UT ARLINGTON NCAA REGIONAL GOLF NOTEBOOK

A LOOK AT THE MAVERICKS: The UT Arlington golf team is at the NCAA Austin Regional this Thursday-Saturday (May 14-16)...the top 5 teams (out of 13) will advance to the NCAA Finals at the Inverness Club in Toledo, Ohio from May 27-30...The Mavericks will enter the regional as the ninth seed and join the following schools in the tournament - Stanford, Florida, Texas Tech, Texas, UNLV, California, Lamar, Michigan, Virginia Tech, Mississippi State, New Mexico State and Jackson State.

MAVERICKS FINISHING IN HIGH PLACES: UTA has played 10 tournaments this season, winning one - the UTA/Waterchase Invitational...the team also registered 3 second 7 top 4 finishes and had 9 top 10 finishes in these 10 tournaments...the Mavs had 2 tournaments canceled due to weather - the Rees Jones Invitational in the fall and the Shocker Classic in the spring.

UTA NCAA REGIONAL HISTORY: This NCAA Regional appearance is the second consecutive, fourth in the last 5 years and the seventh in school history... Last year the team played at Ohio State's Scarlet Course in Columbus, Ohio and finished 22nd with Bobby Massa being the top individual as he finished in a tie for 33rd...the Mavs also made the postseason in 2005 and 2006. In 2005 the team finished 21st at the West Regional in Palo Alto, Calif., and then finished in a tie for 16th in 2006 at the Central Regional in Cleveland, Ohio...UTA also made regional appearances in 1998 (15th at Oak Hills CC in San Antonio), 1999 (T15th, at Ohio State's Scarlet Course) and 2002 (T17th, Little Rock, Ark.).

FOURSOME OF MAVERICKS EARN ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS: Bobby Massa, Zack Fischer and Michael Van deVenter were named to the first, second and third All-Southland Conference teams respectively while Bryce Easton earned honorable mention honors.

MASSA A TWO-TIME FIRST TEAMER: Bobby Massa was named to the All-Southland first team for the second consecutive season earlier this month...he is now just the fourth UTA golfer to earn multiple first team all-conference honors joining Greg Gregory (1993, 1995), Harry Singh (1996, 1998) and Shad Muth (2001-02).

REES EARNS COACH OF THE YEAR: Head coach Jay Rees earned his second Southland Conference Coach of the Year award following the 2009 regular season...the Mavs head coach, who is in his 10th year at the helm, also won the award in 2005.

MASSA ON TRACK TO SET SCHOOL RECORD: Bobby Massa's 71.97 stroke average is on pace to set a school record breaking the current mark of 72.6 held by Adam Babb (72.685 in 2000) and Tyrone Mordt (72.694 in 2003).

SEASON RECORD: The Mavericks fashioned a 116-31-1 head-to-head record this season during their 10 tournaments...they also went 4-5 against teams in this regional - 2-0 vs. New Mexico State, 1-0 vs. UNLV, 1-1 vs. Mississippi State, 0-1 vs. Texas and Texas Tech and 0-2 vs. Lamar.

LATEST RANKINGS: UTA is ranked 49th in the latest golfstat.com rankings as of May 4...they are ranked 53rd in the last golfweek.com rankings...Bobby Massa is 55th in the golfstat.com individual rankings...he is 73rd in the golfweek rankings.

FAMILIAR PLACE: The Mavericks have had success at The University of Texas Golf Club as all of the players head coach Jay Rees will take with him have played the course a number of times and the team tied for first in last Texas Intercollegiate Cup which was held there in the fall of 2007.

SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT RECAP: The Mavericks finished second behind conference champion Lamar, with whom UTA is paired with in the first round of the regional...Zack Fischer was a co-medalist and then was eliminated after the first hole of the three-way playoff.



HEAD COACH JAY REES



One of the top young coaches in the nation, UT Arlington Men's Golf Coach Jay Rees is in his 10th season at the helm of the Mavericks golf program.

Rees was honored following the 2009 regular season with his second Southland Conference Coach of the Year honor as he guided the Mavericks to seven top 10 finishes during the season.

This regional appearance is the fourth in five years for his teams.

His team won the UTA/Waterchase Invitational and then had four second place finishes including at the conference

tournament.

This season he coached four players to all-conference honors including first teamer Bobby Massa, second teamer Zack Fischer, third team Michael Van deVenter and honorable mention selection Bryce Easton.

Rees earned his first Southland Conference Coach of the Year award in 2005 after leading the Mavericks to two consecutive NCAA Regional Tournaments.

Rees has quickly established UT Arlington as one of the top mid-major college golf programs in the nation. He has directed UT Arlington to NCAA Regional Tournament berths in five of the past seven seasons and has had a representative from UTA at the NAAs in seven of his 10 seasons.

In 2007-08, the Mavericks had the best fall season in school history. UTA finished first in two of its first three tournaments, then turned in a record-breaking performance in Hawaii. At the Turtle Bay Invitational, the Mavericks shot a school-record 270-281-272=823. The Mavericks remained in the golfstat.com Top 50 the entire fall season. In the spring, the Mavericks had four top six performances and rode those results to an at-large berth in the NCAA Central Regionals.

Rees led the Mavericks to their best conference finish in 2005. That year, UTA set a school record at the Southland Conference Tournament, posting a 54-hole total of 861 to win the conference championship by 13 strokes over runner-up Louisiana-Monroe and 28 better than traditional power Lamar.

UTA also dominated the individual accolades with Rees earning his first SLC Coach of the Year honor, then-senior Jordan Krantz was named the Player of the Year, junior Jeff Murray was Newcomer of the Year and Krantz shared the league's Student-Athlete of the Year award.

"I am committed to making UT Arlington a golf school," Rees said. "Our goal is to be one of the top 30 golf programs in the nation. We have upgraded our program in terms of schedule and I think we have set the foundation to do something special here."

In 2005-06, UT Arlington won three tournaments and posted an impressive 10 top four finishes during the 13-tournament schedule. Three different individuals — Krantz, Murray and Tyrone Mordt — posted tournament wins as individuals and all six golfers that competed in tournament play last season placed in eighth place or better during the season. As a team, UT Arlington golfers compiled 19 top-10 finishes and 37 in the top 20. As a team, the Mavericks finished the year ranked 53rd by golfstat.com.

For his career, Rees' Mavericks have won six tournaments, recorded 48 top-5 finishes and 77 top-10 efforts.

Rees led the Mavs to the 2002 NCAA Central Regional Tournament, the 2005 NCAA West Regionals and the 2006 NCAA Central Regionals. Individually, Adam Babb (2000) and Shad Muth (2001) made NCAA tournament appearances, before taking the entire team in 2002.

In 2002, the squad was ranked 52nd in the Golfweek national poll and 57th nationally in the Golfstat rankings. In the 2005-06 season, the Mavericks cracked the top 40 for most of the season before settling for

a top-60 finish.

Rees' work ethic has made him a solid recruiter. In the fall 2000 season, Golfstat rated his freshman class as the first-year class having the greatest impact on its team in the nation that season.

Rees arrived at UT Arlington after spending three years at Texas Lutheran University, where he helped lead both the Bulldog men's and women's teams to national prominence. After taking over Lutheran's men's squad in September 1996, the team made three consecutive appearances in the NAIA national tournament, where the Bulldogs finished seventh in 1997, fourth in 1998 and sixth in 1999. Texas Lutheran's women's golf team began play on the varsity level in 1997-98, and under Rees' guidance, finished ninth overall in the NAIA's national championship tournament in its first season before finishing second in 1999.

Prior to his stint at Texas Lutheran, Rees spent one year as the associate head coach of Scottsdale (Ariz.) CC, where his men's squad was ranked No. 1 in the nation.

Rees gained Division I experience as an assistant coach at Louisiana State University (1993-94) and as the assistant men's and women's golf coach at Arizona State University (1994-95).

The Lady Sun Devils claimed the 1995 national championship. Along with his coaching duties at Arizona State, Rees was the teams' recruiting and fund-raising coordinator. Rees' first head coaching job came at his alma mater, Emporia (Kan.) State University, at the age of 21. During his four-year run as Emporia State's head coach, Rees developed an NAIA and NCAA Division II top-10 program and was named the district's Coach of the Year four straight years from 1990-93.

Stuart Powell finished his second season as an volunteer assistant coach for the UT Arlington golf team in the 2007-08.

Powell assists in practice, player developments and day-to-day operations of the Mavericks golf team. He also served as assistant tournament director for the 2007 UTA Fall Classic.

Powell served 26 years in the United States Army with tours in Viet Nam, Germany and various installations in the United States. He served as a professor of military science at UT Arlington where he retired from the military. During his time in the military, Powell achieved the rank of colonel. He stayed active in golf as a competitor. He was club champion at the Fort Eustis Golf Club.

Powell played on the Eagl mini tour for two seasons. He received his golf teaching certification and began teaching following the closure of the Eagl tour. He has been active as a professional golf instructor for the past 15 years.

Powell and his wife, Marsha, have two daughters (Kara and Brittany) and a son, Brandon. Kara Puckett and her husband, Kevin, have two children and live in the Mesquite area. Brittany Powell has one son, and lives in Burbank, Calif., pursuing an acting career. Brandon Powell lives in Mansfield and is studying to become a veterinary technician.

2008-09: Appeared in 9 tournaments, playing 26 rounds...registered a stroke average of 74.54...best finish was 2nd at the Ft. Worth JV Fall Invite...played well at the end of the season as he posted a T12 finish at the Mizzou Intercollegiate and a T14 at the Southland Conference Championship...in the fall posted a 2-under score of 214 at the Turtle Bay Invitational which was good for a tie for 25th.

2007-08: Joined the Mavericks program at the semester break, transferring from UNLV...turned in the single-most impressive performance by a Maverick during the at the Diet Pepsi/Shocker Classic...in his fourth tournament at UT Arlington, he competed as a medalist and was the individual championship by shooting a 67-68-71=226...At the Southland Conference Championships a week later, Carrigan finished in a tie for 14th...had 2 top 10 finishes and 4 top 20 finishes in 6 tournaments...74.47 stroke average was fourth on the team.

PRIOR TO UTA: Attended Midland College in Midland, Texas, for two years...had stroke averages of 72.9 his freshman year and 72.1 his sophomore season...the team won the 2006 National Junior College Athletic Association national championship and he recorded three individual titles that year...he tied for third at the national tournament with a 16-under 272 over the 72-hole event...his first three rounds were in the 60s...as a sophomore at Midland, the team won the regional championship and he won two individual titles.

HIGH SCHOOL: A 2004 graduate of Lambrick Park Secondary school in Victoria, B.C., Canada...lettered on varsity four years...had a stroke average of 73.8...his team won the provincial high school championship...also played on the provincial high school soccer championship team...played three years of soccer and rugby.

PERSONAL: James Kevin Carrigan was born June 19, 1986, in Victoria, B.C., Canada...the son of Perry and Laurel Carrigan...has a sister, Brette Carrigan (24)...majoring in marketing.

2008-09: Honorable mention all-Southland Conference selection...played in 9 tournaments this season recording a 74.00 stroke average in 27 rounds...had 3 top 10 finishes including 8th at the Saint Mary's Invitational, a tie for 11th at Southland Conference Championship and a tie for 17th at the Oak Hills Invitational...season-low round of 69 set three times...finished even par at the Saint Mary's Invitational at Poppy Hills in Pebble Beach, Calif. and was one-over at the Turtle Bay Invitational.

2007-08: Competed in nine of the team's 12 tournaments and finish fifth among the Mavericks in stroke average with a 74.54...Established himself quickly as a factor on the 2007-08 team by finishing tied for third in the team's second tournament, the Texas Cup. In that event, he shot a 75-68=143...Had his best tournament of the season in UTA's record-breaking performance at the Turtle Bay Invitational in Hawaii, shooting 74-67-69=210. It was one of only three times in the 2007-08 season when a Mavericks golfer shot back-to-back sub-70 rounds.

SUMMER 2007: Took third at the Zulu Open (73-73=146) and competed at the KZN Championship (70-77-68-72=287).

2006-07: Ranked fourth on the team with a 74.54 stroke average...he and Zack Reeves were only members of squad to play in all 10 tournaments...led squad with 31 rounds played...low round of 67 at Wolf Pack Classic ties for ninth lowest in UT Arlington history...improved play during spring, averaging 74.14 for five tournaments...posted three top-20 finishes, including tying for seventh at the Callaway Golf Invitational...finished tied for 35th at SLC Championship (78-77-76-231).

PRIOR TO UTA: Attended Westville Boys' High School...captained three South African under-18 teams...represented his province (Kwa-Zulu Natal) at under-16, under-18 and under-23 and senior level...won three tournaments and was runner-up in two others in 2005...fired a course record 64 at the Durban Country Club's Beachwood Course as well as a new tournament record in winning the KZN Invitational (132).

2008-09: Second team All-Southland Conference selection...played in all 10 tournaments this season and registered a 73.11 stroke average in 28 rounds...stroke average is second best on the team...tied for medalist honors at the Southland Conference Championship after recording scores of 67-68-77=212...the first round 67 was a career-low...part of a three-man playoff and was eliminated on the first hole after registering a bogey...had 3 top 10 finishes which also included a tie for 3rd at the Oak Hills Invitational and a tie for 9th at the Mizzou Intercollegiate...finished 3 tournaments under par - Turtle Bay Invitational (-3), Oak Hills (-3) and SLC (-4)...finished in the top 20 in 6 of the 8 tournaments he finished.

2007-08: Made an immediate impact on the Mavericks, finishing as the top UTA player in first tournament, the Saint Mary's Invitational...finished his first season with a 74.62 stroke average, good enough for sixth among UT Arlington golfers who competed in at least 6 tournaments...participated in the 2008 Southland Conference Championships and finished tied for 37th...had 3 top 20 finishes.

PRIOR TO UTA: A two-time Class 4A all-state golfer at THS...recorded 6 tournament victories his senior season at THS...averaged a school record 70.14 strokes per round in 2007...tied for 10th at the Class 4A UIL State Tournament (69-72=141)...tied for 10th at state as a sophomore in 2005 with a 74-72-146...a three-time all-Region II and all-District 11-4A golfer between 2005-07...2005 regional champion...four-time all-district between 2004-07...won 20 tournament between high school and summer tour events during his prep career...named to the National Honor Society and graduated cum laude at THS.

6-1 • Jr. • Irving, Texas • Irving HS

2008-09: First team All-Southland Conference selection...UTA's leading player with a stroke average of 71.97 in 30 rounds (10 tournaments)...the 71.97 is on pace to set a school record breaking the current mark of 72.6 held by Adam Babb (72.685 in 2000) and Tyrone Mordt (72.694 in 2003)...set a school record with a 10-under par 62 in the final round of the Turtle Bay Invitational...finished Rio Pinar Invitational at 10-under as well...medalist at the Border Olympics with a 5-under score of 211 for his second career victory...has one win, 3 second place and five top 10 finishes...13 of his 30 rounds have been 71 or better...

RECORD SETTING ROUND OF 62: Shot a school-record 62 in the final round of the Turtle Bay Invitational to lead UTA to a third place finish at the 19-team tournament...opened the tournament with a two-under par 70 and then shot a second round 74...he then went out in the final round to shoot his record-setting 10-under par round...10-under 206 placed him second in the tournament by one shot behind Ohio State's Vaughn Snyder...the 62 broke the previous school record of 63 shot by Shad Muth at the UTSA Invitational in 2001...the 206 tied for the fourth-lowest 54-hole tournament score in school history...His round helped the Mavericks post a final round score of 271 which was the second-lowest in UTA history.

2007-08: Emerged as the Mavericks most consistent golfer...finished with the team's best stroke average of 73.08, which ranks as the fifth-best single-season stroke average in the program's history...four top 10 finishes and was team's top golfer in 4 tournaments, including the 2 biggest tournaments of the year - the Southland Conference Championships and the NCAA Central Regionals....turned in his best performance of the year with a 64-71-68=203 at the Turtle Bay Intercollegiate.

SUMMER 2007: Advanced deep into the Cotton States Invitational before losing to Russell Helson of Texas, 2&1, in the second round of match play... competed at the Texas State Amateur where he tied for 19th with a four-round total of 294 (74-72-72-76)... shot 72-72 at the U.S. Amateur qualifier.

2006-07: Named honorable mention all-Southland Conference... became first Maverick freshman to win a tournament in more than decade with the medalist award at the Diet Pepsi/Shocker Classic (72-72-75=219)... ranked third on the team with a 74.68 strokes per game... tied for 12th at the Border Olympics (71-72-71=214)... Worked way into starting line up during the 2006-07 season, playing in six tournaments, including every spring tournament... averaged 74.20 during five spring events... shot par-or-better in six of his final nine rounds during the spring... best round of the season was 71 at both the Border Olympics and the SLC Championship.

PRIOR TO UTA: A four-year letterwinner at Irving High... won 12 tournaments during his four-year career, including four his senior season... was District 7-5A champion his sophomore season and runner-up his freshman and senior seasons... tallied a 70-69=139 at the Dallas Morning News Junior City Championship in 2002... also was the Northern Texas Junior PGA Champion in 2002, and the runner-up in 2003...Region I-5A qualifier all four years... named outstanding male athlete at Irving HS his sophomore through senior years... nominated by the American Junior Golf Association for the Hewlett Packard Scholastic Junior All-American Team in 2005... was an honor student all four years and the National Honor Society his senior year at Irving HS.

PERSONAL: Born Feb. 9, 1988, in Dallas, Texas...son of Joe and Mardi Massa...his father, Joe, was a baseball and golf letterwinner at UT Arlington...majoring in physical education.

2008-09: Third team All-Southland Conference selection...appeared in all 10 tournaments and posted a 73.73 stroke average in 30 rounds...won the UTA/Waterchase Invitational in the fall with an 11-under score of 205...shot a season-low 67 3 times including each of the last 2 rounds of that tournament...posted 5 rounds in the 60s...had 4 top 20 finishes...tied for 25th at the Southland Conference Tournament.

2007-08: Named to the Southland Conference All-Academic Team...finished third on the team with a 73.74 stroke average...turned in his highest finish with a 2nd place tie at the UT Arlington Fall Classic, firing a 68-70-74=212... shot 15 rounds of 71 or better during the Fall and Spring seasons...his 19th-place finish at the Louisiana Tech/Squire Creek Invitational was a team-best...finished in a tie for 9th at the Diet Pepsi Shocker Classic with a score of 71-71-74=216.

SUMMER 2007: Claimed second place at the Lowveld Open (71-68=139) and seventh place at the Limpopo Open (74-72-70-76=292)... competed at the Scratch Players Am (77-68-70=215).

2006-07: Named honorable mention All-Southland Conference... improved play dramatically during the season... played in seven tournaments, including all five spring events... led the team with a 73.33 stroke average during the spring with two top-20 finishes... averaged 77.30 in two events in the fall season... competed in his very first collegiate tournament the first tournament of the year with a 56th-place finish at the Scenic City Invitational... ended year with tie for sixth-place at the Diet Pepsi/Shocker Classic (72-72-78=222) and tie for 11th at the SLC Championship (74-74-70=218).
