The matches will start at 9 am on Friday and Saturday, September 21-22 at the Municipal Tennis Center, located at 3030 66th St, Lubbock, TX 79413, (806) 767-3727.

Over the past three years all of you have showed tremendous support for our players and cheered them on to take over some of the best collegiate players from Texas universities and other top ranked Division I programs around the country and we are proud to have you as Texas Tech Tennis Fans!!!

However, this year you have a chance to feel the excitement and competition not just from the stands but on the court! We invite female players of all levels and ability to play in the "Open draw" of this year's Fall Tournament. Players can enter for singles and doubles competition. The "Open Draw" will include female tennis players from local high schools, Texas Tech Club Tennis Team, members of USTA leagues and local country clubs and any other players out there.

The dates are September 21-22 (Friday and Saturday).

Matches will be played at the Municipal Tennis Center and Lubbock High School.

There will be 3-4 singles and 3 doubles matches guaranteed for everybody who enters the "Open

Draw", based on the number of participants, therefore, we will have a back draw. Entry fee is \$35 per singles entrant and \$40 per doubles team. USTA officials will be working the "Open Draw" .
