## Cyclone Notebook

- ▶ Iowa State (13-5, 3-2) travels to Lubbock, Texas on Saturday looking for its first win at Texas Tech (7-10, 0-5) since March 1, 2000.
- ▶ Iowa State is fresh off an impressive come-from-behind victory over Oklahoma State on Wednesday...Iowa State sits alone in fourth place in the Big 12 standings at 3-2, already equalling its conference win total from last year (3-13).
- ▶ Iowa State has started conference play at 4-2 or better just seven times since 1985 (1985, 1986, 1996, 1997, 2000, 2001, 2004).
- ▶ Iowa State leads the Big 12 and ranks eighth nationally in 3-pointers per game (9.1), making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game nine times this year.
- ▶ In Big 12 play, Iowa State has made eight or more treys in all five games, averaging 9.8 3-pointers per game at a 40.2 pct. clip to pace the league in both categories.
- ▶ Iowa State is the only team in the nation to have four players with 30 or more 3-pointers: Chris Babb (43), Chris Allen (37), Scott Christopherson (33) and Tyrus McGee (30).

## Head Coach Fred Hoiberg



Fred Hoiberg – a favorite son and native of Ames, a Cyclone basketball legend, a 10-year NBA veteran and former executive with the Minnesota Timberwolves – was introduced April 28, 2010 as the 19th head men's basketball coach in Iowa State

University history.

The 39-year-old-Hoiberg led Iowa State to a 16-16 mark in his first season as a head coach, the Cyclones' first .500 or above mark since 2005-06. He was named *Basketball Times'* 2011 Rookie Coach of the Year for his efforts. Hoiberg's first ISU team set the school mark for 3-pointers made in a season (275) and featured two all-conference performers in Dante Garrett and Scott Christopherson.

It was Hoiberg's play at Hilton Coliseum in the 1990s that endeared him to Cyclone fans. One of the school's most-admired competitors, "The Mayor" averaged 15.8 points and is the school's third all-time leading scorer (1,993 points). He competed 10 years in the NBA (1996-2005) before moving into the T-Wolves front office.

## Last Time Out

- ▶ Scott Christopherson made the biggest shot of his career Wednesday night, nailing a 30-footer at the buzzer to help Iowa State down Oklahoma State, 71-68.
- ▶ Christopherson scored eight points with under three minutes left in a furious 11-2 Cyclone rally to help the home team erase a six-point deficit.
- ▶ With ISU down 66-60 with 2:50 remaining, Christopherson hit a three and followed it up with a lay-up to cut the lead to 66-65 at the 1:37 mark.
- ▶ Tyrus McGee tied the game at 68-68 with :17 seconds left on a long transition three...he then stripped Markel Brown with 0:04.2 seconds left, setting up Christopherson's bank shot to win it at the buzzer.
- ▶ It was ISU's first buzzer-beater at home since Feb. 23, 2002 when Omar Bynum made a lay-up at the horn vs. Kansas State.
- ▶ Christopherson has 3-point buzzer-beaters in his last three games...he made a half-court shot at the first-half horn vs. Missouri.
- ▶ The victory ended a four-game losing streak to the Cowboys.
- ▶ Christopherson, McGee and Royce White all had 17 points in the victory.
- ▶ McGee tied a career high with 17 points and posted career bests in 3-pointers (5) and rebounds (9).
- ▶ His overall hustle was key to the victory.
- ▶ White handed out six assists, dishing out five or more dimes in a game for the seventh time this season.
- ▶ Iowa State led at the half for the fifth time in five league games.
- ▶ Iowa State committed just nine turnovers, just the third time this season where the Cyclones had less than 10 miscues.
- ▶ The Cyclones shot 50 percent from the field, the sixth time this season where ISU made half of its shots.
- ▶ Iowa State drilled 10 3-pointers in the win...the Big 12 leader in 3-pointers per game (9.1), the Cyclones have made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game nine times this year.
- ▶ Iowa State is 10-1 when scoring 70 or more points on the season.

## Iowa State Team Quick Facts

- ▶ Iowa State won both of its games (Providence, Rice) in South Padre Island, Texas at the South Padre Island Invitational...it was the first time Iowa State went undefeated in a regular-season tournament away from home since 2005-06 (Rainbow Classic, Honolulu, Hawaii).
- ▶ Iowa State ended a seven-game losing streak to Texas (77-71, Jan. 4) and an eight-game losing streak to Texas A&M (74-50, Jan. 7) in the first week of Big 12 play.
- ▶ Iowa State won its first Big 12 opener since 2007, ending a four-year skid with a 77-71 win over Texas on Jan. 4.
- ▶ Iowa State ended a 10-game road losing streak in the Texas A&M game (Jan. 7)...it also ended a 13-game losing skid to Big 12 Texas teams on the road.
- ▶ Iowa State started Big 12 play at 2-0 for just the fifth time in school history.
- ▶ Iowa State equaled its win total in the Big 12 from the previous season after its fifth game: 3-2 in 2011-12; 3-13 in 2010-11.
- ▶ In the Fred Hoiberg era, ISU has made 10 or more 3-pointers in a game 22 times.
- ▶ Iowa State has scored 80 points or more 18 times in the Fred Hoiberg era.
- ▶ Iowa State has shot 50 percent or better 15 times in the Fred Hoiberg era.
- ▶ 69.8 percent of ISU's scoring this season is from newcomers.
- ▶ Iowa State is fifth in the Big 12 and 50th nationally in scoring at 75.3 ppg...the Cyclones have scored 80 or more points seven times.
- ▶ Iowa State is 10-1 this season when scoring 70 points or more.
- ▶ Iowa State has outrebounded 14 of 18 opponents this year.
- ▶ Iowa State ranks first in the Big 12 and eighth nationally in 3-pointers per game (9.1)...ISU is shooting 38.5 percent from 3-point range, ranking third in the Big 12 and 34th nationally.
- ▶ 42.7 percent of ISU's field goal attempts have been from beyond the arc.
- ▶ Iowa State ranks third in the Big 12 in assist/turnover ratio (1.1 a/t).
- ▶ In its five losses, Iowa State opponents have all shot over 50 percent from the field in the second half at a combined 56.6 percent clip (73-129 FG).

- ▶ Iowa State has shot 50 percent or better six times.

## Cyclone-Red Raider Quick Facts

- ▶ Texas Tech leads the all-time series vs. Iowa State at 10-9.
- ▶ The Red Raiders have won nine of the last 11 meetings in the series, including the last two contests.
- ▶ TTU won last season's meeting, 92-83 in Ames...Mike Singletary recorded 33 points for TTU, helping the Red Raiders shoot 62.5 percent in the second half.
- ▶ The Red Raiders lead the overall series in games played in Lubbock at 6-2...TTU has won five in a row in contests played in Lubbock...ISU's last win in Lubbock was an 87-79 victory on March 1, 2000.
- ▶ In two career games vs. TTU, Scott Christopherson is averaging 9.0 points and shooting 4-of-12 from 3-point range (33.3 pct.).
- ▶ TTU sophomore Jaron Nash prepped at East High School in Waterloo, Iowa.
- ▶ TTU assistant coach Jeff Kidder was the head coach at Indian Hills C.C. in Ottumwa, Iowa for six seasons...he coached former Cyclones Sean Haluska and LaRon Dendy at IHCC.

## Getting To The Line

- ▶ Iowa State has done a remarkable job of getting to the free-throw line and keeping the opposition off the charity stripe this season.
- ▶ Iowa State has shot 170 more free-throws than its opponents at a +9.4 margin.
- ▶ Iowa State is averaging 24.6 free-throws per game this year...ISU shot 16.4 free-throws per game last year.
- ▶ Iowa State has shot more free-throws than its opponents in 16 of 18 games.
- ▶ Iowa State has shot 19 or more free-throws in 15 of 18 games.
- ▶ Iowa State ranks 38th nationally in fewest personal fouls (15.9).

## The Cyclones Dig The Long Ball

- ▶ Iowa State, with its arsenal of efficient shooters dotting the lineup at all times, will thrive by the deep shot during the 2011-12 season.
- ▶ Iowa State's top four long-range gunners (Scott Christopherson, Chris Allen, Chris Babb, Tyrus McGee) have a combined 707 3-pointers in their respective collegiate careers...Allen (178), Christopherson (170) and Babb (134) have a combined 482 3-pointers in Division I.
- ▶ ISU has made 10 or more treys nine times this year and 22 times in the Hoiberg era.
- ▶ In the Northern Colorado game, Iowa State broke the school record for 3-pointers made in a game with 16.
- ▶ ISU hit 14 treys vs. Rice, tying for the 3rd-best effort in school history...four of the top six 3-point shooting games in ISU history have come in the two-year Fred Hoiberg era
- ▶ Iowa State is averaging 9.1 3-pointers per game to lead the Big 12 and rank eighth nationally in 3-pointers per game.
- ▶ Iowa State is currently the only team in the nation to have four players with 30 or more 3-pointers: Chris Babb (43), Chris Allen (37), Scott Christopherson (33) and Tyrus McGee (30).
- ▶ ISU is connecting at a 38.5 percent clip from downtown this year, ranking third in the Big 12 and 34th nationally.
- ▶ In league games only, the Cyclones lead the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (9.8) and in 3-point percentage (40.2 percent).
- ▶ ISU has made eight or more 3-pointers in all five Big 12 games.
- ▶ Iowa State has made a 3-pointer in 145 consecutive games...the last time the Cyclones were shut out from beyond the arc was on Nov. 9, 2007 vs. Winston-Salem State.
- ▶ The Cyclones led the Big 12 and ranked 13th nationally in 3-pointers made per game in 2010-11 (8.6 3fg).

## **Rebounding Improvement**

▶ Iowa State has made incredible improvement in rebounding so far this season...Iowa State had a -2.3 rebounding margin in head coach Fred Hoiberg's first season last year.

▶ The Cyclones have outrebounded 14 of 18 opponents this year, owning a +4.3 rebounding margin to rank 67th nationally.

## **White Joins Elite Company With Triple-Double**

▶ Royce White became the fourth Cyclone in school history to record a triple-double when he posted 10 pts., 18 reb. and 10 asst. in a 74-50 win at Texas A&M (1-7-12).

▶ It was the first-ever triple-double recorded by a Cyclone in a road game.

▶ White is among eight players in NCAA Division I with a triple-double this season.

▶ It was the 12th triple-double in Big 12 history and the sixth triple-double recorded by a Big 12 player vs. Big 12 competition.

▶ The 40th anniversary of the opening of Hilton Coliseum was on Dec. 2, as the first game played in Hilton Coliseum was a 71-54 win over Arizona on Dec. 2, 1971...Iowa State radio color analyst Eric Heft was a sophomore with the Cyclones and played in the game.

▶ Hilton Coliseum has long been considered one of the toughest places to play in college basketball...built in 1971, ISU has recorded a 73.5 pct. winning mark (455-164).

▶ ISU has recorded four undefeated seasons at home since Hilton was erected (1985-86, 1992-93, 1999-00, 2000-01).

▶ ISU has ranked in the top-30 nationally in attendance the last five seasons.

▶ The Cyclones were fourth in the Big 12 in attendance in 2010-11, averaging 12,110 fans per game.

## **Iowa State Inks Three In Early Signing Period**

▶ ISU received national letter of intents from three players in the November signing period: Georges Niang (6-7, 235, Fr., Methuen, Mass.), Nkereuwem Okoro (6-5, 220, Fr., Bronx, N.Y.) and Sherron Dorsey-Walker (6-4, 175, Fr., Detroit, Mich.).

▶ Niang is a consensus top-100 national recruit and is rated as one of the best power forwards in the nation...ranked No. 42 nationally by Lindy's and No. 69 by Scout.com, Niang averaged 24.2 points and 8.2 rebounds as a junior.

▶ Okoro is rated as the third-best player in New York City...Rivals.com ranked him as one of the first 10 players outside the Rivals150.

▶ Dorsey-Walker is one of the best shooters in the class of 2012 and is ranked No. 122 in the Rivals150.

## **Hoiberg To Defend "Shots From The Heart"**

▶ Iowa State head men's basketball coach Fred Hoiberg will be among 64 Division I collegiate men's basketball coaches competing in the second annual "Shots From the Heart" program sponsored by the American Heart Association.

▶ The initiative was created to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease and to raise money to benefit the American Heart Association during the 2010-11 season.

▶ Coaches will compete in a year-long free-throw shooting contest against each other in a 64-coach field.

▶ Hoiberg's decision to participate in this cause was easy to make...Hoiberg's 10-year NBA career was cut short when it was discovered he had an aneurism in his aortic root.

▶ Hoiberg won last year's tournament, making all 150 free-throws in the six matchups.

▶ Hoiberg made 227-of-228 free-throws in the entire tournament.

▶ Hoiberg defeated Northern Colorado's B.J. Hill in the first round and Rider's Tom Dempsey in the second round.

▶ He now faces Matt Brady of James Madison in the third round.

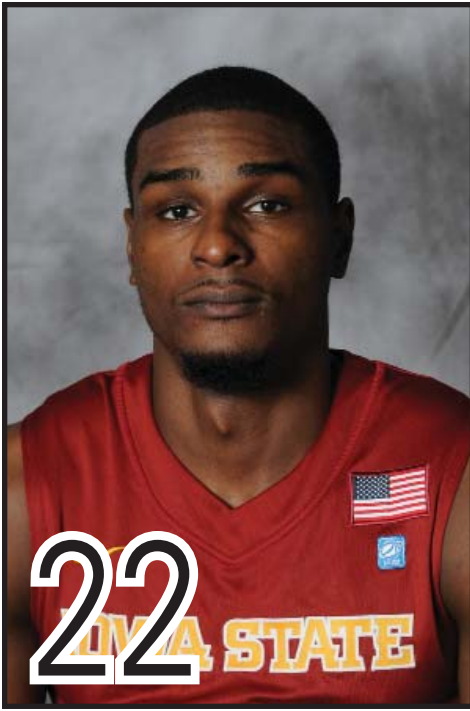

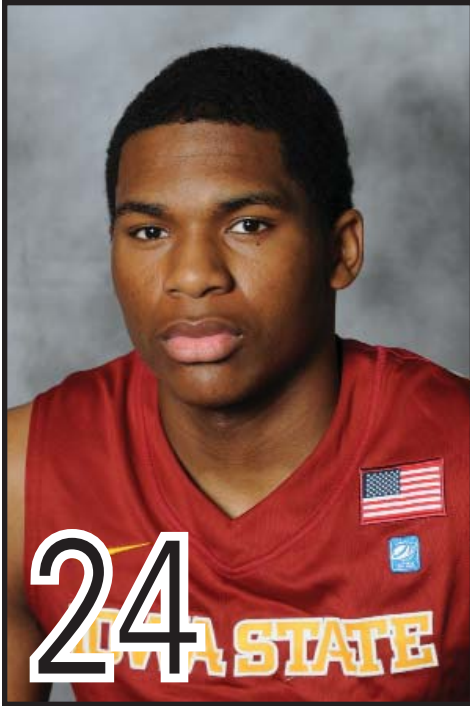
