With the Win...

- Gives Tech first win streak in conference
- Tech improves to 16-11 on the season
- Tech is now 4-9 in Big 12 conference play

Home Sweet Home

- The Lady Raiders are 12-4 overall, and 4-3 in conference when playing at the United Spirit Arena this season.

Tech Seals the Deal

- Dominic Seals scored 19 of her game high 21 points in the second half. It is the seventh time of the season that Seals has scored over 20 points.

Help From The Bench

- Tech had help from the bench as they outscored Nebraska 20-8. Coming off the bench was Erin Myrick with eight points and Maddy Brown with six points.

Scoring From Everywhere

- Jordan Murphree led the Lady Raiders in scoring in the first half with 11 points. She was three of five from the field, two of three from three-point land and three of four from the charity stripe. Murphree was the only Lady Raider to hit a three-pointer in the first half.

Season Highs

- Maddy Brown found her touch as she went two of four from behind the arc, while scoring six points. The two three pointers and six points are both season highs.

Random Facts

- Seals (25) and Murphree (21) have both started over 20 games on the season.
- The Lady Raiders started the game on a 12-2 run that ended on a Nebraska basket at the 15:02 mark.
- Tech and Nebraska exchanged the lead four times in the game, and all four were in the first half.
- The biggest lead of the game was 17 by the Lady Raiders at the 4:58 mark in the second half.
