	NORTHWESTERN ST. Saturday, Sept. 1 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 1-0 ... the game will mark the second meeting between Tech and Northwestern State ... the first matchup resulted in a 75-7 win by the Red Raiders in 2007.
	@ TEXAS STATE Saturday, Sept. 8 Bobcat Stadium San Marcos, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 1-0 ... the Red Raiders will make their first appearance in San Marcos as Tech will be the first opponent for Texas State in the newly renovated Bobcat Stadium ... Texas State will compete at the Division I FBS level and as a member of the WAC.
	NEW MEXICO (FW) Saturday, Sept. 15 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 34-6-2 ... the teams last met during the 2011 season in Albuquerque, a 59-13 Tech win ... this will mark the third time that Tommy Tuberville has faced the Lobos while UNM is one of two non-conference repeats from the 2011 season.
	BYE Saturday, Sept. 22	The first of two off-weeks during the 2012 season. The second off-week comes in the final week of the regular-season (Dec. 1).
	@ IOWA STATE Saturday, Sept. 29 Jack Trice Stadium Ames, Iowa	Texas Tech leads the series 7-3 but has lost the last two meetings in the series ... the Red Raiders will be in search of their first win in Ames since Oct. 28, 2006, when Tech defeated the Cyclones 42-26.
	OKLAHOMA Saturday, Oct. 6 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Oklahoma leads the series 13-6 ... Texas Tech snapped No. 1 Oklahoma's 39-game home win streak last season in Norman as the Red Raiders handed the Sooners a 41-38 loss at Memorial Stadium ... Texas Tech has won the last two meetings against OU in Lubbock.
	WEST VIRGINIA (HC) Saturday, Oct. 13 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	West Virginia leads the series 1-0 ... Texas Tech and West Virginia will be meeting for the first time since 1937 when the Mountaineers defeated the Red Raiders 7-6 in the Sun Bowl ... West Virginia joins the Big 12 Conference in July of 2012.
	@ TCU Saturday, Oct. 20 Amon G. Carter Stadium Fort Worth, Texas	Texas Tech leads the series 28-23-3 ... Tech and TCU will be meeting as conference foes for the first time since 1995 when both were members of the Southwest Conference ... Tech and TCU split a pair of non-conference games in 2004 (Tech win) and 2006 (TCU win).
	@ KANSAS STATE Saturday, Oct. 27 Bill Snyder Family Stadium Manhattan, Kan.	Texas Tech leads the series against Kansas State 8-4 and has posted wins in five of the last six games ... Tech's last meeting with K-State resulted in a 41-34 Wildcat win at Jones AT&T Stadium in 2011.
	TEXAS Saturday, Nov. 3 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas leads the series 45-15 ... teams have met annually since 1960, when the Red Raiders became members of the Southwest Conference.
	KANSAS Saturday, Nov. 10 Jones AT&T Stadium Lubbock, Texas	Texas Tech holds a 12-1 lead in the series against the Jayhawks and has won each of the last five games ... Kansas' lone win came in 2001 when the Jayhawks edged the Red Raiders in overtime, 34-31.
	@ OKLAHOMA STATE Saturday, Nov. 17 Boone Pickens Stadium Stillwater, Okla.	Texas Tech leads the series 20-14-3 ... Red Raiders have won nine of the last 14 meetings ... the game in Stillwater will be the first for Tech since the 2009 season.
	vs. BAYLOR Saturday, Nov. 24 Cowboys Stadium Arlington, Texas	Texas Tech holds a 36-33-1 advantage in the series and has won 15 of the last 16 games in the series ... the Red Raiders and Bears will meet in the DFW Metroplex for the fourth-straight year in 2012 and for the third time in Cowboys Stadium.
