Media Information

The staff of the Tulane University Office of Athletic Communications will be available throughout the 2007 baseball season to accommodate any media requests. Following are some guidelines that should make it easier for media members to cover the Green Wave baseball team. Any additional questions should be directed to Richie Weaver, Assistant Director of Athletic Communications.

Press Credentials

Credentials for all Tulane games are for working media only. Spouses, dates, children or other non-workers are not permitted in the working media areas in compliance with the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. Requests for media credentials should be made in writing on appropriate letterhead at least 48 hours prior to the game. Requests should be directed to Richie Weaver, Assistant Director of Athletic Communications. Requests from the media covering visiting teams will be confirmed with that team's media relations director. Credentials can be picked up at the Will Call window at Turchin Stadium and Zephyr Field, and are also available prior to game day at the James W. Wilson, Jr. Center.

Photo Credentials

Only photographers on assignment and members of the television media will be given photo credentials. Accredited photographers are allowed on the field between the end of the dugout and the outfield wall and must stay in foul territory. Photographers also have access to the photo wells at Zephyr Field and may have access to the roofs of the dugouts with advanced notice. The view of spectators may not be impeded by photographers.



At the Game

Tulane will have a pair of home fields in 2007 as the Green Wave will begin the year at Zephyr Field in Metairie, La., before returning to campus once the construction of the new Turchin Stadium is completed. Both press boxes feature booths for radio and television broadcasts. Tulane grants broadcasting rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on a reciprocal basis. Game Services

The Tulane Athletic Communications staff will be at your service throughout the game. All media will be provided with game programs, rosters, media guides, game notes and other pertinent information. Computer-generated statistics will be available at the conclusion of each game. Information provided includes play-by-play and individual and team statistics in standard NCAA box score format.

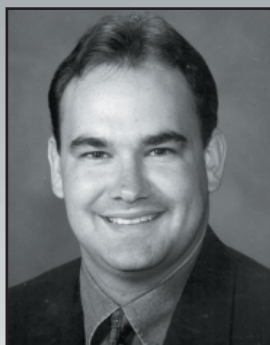

Tulane Athletics and its multimedia rights holder, ISP Sports, are in the sixth year of their partnership in 2006-07. As owner of broadcast and marketing rights for all Green Wave sports, ISP produces and distributes the game broadcasts and coaches' radio and television shows.

ISP additionally holds the rights to market print advertising in various athletic department publications and on the official athletic department website at www.tulane-greenwave.com, and handle sales for all advertising signage in university athletic facilities. In exchange for these rights, the university is guaranteed an annual rights fee and will share in additional revenue as well.



Todd Graffagnini
Radio Analyst

Todd Graffagnini returns for his 16th season calling Tulane Baseball games and the native New Orleanian will be the primary announcer for all Tulane Baseball home and road broadcasts. Following basketball season, he will be joined for home game broadcasts by long-time New Orleans radio voice Larry Matson, who also calls Tulane men's basketball and football games.

Graffagnini graduated from Loyola in 1993, and in the past, has been the play-by-play voice of Tulane women's basketball and last season he served as the studio host for the New Orleans' Hornets game broadcasts. He also provides sideline commentary for all Tulane football games.

When not in the booth calling Green Wave ballgames, Graffagnini works as a regular sports reporter on Sports Radio AM 1280 where he delivers "The Graff Report."



In 2007, nearly every Tulane baseball game will be broadcast live on the flagship station of Green Wave baseball, WRBH, 88.3 FM. In addition, all Tulane baseball broadcasts can be heard live on the internet via the Green Wave's Official Athletic

website, www.tulane-greenwave.com.

Fans sign up for the "All Access" package which provides them not only with the ability to hear each game broadcast from their computer, but also the ability to go back and listen to archived footage of all Green Wave broadcasts during the season.

Headquartered in Winston-Salem, N.C., ISP Sports is the exclusive multimedia rightsholder for the Auburn, Baylor, Boston College, California, UCLA, the

University of Central Florida, Cincinnati, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Houston, Marshall, Ohio, Pittsburgh, Southern Miss, Syracuse, Tulane, Vanderbilt, Villanova, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

Additionally, ISP is a joint venture partner with Learfield Communications as the exclusive multimedia rightsholder for Alabama, Clemson, Miami and South Carolina.

The company was founded in 1992 by current CEO and President Ben Sutton.

The General Manager of the Tulane ISP Sports Property is Owen Shull, who manages both the Southern Miss and Tulane ISP properties along with a staff of four individuals. Shull's primary office is located in Hattiesburg, Miss. at 118 College Drive. The newest addition to the ISP/Tulane Network is Assistant General Manager Chase Jones, who joined the team last spring.

-- Conference USA Baseball On CSTV --

College Sports Television has announced its schedule of Conference USA baseball games that will be televised during the 2007 season. The schedule features five conference matchups and a pair of high-profile non-league contests over the final seven weeks of the season, along with the title game of the 2007 C-USA Baseball Championship at Turchin Stadium.

The schedule gets underway on Sunday, April 8 when longtime rivals Memphis and Tulane meet in New Orleans. Five days later, cross-town foes Rice and Houston renew their rivalry at Cougar Field. On April 17, Texas and Rice, two of most successful programs in college baseball over the past decade, meet at Reckling Park in Houston.

Houston and Tulane, who have won more C-USA Championships than any other schools, will be featured in a Friday, April 20 contest in New Orleans. After a week off, C-USA Baseball returns to CSTV's airwaves on Friday, May 4, when Houston welcomes East Carolina to town.

On May 11, Rice and Tulane – picked to finish first and second, respectively, in the C-USA

Coaches preseason poll – square off to open a key three-game series. Four days later, Rice will host regional-rival Baylor in an important non-conference contest. On May 17, the regular season schedule concludes with Southern Miss and Houston meeting in an important final weekend contest.
