Starting the game

First Career Start

- Freshman forward Jordan Barncastle got her first career start Friday night against Lamar.

At the Half

- Freshman Tilmila Martin led the Lady Raiders with eight points. Maria Moore, Dominic Seals, and Jordan Barncastle each had four rebounds. Tech shot 40 percent, and 60 percent from the line.
