Redbird Arena - Normal, Ill.

The UT Arlington Mavericks return to the road as they travel to Normal, Ill., for the first time in program history to face Missouri Valley Conference foe Illinois State.

UT Arlington (3-2) dropped a heart-breaking 74-73 loss at Texas-Pan American on Monday evening in Edinburg.

UT Arlington junior forward Jermaine Griffin was whistled for a foul with 0.1-seconds left in regulation while six players battled for a loose ball after an Anthony Vereen shot missed as the clock ran down. Texas-Pan American

reserve Zach Trader made the first of two free throws to rally the Broncs from an 11-point deficit in the final 10 minutes of the game for the win.

UTA had control of the game throughout the first half and early in the second half. The Mavs built their largest lead of the game, 58-47, after two Matt Read free throws with 10:16 to play.

UTA's scheduled game versus Austin College was postponed due to inclement weather in the Dallas area on Thursday. Saturday's game is the second of what is now a six-game road trip for the Mavericks. Following Saturday's game, UT Arlington will travel to Western Illinois for a 7 p.m game against the Leathernecks.

THE SERIES

Saturday's game is the first meeting between UT Arlington and Illinois State. UT Arlington is 1-15 all-time against current members of the Missouri Valley Conference. The Mavs' only win against an MVC team was a 61-60 win at Bradley on Dec. 5, 2000.

TEAM CONCEPT

Scott Cross has used the team concept through the first five regular-season games. Five are scoring in double-figures - Jermaine Griffin (14.2), Larry Posey (12.0), Anthony Vereen (15.6), Rodrick Epps (12.2) and Ro'ger Guignard (10.6).

Six different players have scored double figures this season.

CARDELL COMES THROUGH

Freshman guard **Cardell Hunter** (Dallas, Texas) scored a career-high eight points in the first half of the Mavs' win over Texas-Pan American on Nov. 21.

MAVERICKS ON THE COURT, TIGERS OFF

The UT Arlington men's basketball team may be Mavericks on the court, but for a day they were Tigers off the hardwood.

The Mavericks spent last Friday visiting with student at Thornton Elementary School in Arlington on Nov. 17. The visit has become an annual visit where players and coaches de-

liver motivational talks and signs autographs for the students.

PRIME TIME

The UT Arlington Mavericks will be shown on television a minimum of four times during the 2006-07 season.

The Mavs premiered on the Mountain Network when UT Arlington met TCU.

UT Arlington will be shown in Oklahoma and parts of Kansas and Missouri when they are on the Sooner Network for the UT Arlington-Oklahoma basketball game on Saturday, Dec. 16.

The match up between nationally-ranked Texas and UT Arlington will be shown in a five-state region on FOX Southwest on Jan. 2.

Finally, the Mavs will travel to Corpus Christi for a SLC match up with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on FOXSW.

UT Arlington could make a fifth live television appearance if they reach the finals of the O'Reilly Auto Parts SLC Postseason Tournament, March 11, 2007, from the Campbell Center in Aldine, Texas.

Time Warner Cable will tape-delay nine Maverick home Maverick men's basketball. Only the Dec. 30 versus UT-Dallas will not be tape-delayed this season.

SCOUTING THE REDBIRDS

Illinois State has won four straight games after dropping thier first two of the season. The Redbirds defeated Sacramento State 89-69 on Wednesday.

ISU has used balance on the offensive end with four players - Boo Richardson (13.7), Dominatrix Johnson (13.5), Anthony Slack (11.2) and Greg Dillinger (11.0) -scoring in double figures.

The Redbirds are holding opponents to 59.7 points per game and 41.9% field-goal shooting. Opponents have made just 18 3-pointers in six games against ISU.

EARLY SIGNING

Fort Worth Dunbar High School guard **DeAndre Brown** and Dallas Skyline High School forward **LaMarcus Reed** have signed National Letters of Intent (NLI) to play for the UT Arlington men's basketball program in 2007-08.

Brown (5-11, 165), averaged 14.7 points, 7.6 assists and 3.1 steals while earning first-team all-state honors by the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABC) as a junior for Dunbar High School. He has been ranked as high as the 94th best prospect in the nation by Rivals.com. He is considered one of the top 25 high school prospects by several recruiting services including Clark Francis' Hoop Scoop (7th), Tim Onkst's Texas Roundball.com (21st) and Rivals.com (14th).

Brown, who chose UTA over Nebraska, Houston and SMU, ran the point guard position for the Dunbar Flying Wildcats to the UIL Class 4A state championship game. He had 18 points, six rebounds and seven assists in Dunbar's 95-66 win over San Antonio Brackenridge in the state title game. In addition to being named to the All-Tournament Team at the state tournament, Brown was named all-region, first-team all district and was the MVP of the 2005 Whataburger Holiday Tournament.

Reed (6-5, 180) averaged 13.0 points and 9.8 rebounds per game in 2006 for SHS and earned first-team all-district and was named second team all-state by TABC. He was ranked 18th in the state, according to TexasRoundball.com and 21st in the state by rivals.com.

MAVS OVERSEAS

Three members of last season's team are currently playing professional basketball overseas.

Former Maverick players **Steven Thomas** (Grindavik of the Iceland Express League), **Jarrett Howell** (SKK Katwica-Kolobrzeg of the Polish Dominet Basket Liga) and **Kenneth Henderson** (Rotterdam Basketball in the Holland League) signed one-year contracts and are currently playing for their respective clubs.

GRIFFIN THROWS UP A WALL

Junior **Jermaine Griffin** (Houston, Texas) made an early statement with a career-high five blocked shots in the season-opening win over UT-Tyler. The five blocks ties for the fourth most in the program history.

Offensively, Griffin had a career-high 24 points in the win over North Texas.

POWER IN THE PAINT

The inside game of the Mavericks has been a strength so far this season. The inside starting trio of **Jermaine Griffin**, **Anthony Vereen** and **Larry Posey** are averaging collective 46.8 points and 21.0 rebounds per game. Griffin (72.2%), Vereen (63.2%) and Posey (55.3%) are shooting better than 50% from the field and the three have combined to make 67.6% (42 of 62) from the foul line.

FAB FRESHMEN

The UT Arlington freshman class has made an early impact in the lineup. Freshman Ro'ger Guignard is averaging 10.6 points per game. Four freshmen - **Cardell Hunter**, **Guignard**, **Tommy Moffitt** and **Matt Read** - combined for 31 points, 15 rebounds, eight assists and four steals in the win over UT-Tyler.

Game 6: UT Arlington at Illinois State

THE LITTLE GENERAL

Freshman guard Ro'ger Guignard has been the biggest surprise of the season for the Mavs. A true freshman from Mesquite Horn High School, Guignard is shooting 41.9 percent from 3-point range (13 of 31) and has just five turnovers in 170 minutes of play. He canned a career-high 16 points at Texas-Pan American on Monday. He has scored in double figures in four of five games this season and lead the team with 12 3-pointers in five games.

HOME GROWN

Twelve players hail from Texas on the UT Arlington roster. Only sophomore guard **Brandon Long** (Richton Park, Ill.) is from out of state. Sophomore forward **Anthony Vereen** is originally from Hammond, La., but played at Gulf Shores Academy in Houston before signing to play for the Mavericks.

THE HUNT FOR 100

UT Arlington has scored 100 or more points in just two of the past 312 games. The last 100-point game was a 103-45 win over Hardin Simmons on Dec. 29, 2001, at Texas Hall.

HOT FROM THE FIELD

UT Arlington has shot better than 50 per-

cent from the field in four of five games this season. The Mavs made 46.7 % in a double-over-time loss at TCU. For the year, UTA is shooting 53.1 percent from the field.

The last time UTA shot 50 percent from the field for a season was 1981-82 when the Mavs made a school-record 52.6 percent from the field. UTA has shot better than 50 percent from the field just twice since 1959.

Seven players are shooting better than 50% - Cardell Hunter (77.8%), Jermaine Griffin (68.3%), Anthony Vereen (65.2%), Matt Read (62.5%), Larry Posey (54.8%), Tommy Moffitt (56.0%) and Terrell Henry (50.0%).

DISHING THE ROCK

UT Arlington guards Ro'ger Guignard and Rodrick Epps have spread the ball during the first five games. Guignard and Epps have combined for 36 assists.

ROAD WINS RARE FOR MAVS

UT Arlington looks for its second road win of the season at Illinois State on Saturday. With five of their next six games on the road, the Mavs can make a statement with some wins away from Texas Hall. UTA has not won more than six away games since the 1990-91 season when the Mavs went 8-7. UT Arlington has posted a winning records on away games twice in program history - 1980-81 and 1990-91.

COLD FROM OUTSIDE

UT Arlington was limited to one 3-point field goals (1 of 11) during the Mavs' 76-69 win over Texas-Pan American Nov. 21. The 1 for 11 effort tied for seventh lowest 3-point goal percentage in a game.

PUTTING IT ON THE LINE

UTA looks to steady their foul shooting. The Mavs are shooting 61.7% from the line (67 of 109). UTA has shot lower than 50% from the line in two of the five games this season. UTA made 6 of 11 ((54.5%) at Texas-Pan American on Monday, 12 of 22 (54.5%) versus UT-Tyler and 11 of 24 (45.8%) at TCU. UTA shot a season-best 76.7% (23 of 30) at North Texas on Nov. 15.

INJURIES

UTA reports no injuries.

NEXT GAME

UT Arlington travels to Illinois State on Saturday at 7 p.m.
