As a Senior (2004-05)

- Led the Wave in assists (119, 4.57 per game, 4th in C-USA), free throw percentage (.845, 4th in C-USA) and steals (37).
- Also ranked eighth in C-USA in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.72).
- An ankle injury suffered late in the first UAB game (1/19) limited him to 12.6 minutes, 2.1 points, 1.5 rebounds and 2.4 assists (including two dnp's) over the next eight games.
- Played 35 minutes against UAB (2/26), scoring 10 points with four rebounds and three steals.
- Averaged 16.8 points, 7.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists over the four games prior to the injury.
- Had nine points with seven assists, five rebounds and four steals in the UAB victory (1/19).
- Tallied 18 points with 10 boards and six assists against DePaul (1/15).
- Scored 20 points with seven rebounds, five assists, three steals and just one turnover against TCU (1/12).
- Registered a career-high 20 points against Marquette (1/8).
- Tallied double figures in assists for the second time with 10 as well as scoring 17 points against VMI (12/31).
- Matched the school record with 13 assists against Northwestern State (12/6).
- Scored 16 points with five assists and zero turnovers in the Loyola win (12/3).
- Surpassed four key milestones this year: 500 points, 200 assists, 200 rebounds and 100 steals.

As a Junior (2003-04)

- Led the Wave in steals (1.57, 7th in C-USA) and ranked second in scoring (10.2 ppg) and assists (3.48, 12th in C-USA). Also ranked sixth in C-USA in free-throw percentage (.824) and 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.15).
- One of five players in Conference USA to average more than 10.0 points, 3.0 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game.

- Started every game and played 30 or more minutes 17 times.
- Tallied three or more assists in 19 games.
- Needed just 14 games to record a career-best season in points, rebounds, assists, minutes, three-pointers and three-point percentage.
- Paced the Wave with 14 points (all in the second half) and four assists against Saint Louis (2/28).
- Led Tulane to victory over UAB (2/25) with a career-high 19 points, four assists and just one turnover.
- Tallied 14 points, six assists and five rebounds against East Carolina (2/18).
- Recorded his first career double-double with a career-high 10 rebounds and 12 points (seven in the final 2:27 of the game) vs. Houston (2/11).
- Matched his career-high with 17 points against Southern Miss (1/31).
- Tallied 16 points against UAB (1/28), while adding four rebounds, five assists and two steals.
- Played 38 minutes against #8 Louisville (1/17), scoring 15 points with seven rebounds.
- Played a career-high 39 minutes against LSU (12/23), scoring nine points with eight rebounds and three assists.
- Scored 15 points with four rebounds and four assists against Northwestern State (12/9).
- Logged 37 minutes against Rice (12/6), finishing with a then-season-high 11 points, six assists, five rebounds and four steals.

As a Sophomore (2002-03)

- Battled a foot injury late in the season, but returned to average 13.0 minutes per game over the final three games of the year, scoring 12 points with six assists.
- Over the five games prior to his injury (2/4 to 2/18), was averaging 7.2 points (12-of-24 shooting), 2.0 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 1.2 steals in

- Registered a season-best 17 points, including 10 of the Wave's final 12 points, in the road victory over UAB (2/8).
- Scored a then-season-high 12 points (on perfect 4-for-4 shooting) with four rebounds vs. Houston (2/4).
- Dished out a career-best eight assists and added two points, two rebounds and two steals in 18 minutes against Morris Brown (1/4).

As a Freshman (2001-2002)

- Led the Green Wave freshmen in points, minutes, assists and steals.
- Posted a team-best 5.27 assists per 40 minutes.
- Played 21 minutes in the tournament game against Charlotte (3/7) after an injury to Waitari Marsh, and finished with eight points, three rebounds and three assists.
- Scored six points with a pair of assists against No. 6 Kentucky (1/2).
- Posted a 10-point, six-rebound, three-assist effort against Lipscomb (12/21).
- Tallied five points with three rebounds, two assists and zero turnovers against Vanderbilt (12/10), while also hitting a half-time buzzer-beating 35-footer.
- Scored a career-high 13 points (all in the second half), including three three-pointers, against Florida (12/2).

Prep

- After lettering for four years at Glencliff High School in Nashville, prepped for a season at Solebury in New Hope, Pa.
- For Solebury, averaged 23 points, nine assists and 2.5 steals per game.
- Earned first team all-league honors, as well as all-tourney honors in the Pennsylvania Prep School Tournament.
- Scored a career-high 42 points in one contest while shooting 13-of-18 from the field.
- Was a finalist for Tennessee Class AAA Mr. Basketball Honors as a senior at Glencliff.
- Also received All-USA honors from *USA Today* as a high school senior when he broke the school scoring record and averaged 29.5 points and eight assists per game.
- A three-time all-region and four-time all-district selection at Glencliff.
