Robert Morris (3-6) looks for their second road win of the season as they head to New Orleans, La., for the Tulane DoubleTree Tournament. The Colonials take on host Tulane (7-2) to open the tournament on Thursday, December 20, at 7:00 p.m. Eastern. Virginia Tech (8-2) and Texas-San Antonio (6-2) meet in the other first round game on Thursday at 5:00 p.m. Eastern. Robert Morris has played Tulane once in the past while a meeting with Texas-San Antonio or Virginia Tech would be the first.

Quick Stat

Junior guard Sade Logan and senior forward Chinata Nesbit are the fifth-highest scoring duo on in the nation averaging a combined 36.9 points per game. Logan is second on the nation averaging 23.8 points per game while Nesbit adds 13.1 points. Utah Valley State's tandem of Robyn Fairbanks (22.7) and Sandy Marvin (17.8) lead the nation combining for 40.5 points a game.

Head Coach Sal Buscaglia Fifth Season - Canisius '76

The 2007-08 Robert Morris University women's basketball team is led by 29-year veteran head coach Sal Buscaglia. Coach Sal, as he is respectfully called, is entering his fifth season at the helm and has turned the Colonials into not only a Northeast Conference contender, but a nationally competitive program in his short time at Robert Morris.

Four short years after inheriting a program that went 1-26 before his arrival, Buscaglia put the Colonials into the NCAA Tournament for the first time in team history. The 2006-07 Robert Morris squad won

their first NEC Tournament since 1991 while putting together a record of 24-8. The Colonials tied for the regular-season conference title with a 15-3 record, then pushed their way into March Madness with a 68-66 win over Sacred Heart in the title game.

Buscaglia has now led his teams to 10 national tournament appearances and only two losing seasons. The Colonials have finished with 20 wins each of the three two seasons, including a 20-9 record in 2005-06. His team's 20-10 mark in 2004-05 with his first recruiting class improved upon a 3-24 record the season before, marking the third largest turnaround in the nation in one season.

Along the way, Buscaglia tallied his 500th career head coaching victory and currently boasts an overall coaching record of 554-242. Buscaglia's teams own three of the five 20-win seasons and are the only squads to win 20-plus games in back-to-back seasons since the program's inception in 1977.

Coach Sal led the Colonials to the conference semifinals in 2005-06, one year after making it to the conference championship. During the 2004-05 season, the Colonials posted victories over Mid-American teams Akron and Marshall, along with Atlantic-10 member and cross-town rival Duquesne.

Before Robert Morris, Buscaglia spent five seasons at Manhattan College (1998-2003). In five seasons at Manhattan, Buscaglia compiled a record of 79-65, including a 20-10 record and NCAA Division I tournament appearance in 2002-03. In 2001-02, he was the MAAC Co-Coach of the Year guiding the Jaspers to an 18-10 record.

For eight seasons prior to his arrival at Manhattan, Buscaglia was head coach of the University at Buffalo from 1990-98 and led the Bulls to five 20-win campaigns. The Bulls won East Coast Conference regular season titles in 1992, 1993 and 1994, as well as tournament championships in 1992 and 1994. In 1994-95, Buffalo moved to the Mid-Continent Conference. In each of Buffalo's first three seasons in the Mid-Con, Buscaglia led the Bulls to at least 20 wins. For his efforts at Buffalo, Buscaglia earned New York State Coach of the Year honors in 1992 and 1996.

Buscaglia started his coaching career at Hilbert Junior College, in Hamburg, New York, where he is now a member of the Hall of Fame. In 12 seasons, he amassed a record of 249-62, collecting 93 straight league wins, eight straight Regional Tournament Championships, eight straight regular season conference championships, and eight straight National Tournament appearances.

Over his career, Buscaglia has won five conference titles at the Division I level and has averaged 18 victories per year. In his 13 years as a Division I head coach, Buscaglia has guided his teams to winning seasons in 11 of them. He also owns 13 Coach of the Year honors.

A native of Buffalo, New York, Buscaglia is a 1976 graduate of Canisius with a Bachelor of Science Degree in business and accounting and in 1989 earned a Master's Degree in physical education, also from Canisius. In 1980, Buscaglia received a Master's Degree in business education from the SUNY-Buffalo.

Scouting the Green Wave

Tulane has not played since December 5 when they beat Rhode Island, 74-65, improving to 7-2 on the year. Both of the Green Wave’s losses have come on their home court at Fogelman Arena where they are 1-2 this season. Tulane is 6-0 on the road. The Green Wave feature a balanced scoring attack with five players averaging over 6.0 points a game adding up to 63.7 points per game as a team. Their stingy defense allows just 56.8 points per game while holding opponents to 38.2 percent shooting from the floor. The Green Wave shoot 41.0 percent from the floor and 31.0 percent from long range. Brittany Lindsey leads the team in scoring (12.6) and rebounding (6.0). Ashley Langford adds 11.4 points while Nicki Lunghurst has hit 20-of-58 trifectas (.345).

Tulane Head Coach Lisa Stockton

Lisa Stockton is in her 14th season at the helm of the Tulane women’s basketball program, compiling a 273-129 record to this point of her career. The winningest coach in Conference USA, Stockton has a career mark of 334-154 in 16 seasons as a head coach. She has led the Green Wave to the nine NCAA Tournament appearances and has twice been named the conference coach of the year, including after last season’s 26-7 team and the C-USA regular season title. Stockton got her first head coaching stint at Greensboro College in 1987-88 and was an assistant at Georgia Tech for four seasons prior to her arrival at Tulane. A 1986 graduate of Wake Forest, she was the Demon Deacons’ all-time leader in scoring, assists and steals when she finished her four-year career.

RMU Last Time Out

Robert Morris lost a 75-70 decision to Ohio University Sunday night to fall to 3-6 on the season. The Colonials committed 26 turnovers and recorded just eight assists as the Bobcats scored 20 points on turnovers. Junior guards Kendra Williams and Angela Pace each had career-high point totals sharing team-high honors with 16 points each. Pace added 11 rebounds to record her first career double-double. Junior guard Sade Logan added 12 points, going 4-17 from the field, and senior guard Chinata Nesbit had 11 points. The Bobcats led, 60-54, after a Lauren Hmiel trifecta. After an RMU timeout, Logan converted a four-point play and Pace hit a layup to tie the game, 62-62, with 3:38 left. After trading baskets, Hmiel hit a three-pointer that gave Ohio the lead for good as they went on to a 75-70 win.

National Leader Logan

Junior guard Sade Logan is leading the nation in three-pointers, hitting 4.0 per game. The next closest player is hitting 3.4 per game. She is hitting 41.9 percent of her three-pointers, 50th in the nation. Logan has scored 30 or more points in three games this season and holds the RMU single-game record for shots attempted at 30. Twice this season she has hit eight three-pointers, one shy of the school record.

Team National Rankings

As a team, Robert Morris ranks in the top-100 in the nation in four of 16 categories compiled by the NCAA. The Colonials are seventh in the nation in three-point shooting percentage, hitting 40.3 percent of their attempts. RMU is 48th in the nation in steals, 11.3 per game, and 72nd in scoring offense (69.8) and 85th in fewest fouls per game (16.4).

Individual National Rankings

RMU's Chinata Nesbit and Angela Pace also appear in the national top-100. Nesbit is 75th nation averaging 8.7 rebounds per game and is 66th at 2.7 steals per game. Pace is 81st in the nation at 2.6 steals per contest.

Shoplifting

Senior forward Chinata Nesbit could have been charged for theft after recording a career-high eight steals in a 67-53 win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (12/8/07). Nesbit had four steals in each half of that game and leads the team with 22 steals overall. She is 66th in nation averaging 2.7 steals per game. Junior guard Angela Pace is second on the team with 24 steals and sits 81st nationally at 2.6 steals per contest. As a team, RMU is averaging 11.3 steals per game, 48th among the 326 teams in the nation.

Three for Me

It's no wonder why **Sade Logan** wears #3 on the back of her jersey. The 6-0 junior guard has attempted more three-pointers this season, 86, than the rest of the team combined, 33. Logan is averaging a team-best 23.8 points per game and has connected on 36-of-86 three-point attempts (41.9 percent). Logan is on pace to break every field goal season record. She is on pace for 677 attempts, 299 three-point attempts, 270 field goals and 96 three-point field goals.

Redshirt senior guard Psyche Butler became the 14th player in Robert Morris women's basketball history to record 500 career rebounds Wednesday night at Miami (Ohio). Butler, who recorded her first double-double of the season against the RedHawks with 10 points and 10 rebounds, is 14th all-time at RMU with 511 career rebounds. The guard is averaging 8.0 boards this season and had a career-best 18 rebounds against Duquesne (11/21/07). Butler's 274 rebounds during the 2005-06 season are the 10th most in a single season for a Robert Morris player.

The First & Hopefully Not the Last

Robert Morris earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament for the first time in the 30-history of the program. Robert Morris was issued a #13 seed. losing to #4 North Carolina State, 82-54, on the Wolfpack's home court and the Fresno Regional. The Colonials tied for the regular-season Northeast Conference title with a 15-3 record and a 24-8 overall mark. Robert Morris earned the right to play for the national title winning the NEC Tournament and the automatic bid.

Robert Morris returns just three players from last years team — redshirt-senior **Psyche Butler**, senior **Chinata Nesbit** and junior **Kendra Williams**. Combined, the three have played five seasons in Colonial jerseys. Williams came in as a true freshman playing in 2005-06 and 2006-07. Butler and Nesbit are both transfers. Butler came to RMU in 2005-06 as a transfer from New Mexico JC. Nesbit is also a transfer, having played at Chipola JC before joining the Colonial team last season.

Fifth-year head coach Sal Buscaglia has 10 new players on his bench this season, three true freshmen, six transfers, and one rejoining the squad after sitting out the 2006-07 season to concentrate on academics. **Shakeena Cunningham**, **Destiny Harrison** and **Tiffany McMillion** are the freshmen. **Brittany Dukes**, **Gwen Edwards**, **Joy Ike**, **Angela Pace**, **Latavia Vails** and **Grace Williams** all attended junior colleges before joining the RMU team. **Sade Logan** sat out the 2006-07 season after transferring to RMU from Chattanooga State.

2007-08 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll

The Robert Morris University women's basketball was selected to finish second in the Northeast Conference in 2007-08 according to a poll of the league's head coaches. Prior to winning the NEC Tournament title last season, the Colonials were picked to finish third in the league. Robert Morris was the preseason favorite in 2005-06 before finishing second in the regular season.

Robert Morris received three first-place votes while Long Island – tabbed the preseason favorite in 2007-08 – picked up six first-place votes and Quinnipiac took two votes. Quinnipiac was selected third, followed by Sacred Heart, Monmouth, St. Francis (N.Y.), Fairleigh Dickinson, Mount St. Mary's, Saint Francis (Pa.) and Central Connecticut State.

Senior **Chinata Nesbit** was selected to the NEC Preseason All-Conference team after finishing second in the conference in scoring (19.2 ppg) and rebounding (10.3 rpg). An All-NEC First Team pick last season, Nesbit was also fifth in the conference in blocks (34, 1.06 bpg) and seventh in assists (113, 3.53 apg). She was named the 2007 NEC Tournament Most Valuable Player, averaging 25.3 points and 10 rebounds in three playoff games. Nesbit finished with 15 double-doubles last season while leading the team in scoring 18 times and rebounding 23 times.

Senior **Psyche Butler** and junior **Kendra Williams** also return to the starting lineup for Robert Morris. Butler, the best defensive player on the squad, averaged 9.1 points and 6.2 rebounds per game last season. Williams returns to point guard after playing in every game last season. Senior **Psyche Butler** was named team captain for 2007-08 and **Kendra Williams** was named associate captain. Williams is the only returnee on the squad who has attended Robert Morris since her freshman season. Butler transferred to RMU from New Mexico JC and is the only player besides Williams who has played more than one season in a Colonial uniform.

The Butler Did It

Senior captain **Psyche Butler** put aside some of her offensive opportunities last season to concentrate on becoming the best defensive player on the team, and perhaps, the conference. In 2005-06, she averaged 12.2 points, 10.1 rebounds and took 218 shots. Last season, with **Sugeiry Monsac** returning from injury and **Chinata Nesbit** sharing some of the scoring load, Butler's numbers declined while defensive stock skyrocketed. Butler averaged 9.1 points, 6.2 rebounds and took 187 shots last season while consistently drawing the toughest defensive assignments.

Season to Remember

Senior **Chinata Nesbit** had one of the most impressive seasons in a Colonial uniform ever. The forward earned the Northeast Conference Tournament MVP and a spot on the NEC All-Conference First Team. She finished second in the conference in scoring (19.2) and rebounding (10.3). She filled the RMU single season record books as well, setting records for games played (32), points (613) and free throw attempts (230) while finishing in the top-five in points per game (19.2), rebound (331), blocks (34), field goals made (227), field goals attempted (475) and free throws made (145). She also had 113 assists, ninth all-time. In fact, it would be easier to list the categories that Nesbit's name doesn't appear in — steals (54), three point field goals (14), three point attempts (47), three point percentage (.298) and free-throw percentage (.630).

Sal-vation

In a span of just four years, **Sal Buscaglia** has turned the Robert Morris University women's basketball team into a perennial conference power and national contender. When Buscaglia arrived at RMU, the Colonials had only won seven games the previous three seasons. After suffering through his worst season record-wise as a head coach in 2003-04, Buscaglia turned the RMU program into a 20-win squad. After going 20-9 last season, Buscaglia became the first head coach in the program's history to guide a team to back-to-back 20 win seasons and led RMU to its first-ever NCAA Tournament while winning a team record 24 games last season.
