Game 11

Starting the Game

• Kristy Curry used a starting lineup of Jordan Murphree (g), Maria Moore (g), Keisha Walker (g), Erin Myrick (c) and Dominic Seals for the tenth time this season. With the 73-69 win, Tech is 9-1 on the season when this group gets the starting nod. Arizona State countered with a group consisting of Jill Noe (g), Briann January (g), Dymond Simon (g), Sybil Dosty (c) and Lauren Lacey (f).

Dates with the 'Devils

• The game marked just the sixth time the two schools have met. The last time the two squads met in Lubbock before tonight was in 1987, a game that Tech won 69-57. The Sun Devils beat Tech 61-45 last year in Tempe, Ariz. With the victory Thursday, the series is now even at three games apiece.

Tech and the Pac 10

• With the win, the Lady Raiders are now 28-17 against the PAC 10 conference all time.

Tech and the Top 25

• ASU is the first ranked team Tech has faced this year. The Lady Raiders faced eight different ranked teams last season and compiled a 3-8 record against them. Their last win over a Top 25 foe before now was Feb. 14 against No. 19/20 Nebraska.

Quick Start

• Tech connected on four of its first five attempts from the field as four different players got a bucket to spark Tech to a 9-4 advantage.

Tough D in the First Half

• Tech held ASU scoreless over a span of 5:08 (7:25-2:17). The Lady Raiders went on a 7-0 run over that time.

No. 41 Does it Again

• Seals' 20 points gives her nine games this season in which she has scored in double figures. It is her fourth game on the season with 15-plus points.

Odds and Ends

• There were a total of 13 ties and 12 lead changes in the game.

• This was just Tech's second game of the year that has been decided by less than 10 points. It is 1-1 in those contests.

• The Sun Devils went on a 9-0 run from 17:06 to 14:41 in the first half, a span of 3:25, to go ahead 13-9. A Stanecia Graham bucket stopped the run.

• With a score of 32 apiece, it marked the first time this season that Tech has been even with the opposition going into the lockerroom. They have held a halftime lead seven times and trailed twice after the first 20 minutes of play. They are now 1-0 when the score is even at the break.

Odds and Ends Cont...

- Moore scored four-straight Lady Raider Points to help give Tech a 63-59 lead with 5:08 left.
- The Lady Raiders' 11 turnovers was a season low.

Record With

- Seals (20), Moore (14) and Graham (14) all scored in double figures. Tech has had at least that many players record double-digit points in every game this season. They are now 10-1 when three players have 10-or-more points in a game.
- The Lady Raiders are now 10-1 on the season when holding the opposition under 40 percent shooting from the field.
- With a 47-39 advantage on the boards, Tech is 8-0 when winning the battle on the boards.
- With the season-low 11 turnovers, Tech is 4-0 when turning the ball over less than 16 times.
