Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic

For the ninth time in the last 11 seasons the Green Wave will play host to the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic. The event is co-hosted by the title sponsor, the Allstate Sugar Bowl, and Tulane University, the host institution.

Past champions include the Baylor (2001), LSU (2002, 2005), Nebraska (2003), Oregon (2010) and Wisconsin (2000). Tulane has claimed the title a tournament-best three times, winning each season from 2007 to 2009.

This season's event will take place on Sept. 2-3 at Fogelman Arena.



Kathy Troclair Memorial Tournament

For the 15th time since 1990, the Olive and Blue will host the Kathy Troclair Memorial Tournament. Named after the most successful coach in Green Wave history, Troclair won 174 matches during her seven seasons on campus.

The only coach to lead a Tulane squad to 30-plus wins in a season, Troclair's life ended much too early due to ovarian cancer. This tournament and the Louisiana Volleyball Coaches Association's "Kathy Troclair Award" are both named after a coach that had a genuine love for the game, along with unmatched leadership, spirit and sportsmanship.

Putting the "Green" in Green Wave

The 2010 season featured 32 games, 13 wins overall and a 10-10 finish in Conference USA, but the major highlight of the campaign was that all of this happened with a roster that featured seven freshmen.

The squad started three freshmen all season, with two sophomores and two seniors making up the rest of the starting six and the libero spot. Mel Mandelbaum started all 32 matches at setter during her rookie campaign, while Cori Martone was named the Conference USA Freshman of the Year at seasons end.

Azarri Badawi started 23 matches as a freshman, while Milena Dragovic, Megan Peterson and Elysa Jackson all saw court time during their first competitive seasons.

The Olive and Blue took their lumps early on in the season, dropping their first seven games, but closed the season by winning their final three contests.

Like Watching Two Different Teams

If you had watched the Green Wave play their first five matches, then went on vacation, and returned to watch the final five matches of the season, you would have thought you were watching two totally different teams.

During the first five matches of 2011, Tulane reached 20 points in a set just four times and lost four of those matches in straight sets. Their only non-sweep came versus Purdue in a 3-1 loss at the Pit Invitational.

The team was hitting just .106 and their opponents were cranking out kills on over 30-percent of their attacks. During that span, Tulane mustered just 19 blocks and had only ten service aces. They had also been blocked 50 times in their first five matches.

Fast forward almost three months and Tulane was much better on the defensive side of the net and had cleaned up some of their early season hitting mistakes.

In their final five matches, four of which were wins for the Olive and Blue, Tulane posted a .278 hitting percentage and limited the opposition to just a .172 attacking percentage. Their serving game improved to the tune of 24 aces and 24 return errors by their opponents.

They improved their net play and added 42 blocks during that stretch, while offensively limited the other side of the net to just 25 blocks, exactly half of what they had allowed earlier in the season.

The improved play points towards a good start to the 2011 campaign.

Grot Garners All-Conference Honors

The lone Tulane player to earn All-Conference honors in 2010 was redshirt-sophomore Izabela Grot. In her first season on campus - after spending two seasons at Kansas State - Grot was the team's top offensive producer during the season.

Her offensive prowess garnered her a spot on the All-Conference USA Second Team. She ranked among the C-USA leaders (Top-20) in kills per-set (10th, 3.24), points per-set (3.63) and hitting percentage (16th, .271).

Cori Martone, who was the C-USA Freshman of the Year, was named to the All-Freshmen Team, as well.

Finishing Strong

The Green Wave started the 2011 campaign by losing six straight games, but after the young Tulane squad found their footing they rattled off wins in six of their final seven matches.

Tulane rattled off wins in nine of their final 14 matches and finished 10-10 in Conference USA action. Their .500 mark in C-USA play tied them for sixth overall with UAB, just one game behind Rice in the fifth spot.

During their final seven games, TU won four matches in straight sets, while winning a 3-1 decision at Marshall and taking a five-setter at UCF to start their streak.

Their lone loss came to UAB, 3-0, on November 14 at Fogelman Arena.

The Lone Rookie

The 2010 campaign featured only one Conference USA Player of the Week honor for Tulane, but Cori Martone was also the only freshman to win the award in the conference in 2010.

Martone boasted a .450 hitting percentage and helped the Green Wave their first two road victories of the season over the weekend. The freshman accounted for 2.88 kills and 2.00 blocks per set, while Tulane limited its opponents to a miniscule .110 hitting percentage.

At UCF, Martone posted a double-double with ten kills and ten blocks, hitting .333 in the five set win. Then on Sunday at UTEP, she again had a stellar outing with 13 kills - tying for the match-high - and added six blocks, two assists and one dig in the sweep of the Miners.

Best in the State

Three players grabbed All-Louisiana honors at seasons end for the Green Wave, as Izabela Grot, Cori Martone and Milica Jovic all grabbed postseason awards from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Grot was a First Team All-State pick and was honored as the Newcomer of the Year in Louisiana after leading the team in kills and points. She was among the league leaders in both categories, along with ranking 16th in hitting percentage.

Martone was honored with Second Team All-Louisiana laurels and was one of just two rookies to earn all-state honors. Jovic was an Honorable Mention pick for the All-State squad, which is voted on by the state's writers and sports information directors.

Keeping It in the Family

Conference USA has handed out the Freshman of the Year award every season since the league's inception in 1995 (16 seasons) and just seven schools have laid claim to the award.

Cincinnati owns five of those awards, while Louisville and Tulane have each pulled home four honors. USF has won two, while Houston, Marshall and Tulsa each have one recipient.

Cori Martone continues Tulane's recent dominance of the award by grabbing the distinction in 2010. The Baton Rouge, La. native was the fourth TU player to win the award in the past six seasons.
