Day Camp

Resident/Commuter Campers - Players will register between 8:30 to 9:30 p.m. on the first day of each session. Registration will be held at the University Plaza at 1001 University Ave. Campers will be released at Noon on the last day of camp, and commuters are released at 8:45 p.m. each day.

Linens will not be provided for resident campers. All meals will be provided for resident campers, and commuter campers will be served lunch and dinner. Commuter campers will be responsible for their own housing, transportation and breakfast needs.

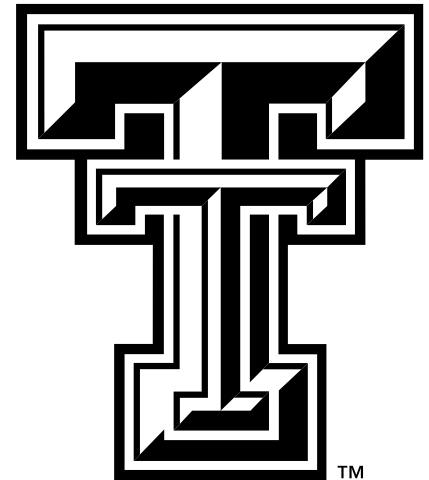
