INSTRUCTION/GOALS

To provide each tennis player with an opportunity to develop & improve tennis skills with an emphasis on good training techniques. The staff will include Texas Tech players who have experience working with young players.

ENROLLMENT

No camp in Texas will have a better student teacher ratio.

The camps have limited enrollment on a first-come, first-serve basis. You are encouraged to send in your application and deposit as soon as possible.

New NCAA rules allow senior high school boys and girls to attend if they have not signed a letter of intent to play a sport for a college or university.

DEPOSIT AND REFUNDS

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required with each application, and the remainder is due two weeks before the beginning of session. No refunds will be issued for late arrival or early departure due to limited enrollment and administrative costs.

OVERNIGHT CAMPS

Check In: 3-3:30 p.m. Sunday, for Camp at Chitwood/Weymouth Dorms (All Campers).

Check Out: Campers can be picked up at 5 p.m. Thursday from Chitwood/Weymouth Dorms.

Cost: \$325 for Commuters; and \$395 for Residents. Residents will have meals provided from Sunday dinner through Thursday lunch. Commuters will have only lunches provided.

NEW TEXAS TECH TENNIS CENTER

Play will be at the **NEW** Texas Tech University Tennis Center located off of Brownfield Highway and Indiana Avenue. The complex consists of 12 courts with digital scoring, locker rooms and a training room. This will be the first year for the camp to take place at the Texas Tech Tennis Center.
