DID YOU KNOW?

H When Selvin Young returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown and a punt 39 yards for a score against New Mexico State in 2003, he became the first Longhorn ever to score on a punt return and a kickoff return in the same game. He also became the first Longhorn to return a punt and kickoff for a score in the same season. Jordan Shipley also accomplished the feat during the 2008 season. Young is one of four Longhorns ever to return a punt and kickoff for a touchdown during his career along with Raymond Clayborn (1973-76), Quan Cosby (2005-08) and Shipley (2004-present). Young is tied with Clayborn for career total kick returns for TDs with three. Both Young and Clayborn returned two punts and one kickoff for scores.
