

Tulane-Tulsa Post Game Notes

- The Green Wave has lost seven straight games, the longest streak for the team since dropping in eight straight games
- Tulane falls to 1-4 in the all-time series against Tulsa and remains winless (0-2) in Tulsa
- Redshirt freshman J.T. McDonald rushed for a career-high 53 yards on one carry and scored his third career rushing touchdown.
- Sophomore tight end Cody Sparks tied his career single game high with three receptions today. Sparks also had three grabs against Louisiana-Monroe and Army.
- David Skehan recorded two interceptions and a career-best 11 tackles (5 solo) today vs. Tulsa.
- Junior Ross Thevenot punted a season-high seven times today. His previous high of five came against East Carolina, LSU and Houston
- Senior Michael Batiste extended his reception streak to 11 straight games with his 19-yard reception from Kevin Moore in the second quarter.
- Senior David Skehan picked off a pair of passes in the second quarter and now has three on the year and 11 for his career. The interceptions moved him into sole possession of sixth place on the school's career list.
- David Skehan now has two games with multiple interceptions. He also had two picks a year ago vs. Houston.
- Game captains for today's game were C Michael Parenton, DE Reggie Scott, DS Craig Gelhardt and WR Brian King
- Tulane center Michael Parenton started his 29 consecutive game, the longest active streak for the Green Wave, while Andrew Nierman made his 23rd straight start. Linebacker Evan Lee's streak of 25 consecutive starts was snapped today.
