	NORTH DAKOTA September 5 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	First meeting between the two schools.
	RICE September 12 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series between the two former Southwest Conference rivals, 26-20-1, including Tech's 59-24 win in Houston in 2007 ... the first game in the series was played in 1942, a 19-7 Rice victory ... Tech has won the last two games in the series — 1995 and 2007 — and have not lost at home to the Owls since 1985.
	at Texas September 19 • 7 p.m. Memorial Stadium Austin, Texas	Undoubtedly, one of the most memorable finishes in recent college football history highlighted last year's 39-33 Tech win in Lubbock ... Red Raiders trail 42-15 overall in the series ... teams have met annually since 1960, when the Red Raiders became members of the Southwest Conference ... Tech's last win in Austin came in 1997.
	at Houston September 26 • 8:15 p.m. Robertson Stadium Houston, Texas	The game is the first between the two schools since 1995, the final year of the Southwest Conference ... teams met annually from 1976-95 ... Cougars hold a 17-10-1 advantage in the series that began during the 1951 season ... Tech and Houston finished 2008 first and second in passing, respectively.
	NEW MEXICO October 3 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 32-6-2 ... the teams last met during the 2004 season in Albuquerque as UNM kicked a last-second field goal to win 27-24 ... Red Raiders have faced the Lobos five times under Mike Leach, including the tenth-year head coach's inaugural game in 2000.
	KANSAS STATE October 10 • 6 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 7-3, dating back to the 1933 season ... the Red Raiders have won four straight against the Wildcats, including a 58-28 win in Manhattan last season ... KSU last picked up a win in 2000, when the 10th-ranked Wildcats narrowly escaped Tech, 28-23, in Manhattan in Mike Leach's first season as head coach.
	at Nebraska October 17 • TBA Memorial Stadium Lincoln, Nebraska	Texas Tech has won the last three meetings against the Huskers, including last year's dramatic 37-31 overtime win in Lubbock ... Nebraska leads the series 7-3 ... the teams first met in the 1976 Bluebonnet Bowl in Houston ... of the 10 games in the series, the Huskers have been among the top 10 in five of those games.
	TEXAS A&M October 24 • 1 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Game returns to Lubbock with the Red Raiders riding a three-game win streak ... Texas Tech trails in the overall series 34-32-1, but has won 11 of the last 14 contests ... Red Raiders are averaging 41.5 points per game in the last six games against the Aggies ... Tech has won seven straight against the Aggies in Lubbock.
	KANSAS October 31 • 1 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech holds a 10-1 advantage over the Jayhawks, including a 6-1 edge in Big 12 play ... Red Raiders have won three straight (2004-05, 08) and last lost in 2001 at home ... Tech coach Mike Leach and Kansas head coach Mark Mangino were on Bob Stoops' staff together at Oklahoma ... Red Raiders have scored 30+ in each of the last five meetings.
	OPEN DATE November 7	Texas was originally scheduled on this date, but the game was moved forward in the season to accommodate national television opportunities.
	at Oklahoma State November 14 • TBA Boone Pickens Stadium Stillwater, Oklahoma	Texas Tech leads the overall series 20-12-3, but OSU has taken the last three in Stillwater ... Red Raiders have won nine of the last 12 meetings ... Tech has scored 30+ in eight of the last nine meetings, including last season's 56-point outburst in Lubbock ... the teams have split the last six games, each winning on their home field.
	OKLAHOMA November 21 • 1 p.m. Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	The Red Raiders and Sooners have split the last four games ... Texas Tech defeated the third-ranked Sooners, 34-27, in 2007, and 23-21 in 2005 ... despite five-hour distance from each other, the schools first met in 1992 in Lubbock ... OU won the first three, before the Red Raiders hit the win column in 1996 ... OU leads series 12-4.
	vs. Baylor November 28 • TBA Dallas Cowboys Stadium Arlington, Texas	Texas Tech took its first series lead since 1946 with the 2007 win in Waco and holds a 34-32-1 advantage ... Tech narrowly escaped a much-improved Baylor team last season, 35-28, in a game Tech trailed entering the fourth quarter ... Red Raiders are winners of 13 straight against the Bears ... the teams meet in Arlington this season.
