**Head Coach Kristy Curry**

*On if the newcomers can contribute*

"I have to give them a lot of confidence. There's no question that they can contribute, I think it would be nice to be able to get and when Ashlee Roberson comes back we will have more depth, more versatility. But, even Maddy Brown is brand new and didn't really have a chance to get with the flow of things. To me, this a whole different team from a year ago for several reasons and Maddy is one of those."

*On giving newcomers more time*

"We did have a couple of mismatches, but obviously we realize we need to give them some more minutes and they're only going to get better if they play. To improve, they're going to make a few mistakes here and there, but they really give us a presence inside and it's nice when we can give some other players some relief because we have some quality backup. I think Jordan (Barncastle) and Kierra (Mallard) are really committed to making this a better team. They care too much about what we're doing and I'm excited about it."

*On tonight's intensity*

"I think we had more personality in the half than what we had starting the game. We need to understand that regardless of what the score is, we need to approach things different and have that mean streak about us and play to our capabilities. I expect us to play every single possession like it's our last. I think we need to do a better job of that."

*On if there are things they need to work on*

"I think as coaches we always feel like we have stuff to work on especially this time of year. We're going to continue to just be persistent and have repetition with all the little things, all the things that can win over a game. Just work on critical little things that can really make a difference. Obviously, we have a lot of room to grow and be better and that's what comes with this time of year."
