Dear [Prospective Student-Athlete],

We are glad that you will be visiting Texas Tech University on [DATE]. It is an honor for us to have you as our guest. Our goal for this visit is for you to confirm Texas Tech as the “right fit,” both academically and athletically, and for the university (e.g., coaches, staff) to feel the same way.

The Athletics Department will provide you the opportunity to gain knowledge about academic programs, familiarize yourself with future teammates, coaches and support staff and experience what campus and community life would be like as a student-athlete at Texas Tech. Prior to your visit, we would like to inform you of our Code of Conduct by which we would like you to abide: Individuals involved in the recruiting visit will act in a responsible manner and are expected to abide by the law. The use of alcohol, drugs, sex and gambling in recruiting are prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.

We are permitted to provide you and your parents [(or legal guardian(s)] with lodging and meals. Please note however, that NCAA rules state that we cannot pay for any incidental hotel charges (e.g., phone charges, pay per use tv games, pay per view movies). Accordingly, these services will not be available unless you provide a cash deposit or credit card at the time of check-in. Further, we may provide you three complimentary admissions to home athletics contests during your visit. Complimentary admission check-in requires photo identification per NCAA rules. If you need to purchase additional tickets please contact the athletic ticket office at (806) 742-4412 and let them know you are visiting Texas Tech as an official visit recruit. The additional tickets must be purchased in advance.

Again, we are excited about your decision to visit our campus and look forward to your visit with great anticipation. Please be reminded that per NCAA rules, your visit to Texas Tech is one of your five allowed visits and is limited to 48 hours from the time you arrive on campus.
