Compliance Corner is a monthly column that features current topics of interest in athletic compliance with the goal of educating our loyal donors about NCAA rules and regulations.

At some time you may want a TU student-athlete to help promote your organization, or activities and events conducted by your organization. However, the NCAA stipulates specific criteria for which you and our student-athletes may do this.

The University of Tulsa, Conference USA, or non-institutional charitable, educational or non-profit agencies may use a student-athlete's name, picture or appearance to support its charitable or educational activities, provided the following conditions are met:

- Prior approval from the athletics department;
 - The student-athlete's name or picture may not appear on any promotional item if they have eligibility remaining;
 - While commercial items with the names or pictures of multiple student-athletes may only be sold at TU, institutionally controlled outlets, or outlets controlled by a charity or educational organization, items featuring individuals may not be sold;
 - The organization may only advertise their official trademark or logo for the event;
 - All proceeds derived from the activity or event must go directly to the organization;
- We want you to be able to conduct promotional activities with our student-athletes as permitted by the NCAA, but be sure to contact the Athletic Department or Compliance Office before doing so. As always if you are unsure or have further questions pertaining to these rules, be sure to **ASK BEFORE YOU ACT!**

Freshman women's basketball player, **Taleya Mayberry**, is quickly making a name for herself on the hardwood for the Golden Hurricane. In 18 games this season, she has started in all 18, averaging 10.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game.

As a local prep standout, Taleya was a four-year letterwinner at Tulsa's Booker T. Washington High School, where she led her team to the Class

5A State Championship as a junior and senior. She was twice named Most Valuable Player of the state tournament and was selected as the *Tulsa World Player of the Year* as a senior.

Taleya is the daughter of Lee and Marla Mayberry. Her father played nine years in the NBA for the Milwaukee Bucks and Vancouver Grizzlies. She is majoring in arts and sciences at TU.

Tulsa's Clarke named National Assistant Coach of the Year

TULSA, Oklahoma - TU assistant head coach **Colin Clarke** was named as the 2009 National Soccer Coaches Association of America Assistant Coach of the Year. Clarke also received regional coach of the year honors in December.

Clarke just concluded his seventh season with TU, as the Golden Hurricane posted a 15-5-2 overall record, captured the Conference USA regular season and tournament titles for the third-straight season and advanced to the NCAA Quarterfinals.

He has been an integral part of Tulsa soccer, helping TU record 87 wins, advance to the NCAA tournament five times, and has helped coach three All-Americans and 29 all-conference performers in the last seven years.

Recent happenings with Golden Hurricane Athletics

- TU softball seniors **Jackie Lawrence**, **Lauren Lindsay** and **Vanessa Vice** were named to the Pre-season All-Conference USA team. Lawrence and Lindsay were named to the All-C-USA first team last season, while Vice earned second team honors. The Golden Hurricane are coming off a record-breaking season in 2009 - one that saw them win the conference regular season and tournament championships, and for the first time in school history, advance to the regional championship round of the NCAA tournament.
- The TU men's basketball team claimed back-to-back Mayor's Cup victories with a 57-52 come from behind win over ORU on January 20. Senior **Jerome Jordan** led the way with 17 points and eight rebounds. "It was a hard-fought, ugly game, but we found a way to win," said head coach **Doug Wojcik**. "This was a great win for us, it was a great night and I am very happy for our guys, especially the seniors."
- TU head football coach, **Todd Graham**, announced the appointment of **Chad Morris** as the new Co-Offensive Coordinator and Quarterbacks coach for the Golden Hurricane. Morris is one of the most successful prep head coaches in Texas High School history. Most recently, Morris served as head coach at Lake Travis High School where he led them to back-to-back undefeated seasons and two Class 4A state titles.
