Starting the Game

• Lady Raider coach Kristy Curry used a starting lineup of Jordan Murphree (g), Maria Moore (g), Keisha Walker (g), Erin Myrick (c) and Dominic Seals (f) for the fifth-straight game. With the 86-72 victory, Tech is 5-0 on the season when this group takes the floor first. The Bengals opened the contest with Andrea Lightfoot (g), Jenna Brown (g), Natalie Doma (c), Devin Diehl (f) and Michelle Grohs (f).

Tech Thankful for Myrick

• Myrick scored the Lady Raiders' first four points of the game and hit her first four shots from the field. Her three-point play with 8:39 left in the first half put the skids on a 9-0 ISU run. The Duarte, Calif. native finished with a season-best 20 points, eight rebounds and one assist.

Odds and Ends

- Tech started the game shooting 60 percent (6-10) from the field. It finished the first half at a 53 percent clip. The Lady Raiders shot 48 percent for the game.
- Tech dominated the action inside the paint. The Lady Raiders outscored the Bengals 28-12 in the paint in the first half and 50-26 on the night.
- The Lady Raiders' 50 points through the first 20 minutes was their highest first-half output of the season. The last time Tech had 50 points going into the half was Jan. 2, 2005 against Idaho State, the first time the two squads met.
- Tech went on a 6-0 run from 7:09 to 5:11 in the first half.
- Raquel Christian's 3-pointer with 13:38 left gave the Lady Raiders a 20-point lead.

Record With...

- Seals (14), Murphree (13), Myrick (20) and Ashlee Roberson (11) all scored in double digits to improve the Lady Raiders' record to 5-0 when at least three players score in double figures and 3-0 when four hit for 10 points.
- With her 14 points on the game, Seals has scored in double figures in all five of Tech's games this season. The Lady Raiders are 5-0 when the South Plains College transfer scores in double digits.
- Tech hit five 3-pointers to improve its record to 2-0 when it hits at least five from behind the arc.
- The Lady Raiders are now 3-0 on the season when taking a lead into the lockerroom.
- Idaho State won the battle on the boards 42-41 to mark the first time this year that Tech has been outrebounded. The Lady Raiders are now 1-0 when losing the rebounding battle.
- Tech's 13 turnovers was a season low. It is now 1-0 when turning the ball over 16 or fewer times.

Record With Cont...

- With the Bengals giving the ball away 18 times on the night, the Lady Raiders are now 3-0 when the opposition has 17-20 turnovers.
- The United Spirit Arena has been kind to Tech to this point in the season. The Lady Raiders are now 2-0 when playing in Lubbock.

Highs

- Seals' 3 blocks gave her a new career high.
- Roberson notched a career high with 11 points.
