orange women were 8-8 in league play a year ago and seeded seventh in the SEC Tournament. Tennessee advanced to the tourney semifinal round before bowing out.

PLAYERS

- The Lady Vols' top returnee is 6-1 redshirt junior guard Diamond DeShields, who averaged 14.3 points, 5.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.6 steals despite an injury that limited her effectiveness all season long.
- DeShields was named AP All-SEC Second Team and made the SEC and NCAA Sioux Falls Regional All-Tournament Teams.
- Redshirt junior center Mercedes Russell returns after averaging 9.9 points and 8.3 rebounds, blocking 66 shots (No. 8 season total in UT history) and shooting 55 percent from the field last season.
- Russell finished third all-time among UT sophomores with 11 double-doubles, trailing only Candace Parker (21) and Chamique Holdsclaw (16), and made the NCAA Sioux Falls All-Regional Team after missing all of 2014-15 due to surgery on both feet.
- Tennessee's other two returning starters are senior point guard Jordan Reynolds (4.8 ppg., 4.0 rpg., led team with 89 assts. vs. 55 turnovers) and junior guard/forward Jaime Nared (8.3 ppg., 4.8 rpg. after missing first nine games with a broken hand).
- UT's top newcomer is Schaquilla Nunn, a 6-foot-3 forward who averaged a double-double of 11.2 points and 10.3 rebounds in her three seasons with Winthrop University before graduating and transferring to Tennessee.
- The Lady Vols graduated four-year starter Bashaara Graves (10.3 ppg., 8.3 rpg.), a second-round WNBA pick by Minnesota.
- Nia Moore (playing professionally overseas) and Jasmine Jones both graduated, Andraya Carter retired for medical reasons and Te'a Cooper (team's fourth-leading scorer as a freshman last season) will miss the 2016-17 campaign due to a knee injury.

COACHES

- Holly Warlick's 108-34 record (.761) gives her the seventh-highest victory total ever recorded during the first four years on the job by an NCAA Division I women's basketball coach.
- Warlick's career (.761) and SEC (.781, 50-14) winning percentages rank her first among all SEC women's head coaches.
- Her Lady Vols made it to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2013, 2015 and 2016, making Warlick and Leon Barmore of Louisiana Tech the only skip-pers to direct their programs to three NCAA Elite Eight appearances in their first four seasons as head coaches.
- Tennessee has claimed three SEC trophies in Warlick's first four seasons, winning regular-season crowns in 2013 and 2015 and claiming the tournament title in 2014.
- Sharrona Reaves joined the staff as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator after holding the same position at West Virginia. Former UT football administrator Heather Ervin was hired as director of recruiting and player personnel to assist.

- Named national freshman of the year by a number of organizations, honorable mention All-American (AP & Full Court) and All-ACC First Team and All-Freshman in 2014-15.
