MAVS GO FOR 15 STRAIGHT AT HOME

UT Arlington looks to extend its school-record 15-game home-court win streak with a 4 p.m. game Saturday against Southeastern Louisiana at Texas Hall. The old record was 12 consecutive victories at UTA's home arena.

QUICK HITS

With 4 3-pointers against Nicholls State, Rod Epps moved into fifth place all-time at UTA in 3-pointer made in a career. Epps has hit 134 3-pointers, moving ahead of Jabari Johnson. A senior from Dallas Lake Highlands HS, Epps needs 29 3-pointers to tie Steven Barber... UT Arlington sophomore guard Roger Guignard has hit 21 of his past 48 3-pointers (43.8 percent) over a span of five games...UTA enters the game against Southeastern shooting 61.8 percent from the free-throw line, but the Mavericks turned in one of their best games at the line this season on Thursday against Nicholls State by hitting 18 of 23...Forward Anthony Vereen started for the first time this season on Thursday against Nicholls. Vereen, a 6-foot-7 junior forward, has scored in double-figures in 10 of UTA's 15 games this season. In the non-conference season, UTA defeated a school-record six Division I schools (UALR, Wichita State, UC Riverside, Texas Southern, North Texas and Western Illinois)...After using the same starting lineup for the first nine games this season, UTA has used a different starting five in each of the past three games.

THE SERIES

UT Arlington won 14 of the first 15 matchups between the universities from 1983 to 2004. SLU reversed the trend recently, winning three of the past four. Southeastern captured a victory against UTA, 71-63, during the 2005-06 season the last time they played in Arlington.

ABOUT THE LIONS

Southeastern already has two impressive league victories on its resume! The Lions defeated Sam Houston State, 61-58, in Huntsville to open the conference season. Entering the game, Sam Houston State was ranked in the Top 10 among Mid-Major school and received votes in the Associated Press Top 25 rankings. After a loss against Stephen F. Austin at home, the Lions rebounded by defeating Texas State, 84-83, in its most recent game Thursday night. Kevyn Green scored 27 points and Dekyron Nicks hit two key free throws with nine seconds left to lift Southeastern to victory.

GRIFFIN REACHES MILESTONE

With his 10-point performance against Northwestern State, senior center **Jermaine Griffin** became the eighth player in UTA men's basketball history to score at least 1,000 points and pull down at least 500 rebounds.

In addition to the scoring and rebounding milestone, Griffin has been a defensive presence inside during his four-year career. The former Houston Wheatley standout set the Mavs' career blocks record with two blocks at SE Louisiana on Jan. 13, 2007. The senior now has 130 career blocked shots.

His 58 blocked shots last season is a single-season record, eclipsing 43 set by Paul Renfro in 1979-80. Griffin was the Southland Conference Player of the Week for the first week of the season after 16 points and 14 rebounds in a 79-58 win over UC Riverside on Nov. 12.

FAB FRESHMAN NOW A SUPER SOPH

Sophomore point guard **Ro'ger Guignard** is averaging 12.4 points (2nd on the team). He is second on the team with 3.36 assists per game and leads the Mavericks with 41 3-pointers made and 26 steals.

Guignard had a career high seven steals against North Texas on Nov. 21, one shy of a school record. He became the first Mav since Derrick Obasohan in 2000-01 to win the SLC Freshman of the Year last season. He was the first Maverick to average in double figures as a freshman since Bill Washington in 1996-97 by scoring 10.9 points per game in 30 games last season. He became just the second Mav to score 70-or-more 3-point field goals with 71 last season. Willie Brand set the season record of 77 in 1990-91. He needs 18 3-pointers to reach 100 in his career and 23 to move into 10th on the all-time list.
