### 2007 SCHEDULE

	<b>at SMU</b> September 3 • 3 p.m. Gerald J. Ford Stadium Dallas, Texas	ESPN ... Texas Tech leads the series 27-15 and has won 11 straight, dating back to 1989 ... the teams have faced each other four times since the Southwest Conference days, 2002-04 and 2006 ... the game marks the third in five appearances for the Red Raiders in Dallas ... additionally, the Monday tilt is the first since opening the season at Arizona State in 1999.
	<b>UTEP</b> September 8 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	The Red Raiders have won four straight against the Miners, including last year's overtime game in El Paso ... the teams meet in Lubbock for the first time since 1998 ... Texas Tech holds an 11-6-1 series advantage ... UTEP's last win in the series came back in 1957 in El Paso ... seven of the series' 18 games have been played in Lubbock.
	<b>at Rice</b> September 15 • TBA Rice Stadium Houston, Texas	Another former Southwest Conference member renews acquaintances with the Red Raiders ... Rice and Texas Tech have not played since the 1995 season ... the Red Raiders hold a 25-20-1 series lead ... the teams split the last six games between each other in SWC play, each winning on their respective home fields.
	<b>at Oklahoma State</b> September 22 • TBA Boone Pickens Stadium Stillwater, Oklahoma	Texas Tech leads the overall series 19-11-3, but has dropped games in the last two visits to Stillwater ... the game marks the earliest Big 12 start for Texas Tech since opening the 1996 season at Kansas State ... Red Raiders have won eight of the last 10 meetings ... only losses in Big 12 play came in 1999, 2003 and 2005.
	<b>Northwestern (LA) St.</b> September 29 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Final non-conference matchup of the regular season ... first meeting against the Northwestern (La.) State Demons ... Tech has faced schools from the state of Louisiana 18 times during its 82-year history and boasts a 13-4-1 record ... NSU is the sixth program from Louisiana that Texas Tech has placed on its schedule.
	<b>Iowa State</b> October 6 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the overall series 6-1, including a 42-24 win in Ames last season ... the Red Raiders are averaging 34.0 points per game against the Cyclones since the inception of the Big 12 Conference in 1996 ... Tech has won the last two meetings ... the team first met in 1967 and Iowa State picked up its first win in 2002 in Ames ... Homecoming at Texas Tech.
	<b>Texas A&amp;M</b> October 13 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Game returns to Lubbock with the Red Raiders riding a two-game win streak ... Texas Tech trails in the overall series 34-30-1, but has won nine of the last 12 contests and the last six in Lubbock ... Red Raiders are averaging 42.3 points per game under Leach at home against the Aggies, including 2001's 12-point output in the Red Raider shutout.
	<b>at Missouri</b> October 20 • TBA Columbia, Missouri Memorial Stadium	Missouri leads the series 4-2 and won last year's game in Lubbock ... the Red Raiders have not won in Columbia ... Memorial Stadium is one of only two Big 12 venues in which Texas Tech has not won (Colorado) ... teams first met in 1995 as a prelude to Big 12 Conference play ... didn't meet in league play until 1998.
	<b>Colorado</b> October 27 • 1 p.m. Lubbock, Texas Jones AT&T Stadium	The series is tied at 4-4 as both teams have won at their home sites ... Colorado won last year's meeting in Boulder and Texas Tech's last win was in 2003 in Lubbock ... the teams first met in 1967 and again in 1976 and 1981, before facing off as Big 12 foes in 1998 ... Wes Welker set the NCAA record for career punt returns for TDs in the last home meeting in 2003.
	<b>at Baylor</b> November 3 • TBA Waco, Texas Floyd Casey Stadium	Texas Tech tied the series for the first time since 1933, when Tech last tied the series 2-2 ... the Red Raiders haven't led in series since 1946 when Tech led 5-3 ... winners of 11 straight against the Bears, Tech has not lost to Baylor in Big 12 play ... Tech's last loss was a 9-7 setback in Waco in 1995.
	<b>at Texas</b> November 10 • TBA Austin, Texas Royal-Memorial Stadium	The Longhorns have won four straight for the first time since winning five in a row from 1981-85 ... Red Raiders trail 41-14 overall in the series ... teams have met annually since 1960, when the Red Raiders became members of the Southwest Conference ... Tech's last win was in 2002 in Lubbock and last win in Austin came in 1997.
	<b>Oklahoma</b> November 17 • 1 p.m. Lubbock, Texas Jones AT&T Stadium	Oklahoma leads the series 10-3 ... Texas Tech snapped a five-game winless streak in Lubbock against the Sooners in 2005, a 23-21 victory ... despite five-hour distance from each other, the schools first met in 1992 in Lubbock ... OU won the first three, before the Red Raiders hit the win column in 1996.
