**Head Coach Kristy Curry**

***On first comments***

***On inside game***

**Head Coach Larry Tidwell**

***On the game***

"First assessment of the game is we knew we had to contain them, they are much more athletic. We ran a little 1-2-2 zone. When they would get penetration, they scored. They are very well coached, and they just missed some shots and we got lucky. The (Jordan) Barncastle kid, is a friend of mine, she just spanked us tonight. She is going to be an outstanding player, that's a true freshman and she will be outstanding. They have great coaching."

***On their run, and then Tech coming back and putting it away***

"It's sort of like we are setting in there and we tried to answer and we closed it to three. I was talking to them and my girls were trying to be excited. They have a real nice team."

***On the atmosphere***

"When you come into this setting, it's something you want your kids to do. As I try to build a program at Lamar, this is not a bad program to follow. But the players as you sit there, either the glass is half empty or half full. It is half full for us. I am very positive person, and I am proud of my girls, but satisfied no."
