THE SERIES

UT Arlington and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi have played seven times with the Islanders taking five victories. Most recently, UTA defeated Texas A&M-Corpus Christi at the American Bank Center, 57-55. It remains UT Arlington's only conference road victory. The Mavericks are currently in a season-long three-game losing streak. The Islanders are 2-1 against UTA at Texas Hall.

ABOUT THE ISLANDERS

The Islanders are coming off a loss at home against Texas State in a game where the visitors held Texas A&M-Corpus Christi to 44 percent shooting from the field and forced 19 turnovers. Before the loss at home, the Islanders swept a two-game road trip with victories against Southeastern Louisiana and Nicholls State. The Islanders have a winning record on the road in conference at 3-2.

TRENDS

*Not including the Lamar game - he played only 10 minutes because of injury - UT Arlington guard Rog'er Guignard is averaging 20 points per game since the victory against UT Pan American.

UTA sports one of the best field-goal percentage defenses in the country, but in the past three losses, the Mavericks have allowed teams to shoot 49.1 percent, 46 percent and 44 percent.

In his past four games, UTA senior center Jermaine Griffin is averaging 18.7 points per game.

In UTA's past three games, Griffin and fellow inside players Anthony Vereen and Larry Posey have combined to average 9.3 rebounds. Their season average is 16.8.

GRIFFIN REACHES MILESTONE

With his 10-point performance against Northwestern State on Jan. 5, senior center **Jermaine Griffin** became the eighth player in UTA men's basketball history to score at least 1,000 points and pull down at least 500 rebounds.

In addition to the scoring and rebounding milestone, Griffin has been a defensive presence inside during his four-year career. The former Houston Wheatley standout set the Mavs' career blocks record with two blocks at SE Louisiana on Jan. 13, 2007. The senior now has 141 career blocked shots.

His 58 blocked shots last season is a single-season record, eclipsing 43 set by Paul Renfro in 1979-80. Griffin was the Southland Conference Player of the Week for the first week of the season after 16 points and 14 rebounds in a 79-58 win over UC Riverside on Nov. 12.

He became just the second Mav to score 70-or-more 3-point field goals with 71 last season. Willie Brand set the season record of 77 in 1990-91.
