## MEDIA OPPORTUNITIES & SERVICES

### Weekly Press Opportunity

Tulane head coach Bob Toledo and selected players will meet with the media each Tuesday morning during the season in the Hall of Fame Room of the Wilson Center. Requests for specific players should be made to the Athletics Communications Office on Sunday afternoon prior to the press opportunity.

### Interviews

All interview requests for Coach Toledo, any Tulane assistant coaches and players must be coordinated through the Athletic Communications office.

Players are available for interviews, either in person or on the phone, before or after practice Sunday through Wednesday. In order to arrange for player interviews, please provide 24 hours notice to the Athletic Communications Office. Player interviews may be conducted in the atrium of the Wilson Center, on the practice fields or in the Athletic Communications Office.

The Tulane training room, football locker room, weight room and meeting rooms are off-limits to the media. Your cooperation is appreciated.

For telephone interviews, the student-athlete will be provided with the number and will make the call at a mutually-agreed upon time. Phone numbers of student-athletes will not be made available to the media.

For interviews with head coach Bob Toledo and/or Tulane assistant coaches, please contact Roger Dunaway or Richie Weaver in the Athletic Communications Office. The best time for Coach Toledo to conduct interviews is weekday mornings.

### Practice Coverage

In general, Tulane practices, usually held at the Westfeldt Practice and Competition Facility behind the James W. Wilson Center, are open to the local media. However, practice may be closed or moved without notice. Please contact the Tulane Athletic Communications Office if you plan on attending practice so that we may confirm the day's practice schedule.

Still photographs and video may be shot during selected segments of practice by approved agencies. After that time, photographers will be asked not to shoot. Media are asked to remain on the track or in the stands during practice, and are asked not to speak to players or coaches during the workout.

### Website

Updated statistics, game recaps, weekly and daily releases, press conference transcripts, player and coaches' bios, historical, broadcast and ticket information, can be found on the Tulane Official Athletics Website at [www.TulaneGreenWave.com](http://www.TulaneGreenWave.com). Media are encouraged to check the website regularly for the latest Green Wave athletics news.

### Video Services

Requests for video footage of Green Wave football should be made to Roger Dunaway or Richie Weaver in the Athletic Communications Office. They will work with TU Video Director Mike Langford and his staff to fill specific requests. Please allow a minimum of three days lead time for video requests. Agencies will be asked to either supply a new Beta tape or to return the highlights to Tulane.

## GAME DAY COVERAGE

### Credential Requests

All requests for media, radio, television, photography, scouting and parking credentials for the 2007 Tulane Football season, or for any individual game, should be made in writing, on company letterhead or via e-mail (company name in address), to Roger Dunaway or Richie Weaver. Requests should be made at least one week prior to the game. Individual game credentials will not be mailed, but can be picked up in the Athletic Communications Office the week of the game or at Superdome Will-Call.

A limited number of parking passes for the Northwest Parking Garage at the Superdome are available to visiting media. Requests for parking passes should be made well in advance of the game.

### Will Call

Any media credentials not picked up during the week at the Wilson Center will be available at Press Will Call in the Superdome beginning three hours prior to the game. Press Will Call is located at the Press Entrance in the Northwest Parking Garage.

### Press Box Services

The press box, located on the third level of the Superdome, opens three hours prior to game time. The working press box and communications booths are located to the right of elevator 8.

Meals will be served in the Hall of Fame Lounge beginning two hours before game time until kickoff. Sodas will be available throughout the game and snacks are served at halftime.

Game notes, programs, a flip card and statistics will be provided prior to the game. Play-by-play and quick statistics, final team, individual and defensive statistics, drive charts and coaches' quotes also will be provided. Complete sets of information will be available approximately 20 minutes after the game.

### Telephones/Fax Machines

Three "0-plus" telephone lines are available on a first-come, first-served basis in the working area of the Superdome press box. Additional requests for telephone lines should be directed to BellSouth at (504) 528-7940. On game day, BellSouth and Superdome communications representatives will be on hand to handle last-minute problems.

Tulane will provide a FAX machine for complimentary use on a first-come, first-served basis. Tulane will e-mail (preferred) or fax stats and other post-game information as requested.

### Visiting Radio/Television Broadcasts

Booth space in the Superdome press box will be allocated by the Tulane Athletic Communications Office. Visiting SIDs will designate their official radio stations in writing and Tulane, through its broadcast partner, ISP Sports, will supply phone lines on a reciprocal basis in that booth. Entities which wish to telecast home contests from the Superdome should send their request, in writing, to Roger Dunaway.

### Sidelines

Tulane follows guidelines set forth by the NCAA Public Relations Committee, the NCAA Football Rules Committee, the American Football Coaches Association and the National Press Photographers Association. Photographers are not permitted between the 25-yard lines and must have credentials visible at all times. Photographers are required to go behind the team benches to pass from one end of the field to the other.

Uniformed security personnel will patrol the sidelines and anyone holding a media pass who is not actively involved in coverage of the game will be escorted from the sideline. Children under 12 will not be issued media or sideline credentials. Similar procedures will be in effect in the press box.

### Post-Game Interviews

The Tulane locker room is located below the East stands near the North End Zone. The interview room is the first room on the left upon entering the locker room facility. The visitor's locker room is located adjacent to the tunnel at Gate A (North End Zone).

### Credential Regulations

All space for the working press, radio and television for Tulane Football games is allocated by the Tulane Athletic Communications Office, which reserves the right to deny credentials to any outlet. Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. Seating in the press box at the Superdome is for working media and scouts only.

Press credentials will be issued to working press only. Press credentials are not transferable and use by anyone other than members of the working media is prohibited. Press credentials used in an unauthorized manner will be revoked. News organizations allowing unauthorized individuals to use credentials will have their credentials revoked.

All press credentials remain the property of the Tulane Athletic Department and must be returned upon request. Credentials will NOT be mailed.

Tulane Athletics and its multimedia rights holder, ISP Sports, begin the sixth year of their partnership in 2007. As owner of broadcast and marketing rights for all Green Wave sports, ISP produces and distributes the game broadcasts and coaches' call-in shows on the Tulane ISP Radio Network throughout Louisiana and neighboring regions.

ISP additionally holds the rights to produce, sell and distribute Green Wave television shows, market print advertising in various athletic department publications and on the official athletics department website (www.TulaneGreenWave.com), and handle sales for all advertising signage in university athletic facilities.

In exchange for these rights, the university is guaranteed an annual rights fee while also sharing in additional revenues.

Serving as the flagship radio home of Tulane Football in 2007 will be WIST-AM (690). With WIST and affiliate WJSH-FM (104.7) in Hammond, Green Wave broadcasts can be heard throughout the New Orleans market.

At press time, eight other stations make up the Tulane ISP Sports Radio Network for 2007, including affiliates in Baton Rouge, Alexandria, Lafayette, Lake Charles, West Monroe and Shreveport.

Tulane Football game broadcasts, as well as the Tulane coaches' show, are available live on the internet via the Green Wave's Official Athletics Website at www.TulaneGreenWave.com through the new "WaveCast," and on the telephone thanks to Teamline, at 800-846-4700, team code 0647.

Each week during the football season, fans can email questions to Head Coach Bob Toledo on the "Tulane Coaches' Call-In Show," which is broadcast live from WOW Café and Wingery at the corner of State and Magazine in New Orleans every Monday night during the season beginning at 7 p.m.

Headquartered in Winston-Salem, N.C., ISP Sports is the exclusive multimedia rights holder for Auburn, Baylor, Boston College, California, UCLA, the University of Central Florida, Cincinnati, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Houston, Marshall, Ohio, Pittsburgh, Southern Miss, Syracuse, Tulane, Vanderbilt, Villanova, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

Additionally, ISP is a joint venture partner with Learfield Communications as rights holder for Alabama, Clemson, Miami and South Carolina. The company was founded in 1992 by current CEO and President Ben Sutton.

The general manager of the ISP Sports staff in New Orleans is Marc Tuttle, who began as General Manager with ISP this past summer. Prior to that position he was the Assistant Athletics Director for Marketing and Promotions at Tulsa.

Also on the Tulane ISP staff is account executive Meg Snyder, who came to Tulane from Pitney-Bowes in Rochester, N.Y.
