### Perfection

- Has not missed a kick this year: has made all 15 of his field goal attempts, the most in the nation without a miss; and has also connected on 33-of-33 extra points.
- Is 7-for-7 on FGs of more than 40 yards and 3-for-3 on kicks longer than 50 yards this year.
- Has made 18-of-18 kicks from inside the 40-yard line since the end of the 1999 season. He is perfect from inside the 30 for his career (17-of-17).
- Leads Tulane and ranks 18th in the country in scoring with 77 points. That ranks fourth in Tulane history while his 15 field goals tie for third on the single season chart.
- Marler connected on a 51-yard boot versus TCU and made a career-record 53-yarder versus East Carolina, the second-longest in Tulane history.
- Also connected on a 51-yard boot versus TCU and a 50-yarder against Southern.
- Has moved within two three-pointers of the Tulane career record for field goals after making his 45th and 46th career threes at UAB.

- Moved up to third on the school scoring list (237) and is second all-time in kick scoring.
- Tied his career high with four field goals versus Southern, connecting on three-pointers of 25, 44, 50 and 23 yards. Scored 15 points in the game.
- Kicked three field goals of more than 40 yards versus UCF. Converted on kicks of 48, 43 and 46 yards. 46-yarder gave Tulane a 22-21 lead in the fourth quarter.
- Scored 12 points in the TCU game with six PATs and a pair of field goals, including his 51-yarder, his second-longest of the year.
- Hit two field goals and three PATs versus Cincinnati.
