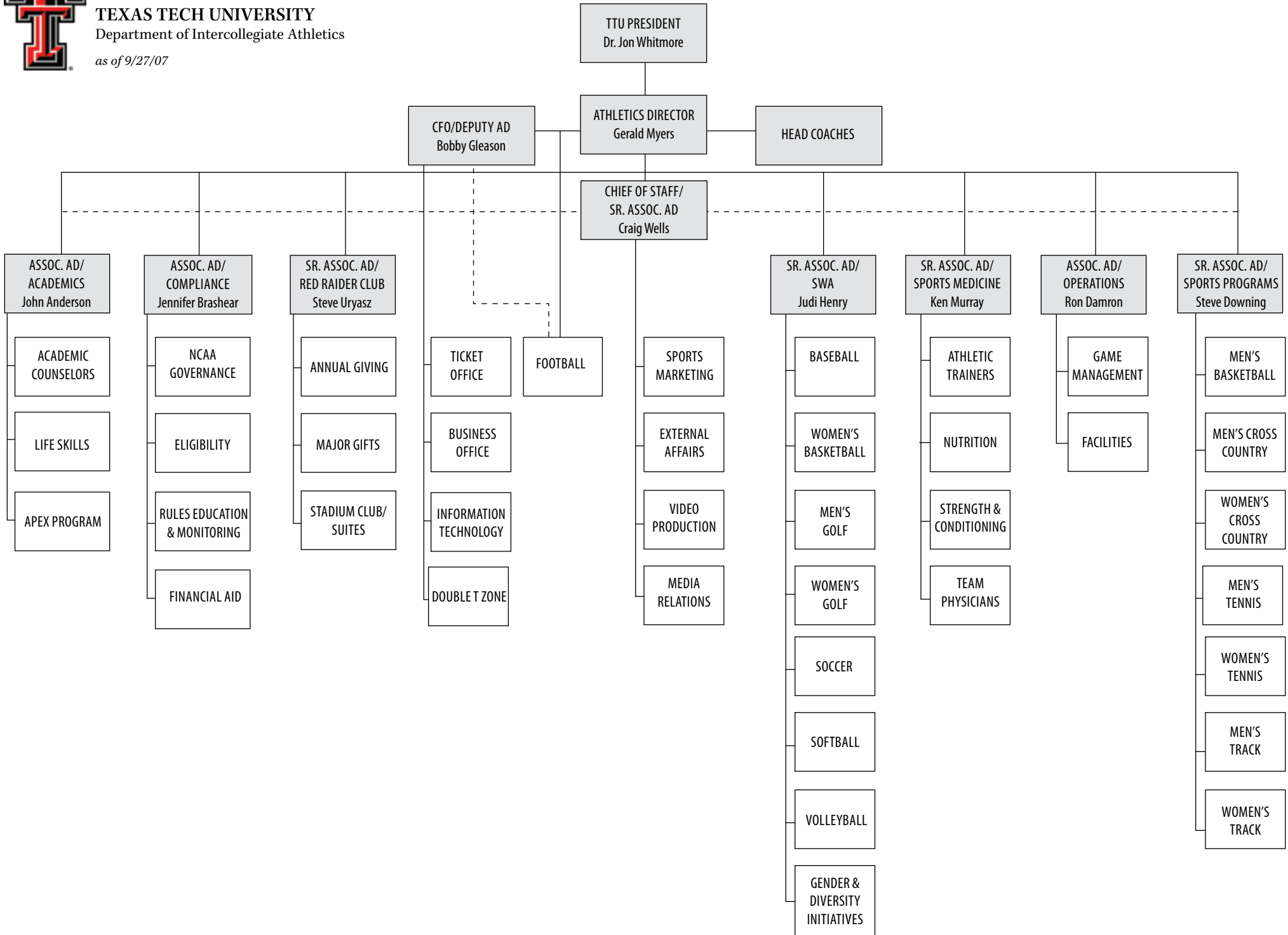


Organizational Chart
