No. 30 Lady Vol Tennis Heads To Atlanta, Ga., For NCAA Tournament

The 30th-ranked Lady Vols are heading to Atlanta, Ga., for a regional hosted by Georgia Tech. Tennessee (12-12) takes on Ivy League runner-up and 45th-ranked Penn (12-5) at 2 p.m. on Friday. That contest is preceded by the hosts and sixth-ranked Georgia Tech (21-5) playing Southeastern Louisiana (22-3) at 11 a.m. The two winners play at noon on Saturday for a trip to the NCAA Team Championships in Stanford, Calif., to be contested from May 18-22.

The Big Orange finished 6-5 in Southeastern Conference play, once again claiming a winning conference record, which they have done every season since 2000 when the league commenced determining its champion through a round-robin format. The Lady Vols have played a challenging slate to date, as 20 of 24 matches so far have come against top-75 opposition, including 15 against top-35 teams. Tennessee has claimed eight wins over nationally-ranked opposition.

The Orange and White are coming off a successful SEC Tournament which saw the Lady Vols advance to the semifinals for the first time in three years. In the quarterfinal round, UT rallied from a 3-0 deficit to then-No. 24 Georgia with four straight singles wins.

Noteworthy

About Penn

The University of Pennsylvania earned an at-large berth from the Ivy League after finishing second with a 6-1 mark. The Quakers have taken on a challenging slate as well, as evidenced by playing eight straight matches versus ranked opposition early in the campaign. Penn has played in four NCAA Tournaments, last making the field in 2003, the third of three consecutive appearances. They first qualified in 1996 and are 2-4 all-time in NCAA Tournament play.

About Georgia Tech

Georgia Tech, the Atlantic Coast Conference champions for the second straight year, has been ranked near the top all season, reaching as high as third on Feb. 28. Last season, Georgia Tech (6-6 all-time mark in NCAA Tournament play) advanced to the Round of 16. The Yellow Jackets have now qualified for seven straight tournaments after having never played in the tournament previously.

About Southeastern Louisiana

Southeastern Louisiana fell in a first round contest, 4-0, to Tulane in its initial NCAA Tournament appearance. The Lady Lions claimed their second consecutive Southland Conference Tournament and will enter the NCAA Tournament with a 13-match winning streak. Southeastern qualified for its first tournament last season.

UT Faces Top-Notch Schedule

The 2006 Lady Vol dual-match schedule is top of the line, as Tennessee has played 11 contests versus teams currently ranked in the top-25 nationally. Seventeen of the 24 matches played have come against top-50 squads.

Noteworthy

A total of 17 matches on UT's regular-season slate of 24 contests were versus teams who played in the 2006 NCAA Tournament. Five of the Lady Vols' 12 losses have come against teams ranked in the top 10 currently: No. 2 Notre Dame, No. 4 Florida (twice), No. 8 North Carolina and No. 10 Duke. All of UT's setbacks have come against schools currently ranked among the top 52 nationally.

SEC Success

The Lady Vols finished 6-5 in Southeastern Conference regular-season play, dropping their last match versus then-No. 24 Georgia on April 15, 6-1. This season marks the seventh straight year the Big Orange have recorded a winning SEC record.

The Big Orange began the league slate of matches with a dominating 7-0 win over No. 46 LSU on March 3. The 7-0 score was just the eighth in SEC history for the Big Orange (since the NCAA went to a seven-point scoring format in 2001), the first in an SEC season-opening contest and the initial one in any league contest since March 5, 2004 (Arkansas).

Tennessee's second match of its SEC-opening weekend saw the Big Orange pull out a tight 4-3 decision over 59th-ranked Arkansas. The teams were tied, 2-2, before UT tallied the next two points to clinch the team win.

After rebounding from a 7-0 loss to then-No. 6 Florida, the Lady Vols took 2-0 and 3-1 leads over South Carolina before USC rallied to tie the score at 3-all. At that point, junior **Blakeley Griffith** (Middleburg, Va.) finished off an impressive comeback for a 1-6, 6-2, 6-1 win at No. 3 over Danielle Wiggins, to clinch the victory for Tennessee.

Against the Crimson Tide of Alabama, the Lady Vols fell behind, 2-1, before Tennessee rallied to earn the victory. After dropping the first two singles matches, the Lady Vols took control, winning the remaining four to clinch the team win. UT and Auburn were tied, 2-2, before the Lady Vols claimed the last three singles matches in their contests on March 26.

After rebounding from a 4-3 home loss to No. 60 Ole Miss on April 7 the weekend previous, UT dominated Mississippi State, 7-0, two days later.

Moving On Up

After competing at Nos. 2 and 3 singles, **Melissa Schaub** moved up to the No. 1 spot for the first time in her career versus Kentucky on April 2. The senior fell to No. 39 Kim Coventry, just missing earning the biggest win of her career (based on opponent's national ranking), 6-4, 3-6, 1-0 (10-5). In the match against Mississippi State on "Senior Day," Schaub recorded her first victory in the top spot, 6-4, 6-4, over Renee Joseph.

She attained the most significant triumph of her career on April 21 in an SEC Tournament quarterfinal contest against then-No. 24 Georgia. With the team score tied, 3-3, she completed an impressive 7-5, 7-6 (7-4) victory to move the Lady Vols to the semifinals for the first time in three years. Schaub rallied from a 5-3 deficit in the first set and a 4-2 deficit in the second-set tiebreaker. The win came against 22nd-ranked Natalie Frazier, the highest-ranked player that the senior has defeated in her time at Rocky Top.

Impressive Win For Jones

Junior **Victoria Jones** (Tyne & Wear, U.K.) earned the biggest win of her Lady Vol singles career (based on opponent rank) on Jan. 29 with a 6-1, 3-6, 6-3 victory over 29th-ranked Hala Sufi of Purdue. She has played 17 Lady Vol matches from the No. 1 position, including 11 versus nationally-ranked opponents. Her most dominating triumph in the No. 1 position was by 6-1, 6-1 scores on March 3 against Mykala Hedberg of LSU in the SEC

season-opening contest. Overall in 2005-06, Jones has taken on 16 elite players.

In Tennessee's clutch 4-3 win over then-No. 24 Georgia (rallying from a 3-0 deficit), Jones started the dramatic comeback with a convincing 6-1, 6-1 victory over Caroline Basu at No. 2. She has made quick work of her opposition in numerous matches of late, having won in straight sets in four of her last eight contests (going 5-3 in that span).

Griffith in the Clutch

Junior **Blakeley Griffith** (Middleburg, Va.) was a part of a pair of clutch singles and doubles wins on March 12, as the Lady Vols defeated No. 19 South Carolina, 4-3.

In doubles play, she and partner **Victoria Jones** (Tyne & Wear, U.K.) played the last match to conclude. The doubles point rested on the outcome and the two rallied from an 8-7 deficit for a dramatic 9-8 (14-12) victory.

At No. 3 singles, Griffith was on the cusp of winning the second set to tie the match when South Carolina tied the team score, 3-3. At that point, she finished off USC's Danielle Wiggins in that stanza before taking the third set comfortably for a 1-6, 6-2, 6-1 victory.

The junior went 2-1 in the conference tournament, giving the Lady Vols a 3-0 lead in the match against Auburn after defeating Irina Pljusznyin, 6-1, 6-2. In the quarterfinal contest with Georgia, Griffith toppled Evgenia Subbotina, 2-6, 6-4, 6-2,

to tie the overall score, 3-3. The Lady Vols went on to take the match, 4-3.

She has played one of the most challenging schedule of any Lady Vol, taking on 15 nationally-ranked opponents. Ten of those matches came in the dual-match portion of the schedule.

Her biggest win (based on opponent's ranking) came on Jan. 21 against No. 46 Caitlin Collins of North Carolina by 6-1, 7-5 scores. That victory ended an uncharacteristic six-match (and 12-set) losing streak for the junior.

Sensational Schutte

Sophomore **Ghizela Schutte** (Cape Town, South Africa) played a big part of Tennessee's 5-2 win over then-No. 11 Texas on March 15. Teamed with senior **Melissa Schaub** (Lexington, Ohio), the pair clinched the doubles point with a 9-8 (7-3) victory at No. 1 over Mia Marovic and Courtney Zauft.

In singles, the Lady Vols completed the dramatic triumph when, with a 3-1 lead, Schutte finished off No. 125 Courtney Zauft, 7-6 (8-6), 6-3. The win was Schutte's first-ever over a nationally-ranked opponent.

Texas is the defending NCAA National Finalist and the 2006 USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Finalist. The Longhorns had claimed the first 11 meetings between the teams.

Schutte went 2-0 in the SEC Tournament, clinching the 4-0 win for the Lady Vols over Auburn by defeating Ashley Cowart, 6-1, 6-2. In the quarterfinal match with Georgia, the sophomore

Schutte Hits The 20-Win Mark

Sophomore **Ghizela Schutte** (Ninapark, South Africa) currently has the most wins on the Lady Vol squad.

Schutte owns a 22-12 record (.647) and has seen action on primarily the fourth and fifth courts. Schutte has won nine of the last 11 single matches, including a key win over Kelley Hyndman of Georgia, 6-4, 6-0, to help the Lady Vols claim their second team point in a dramatic 4-0 run by Tennessee after trailing the Bulldogs, 3-0, in the SEC Tournament quarterfinals.

Schutte was able to clinch her 20th victory on April 15, as she earned her squad's lone point in the 6-1 loss at Georgia with a 3-6, 6-4, (10-2) triumph over Kelley Hyndman.

Orlin Earning Impressive Record

Freshman **Samantha Orlin** (Miami, Fla.) has contributed significantly to Tennessee's success in 2005-06, compiling an 18-13 mark (.581 winning percentage), the second-best record on

the squad. She has played most of the season at No. 5, although the freshman has seen playing time at both Nos. 4 and 6.

At one point during the dual-match season, she claimed 8-of-10 contests, combining two four-match winning streaks with two setbacks in the middle. She started the 2005-06 campaign with an 8-1 mark.

Back in the Rankings

Senior **Melissa Schaub** (Lexington, Ohio) and sophomore **Ghizela Schutte** (Cape Town, South Africa) are ranked once again in doubles, coming in 52nd. This marks the second time this season the duo has been ranked (51st on April 18). The two have played together in the No. 1 doubles spot in 22-of-24 dual matches this season.

Schaub and Schutte went 12-9 in dual-matches (one contest went unfinished) and 14-11 overall. The pair has played on the No. 1 doubles court since the third match of the season.

The duo had a convincing 8-0 win on March 15 against No. 11 Texas' top doubles team of Kelly Baritot and Kendra Strohm. The love-win was the first for Griffith and Jones in any doubles contest (with any partner) since the two paired up for an 8-0

victory in their first match together on March 5, 2004. The two defeated Christian Kincannon and Iliana Pacheco of Arkansas in the third position in that match.

The 8-0 victory was the first-such result for any Lady Vol doubles team since senior **Melissa Schaub** (Lexington, Ohio) and sophomore **Ghizela Schutte** (Cape Town, South Africa) earned an identical result on Sept. 30, 2005, at the St. Mary's Classic versus Wisconsin's Nicole Beck and Liz Carpenter.

The biggest victory for the duo came in the match against the 55th-ranked doubles pair of Ilona Somers and Virginia Tomatis of Ole Miss, 8-1. The two took a commanding 7-0 lead on the way to their most impressive win on the season (based on opponent's national ranking). Schaub earned her 70th career doubles victory in the process, becoming just the 10th Lady Vol in history to reach that milestone.

Dynamic Duo

Juniors **Blakeley Griffith** (Middleburg, Va.) and **Victoria Jones** (Tyne & Wear, U.K.) finished the regular season 13-10 in dual-matches, which included a dramatic 9-8 (14-12) win in the tiebreaker over Christyn Lucas and Danielle Wiggins of South Carolina on March 12 to clinch the doubles point in the Big Orange's 4-3 victory.

The two went 14-11 overall in 2005-06 (the pair went 1-1 at the Freeman Memorial Women's Tennis Championships the week before dual matches began).

The Fall Recap

In the St. Mary's Classic in Knoxville, the Big Orange came away with a pair of singles flight titles. Sophomore **Ghizela Schutte** (Cape Town, South Africa) won the flight four title over Mallory Voelker of Purdue, 6-1, 7-5. Lady Vol freshman **Samantha Orlin** (Miami, Fla.) also picked up a title in flight six with a win over Wake Forest's Blakely Offutt, 6-1, 6-4.

Junior **Blakeley Griffith** (Middleburg, Va.) and sophomore **Bryce Marable** (Darien, Ill.) finished second and third in flights two and three, respectively.

In doubles competition, Schutte and Orlin teamed up for a 2-1 record, finishing in third place for the flight.

At the Furman Fall Classic in Greenville, S.C., every Lady Vol finished in the top three of their respective flights in singles competition. Marable claimed the flight four title with a win over Shannon Moore of Furman, 6-0, 6-4.

In doubles competition, the duo of Marable and Griffith finished on top of flight two with a win over Laura Gioia and Jacqueline Eckert of Furman, 8-4. Schutte and senior **Melissa Schaub** (Lexington, Ohio) picked up a second-place finish in flight one.

At the Wilson/ITA Regional Championships in Chapel Hill, N.C., Schutte beat Alex Jurewitz of North Carolina, 6-3, 6-2, then fell in her second match to Clemson's Maria Brito, 6-2, 6-4.

Schaub picked up a win over Meredith Giles of Eastern Kentucky, 6-2, 6-1, before falling in the second round to Clemson's Federica van Aldrichem, 6-4, 7-6.

At the SEC Coaches Tournament in Peachtree City, Ga., Schaub and Orlin teamed up in doubles action to go 3-1, finishing second place in the "A" flight.
