Starting the Game

• For the fourth time this season, Kristy Curry called on Maria Moore (g), LaVonda “Tiny” Henderson (g), Ashlee Roberson (f), Erin Myrick (c) and Dominic Seals to start the contest. With the win, Tech is 2-2 on the season when this group gets the starting nod. Texas A&M started the game with A’Quonesia Franklin (g), Takia Starks (g), La Toya Micheaux (c), Danielle Gant (f) and Patrice Reado (f).

Tangles with Texas A&M

• The two in-state foes met for the 64th time Saturday night. The Aggies have now won the last four meetings. Even with the loss, Tech still owns a 52-12 series record all time and a 26-3 advantage on the South Plains.

Against the Top 25

• With the loss, Tech is now 2-4 against Top 25 teams this year. The Lady Raiders beat Arizona State and Texas and have lost to Arkansas, Baylor, Oklahoma and Texas.

With the loss...

- Tech falls to 14-7 and 2-5 in conference play
- Tech is now 10-3 when playing in the USA.
- Tech is 2-2 at home in conference play.

Unkind Rims

• After shooting above 40 percent in each of their last two home games, the rims were unkind to Tech. The Lady Raiders hit just 3 of their first 11 shots from the field. They finished 16-45 for a 36 percent clip on the evening.

Keisha Spark

• When junior Keisha Walker entered the game at the 13:46 mark in the first half, the score was 10-3. The Kansas City, Mo., native scored six points to lead Tech on a 13-6 run to tie the score at 16 apiece before she exited. Her three-point shot with :57 seconds left in the first half gave the Lady Raiders a 25-24 lead. She eclipsed her season average of 5.7 all nine of her points in the first half.

Dominic Does it Again

• With her 10 rebounds, Seals recorded her ninth double-figure rebound night of the season. She was second in the Big 12 in rebounds at 9.1 rpg coming into the contest.

Odds and Ends

- With her team-high 12 points, Jordan Murphree has scored in double figures on 10 games this season.
- A&M went on an 8-0 run over the first 3:36 of play. A Moore free throw at the 16:24 mark stopped the Aggie run.

Odds and Ends Cont...

- A three pointer by Walker at the 10:03 mark in the first half gave Tech its first lead of the game. The Lady Raiders went on an 11-2 run over a 5:57 span (14:52 - 8:55).
- A&M went on a 22-0 run over 10:27 in the second half (11:50-1:23). A Murphree three stopped the Aggie run.
- By holding a 25-24 advantage at halftime, Tech has taken a lead into the lockerroom 13 times this season. With the loss, the Lady Raiders are now 11-2 when leading after the first 20 minutes.
- With the 26-40 deficit on the boards, Tech is now 2-2 when being outrebounded by the opposition.
