## TULSA COMPLETED SEASON WITH SEVENTH PLACE FINISH AT NCAA FAYETTEVILLE REGIONAL . . .

√ The Tulsa men's golf team finished in seventh-place in a 14-team field at the NCAA Fayetteville Regional, May 16-18, in Fayetteville, Arkansas. It was Tulsa's 23rd appearance in 25 years of NCAA Regional competition under Head Coach Bill Brogden.

The Hurricane carded rounds of 303-292-313 for a 908 total at The Blessings Golf Club. Tulsa finished 16 strokes behind the all-important fifth-place, as the low five teams advanced to the NCAA Championship Finals. Illinois, Arkansas, Texas, Oklahoma State and Kent State finished 1 thru 5 and advanced to the NCAA Championship.

For the Hurricane, junior Mark Mumford had Tulsa's best finish with a 20th place score of 223, while senior Chris Worrell completed his collegiate career with a 37th place finish as he carded a 54-hole total of 228.

## McCRACKEN AND WORRELL EARN C-USA HONORS . . .

√ Senior Chris Worrell and junior Logan McCracken were named all-Conference USA second team selections, as voted by the league's coaches.

Worrell and McCracken share the team-lead with a 73.2 stroke average in 31 rounds of golf this season.

Worrell, a three-time C-USA all-academic performer, has placed among the top-25 in six of 11 tournaments this season. He had a career-best second-place finish at the GolfWeek Conference Challenge in the season-opening tournament.

McCracken is in his first year at Tulsa after transferring from Texas Tech. He had a career-best second-place performance at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic, while finishing among the top-10 in three other events.

## TULSA PLACES SIXTH AT C-USA CHAMPIONSHIP . . .

√ The Tulsa men's golf team finished in sixth place at the 2013 Conference USA Men's Golf Championship, April 21-23. Tulsa carded rounds of 297-291-293 and finished the 54-hole tournament with a score of 881 at the par 72, 6,935-yard Texarkana Country Club.

All five Tulsa golfers finished the tournament separated from the next by one stroke. Senior Chirs Worrell, after a horrible opening round 11-over par 83, regrouped to shoot rounds of 68-71 for five-under par score over the final 36 holes.

Worrell finished in 28th place, while junior Mark Mumford placed 30th and was followed by junior Logan McCracken in 34th place and sophomore Matt Mabrey in 35th place.

## MABREY WINS C-USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR . . .

√ Tulsa sophomore Matt Mabrey claimed Tulsa's lone Conference USA Golf Athlete of the Week honor this year. He garnered the weekly award on February 13 after turning in a fifth-place performance at the UTSA Oak Hills Invitational.

## **WORRELL EARNS ALL-ACADEMIC HONORS FOR THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR . . .**

√ Tulsa senior men's golfer Chris Worrell was named to the Conference USA Men's Golf Academic Team for the third consecutive year. Worrell has maintained a 3.84 grade point average in finance and is the only repeat performer on this season's all-academic golf team.

The senior from Enid, Oklahoma has a team-leading 73.2 stroke average in 31 rounds of golf this year. He had a season-best second-place performance at the GolfWeek Conference Challenge and has placed among the top-25 in six of 10 tournaments, including four top-10 finishes. Worrell has played in 47 career events and has finished among the top-20 at 14 of those tournaments.

## **THE TULSA ROSTER . . .**

**MARK HICKS** . . . a sophomore . . . has not seen action yet for Tulsa . . . did not play in the 2012-13 and 2011-12, while red-shirting in the 2010-11 season . . . qualified for the 2010 U.S. Amateur and the 2009 U.S. Junior Amateur . . . tied for first at the U.S. Amateur Sectional Qualifier in Mission Viejo, Calif. . . . was named the Desert Valley League MVP as a sophomore and junior . . . was a three-time all Desert Valley League performer . . . won the DVL Individual Championships as a sophomore and a junior.

**CODY KENT** . . . a sophomore . . . has played in only two career tournaments . . . his only action in 2012-13 was a 55th-place performance at the Rod Myers Invitational . . . has a 77.3 stroke average in three rounds this year . . . in 2011-12, saw his only action at the Desert Shootout as he averaged 73.3 strokes and finished in 48th place playing as an individual . . . did not play in 2010-11 season . . . qualified for the U.S. Amateur in 2010 . . . placed third at the U.S. Amateur Sectional Qualifier in Aurora, Colo. . . . placed fourth at the 2010 Colorado State Amateur . . . tied for second at the Colorado AJGA tournament in 2009 . . . in high school, was a three-time first team Colorado All-State selection and two-time state individual runner-up . . . was a two-time team state champion, two-time Continental League Low Player of the Year . . . was a four-time first-team All-Continental League selection.

**MATT MABREY** . . . has played in 22 career tournaments and has placed among the top-20 nine times . . . has a 73.8 stroke average in 34 rounds this year, while holding a team-best 73.8 stroke average in 19 rounds this spring . . . placed among the top-25 six times in 12 tournaments in the 2012-13 season . . . best performance was fifth-place at both the David Toms Invitational and the UTSA Oak Hills Invitational . . . earned C-USA All-Freshman Team honors in 2012 . . . played in 10 tournaments and finished among the top-20 five times with four top-15 performances in 2011-12 . . . had a 73.6 stroke average in 30 rounds in 2011-12 . . . turned in a career-best 4th place performance at the Louisiana Classics in 2011-12 . . . also had a 10th place performance at The Woodlands All-American and 13th finish at the Conference USA Championship . . . had a 15th place finish in his first career tournament at the 2011 Northern Intercollegiate . . . had a team-best 72.6 stroke average in 18 rounds during the spring 2012 season.

**LOGAN McCracken** . . . completed his first year at Tulsa after transferring from Texas Tech . . . was named second-team all-Conference USA in 2012-13 . . . played in all 12 tournaments and had a 73.7 stroke average . . . had seven top-20 performances this year . . . had a career-best second-place finish at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic . . . also placed fifth at the Rod Myers Invitational and seventh at the GolfWeek Conference Challenge . . . had a 73.7 stroke average in eight tournaments and 24 rounds during the 2011-12 season at Texas Tech . . . played his prep golf at Putnam City North High School.

**MARK MUMFORD** . . . has played in 23 career tournaments, including 11 this year, 10 in 2011-12 and two in the 2009-10 campaign . . . had a 75.5 stroke average in 31 rounds this year . . . had a career-best 12th place finish at the UTSA Oak Hills Invitational this year . . . had Tulsa's best finish at the NCAA Fayetteville Regional with a 20th place performance . . . had five top-30 performances in 2012-13 . . . placed among the top-30 in five tournaments in the 2011-12 campaign . . . had a 74.5 stroke average in 30 rounds in 2011-12 . . . did not play in the 2010-11 season . . . played in two tournaments in 2009-10 . . . his best finish in 2009-10 was 59th place at the Baylor Intercollegiate . . . had a 77.5 stroke average as a freshman in 2009-10 . . . was a Future Collegians World Tour All-American . . . was a New York all-state selection as a junior and senior.

**COLTON STAGGS** . . . has played in 18 career tournaments at Tulsa . . . transferred to Tulsa from Oklahoma State prior to the spring 2012 season . . . had a 74.9 stroke average in 34 rounds this year . . . had five top-20 performances in 2012-13 . . . his best finish was 16th place at the Desert Shootout . . . played in six events and had a 77.0 stroke average in 18 rounds during the spring 2012 season after transferring from OSU . . . best 2012 finish was 16th place at the 2012 NCAA Greensboro Regional . . . was a four-time all-conference selection at Jenks (Okla.) High School . . . was an all-state selection for the Trojans as well . . . also named the Tulsa World All-Metro Golfer of the Year . . . captured Class 6A regional titles in 2007 and 2008 . . . won the PGA South Central Junior Championship in 2008 and 2009 . . . won the 2009 OGA Men's State Amateur to become the youngest winner in the history of the event.

**CHRIS WORRELL** . . . played in 48 of 54 career tournaments . . . has earned C-USA All-Academic team honors for three straight years . . . had a team-leading 73.4 stroke average in 34 rounds during the 2012-13 campaign . . . earned second-team all-C-USA honors as a senior . . . placed among the top-25 in six of 11 tournaments in 2012-13 . . . had a career-best second place finish at the GolfWeek Conference Challenge in the season-opening tournament . . . had a 73.5 stroke average in 36 rounds in 2011-12 . . . played in all 12 tournaments in 2010-11 and had a team-leading 73.5 stroke average in 39 rounds . . . was named second-team all-C-USA in 2010-11 . . . had seven top-20 finishes in the 2010-11 season, while turning in a season-best sixth place finish in back-to-back tournaments at the Desert Shootout and the National Invitational . . . had a career-best round five-under par 67 in the second round at the Desert Shootout in 2010-11 . . . played in 11 of 12 tournaments in 2009-10 . . . had a 75.6 stroke average in the 2009-10 season.

#### **BROGDEN COMPLETES 27th SEASON AT TULSA . . .**

√ Bill Brogden completed his 27th year as the men's golf coach and assistant athletic director at The University of Tulsa in the 2012-13 season.

In 44 years as a collegiate golf coach, Brogden has taken teams to national prominence at four different schools.

During that time, his teams have qualified for national competition 37 times, including 19 times to the national championship round. Brogden has earned conference coach of the year accolades 11 times, has been inducted into the GCAA Hall of Fame, has coached 22 All-Americans and has won 16 conference championships.

Under Brogden's guidance, Tulsa has won seven Missouri Valley Conference titles and captured the Western Athletic Conference Championship in 2002. Tulsa finished as the WAC runner-up in 2001, 2003 and 2004, and in 2005 tied for the school's second WAC title.

In 2006-07, Brogden led the Hurricane to the 2007 Conference USA crown and the NCAA Central Regional title. He was named C-USA and the Central Regional Coach of the Year.

Tulsa has made seven appearances at the NCAA Championships under Brogden – 1987, 1988, 1995, 2002, 2005, 2007 and 2012. .

In 2002, Brogden's team placed third at the NCAA Central Regional and advanced to the NCAA Championships. The Hurricane entered the final round in second-place and finished with the school's highest national finish with a ninth place performance.

Brogden was named the Central Region Coach of the Year in 2002 and 2007 as selected by the Golf Coaches Association of America.

Brogden was named as the TU coach on September 2, 1986 following 10 seasons as the head coach at Oral Roberts University. At ORU, Brogden's teams made seven NCAA Championship appearances, captured six Midwestern Collegiate Conference titles and won 15 tournaments. He was named the National Coach of the Year in 1980 and added the District V Coach of the Year honors in '80, '81 and '85.

Before his appointment at ORU, Brogden coached for five years at LSU and two years at Memphis.
