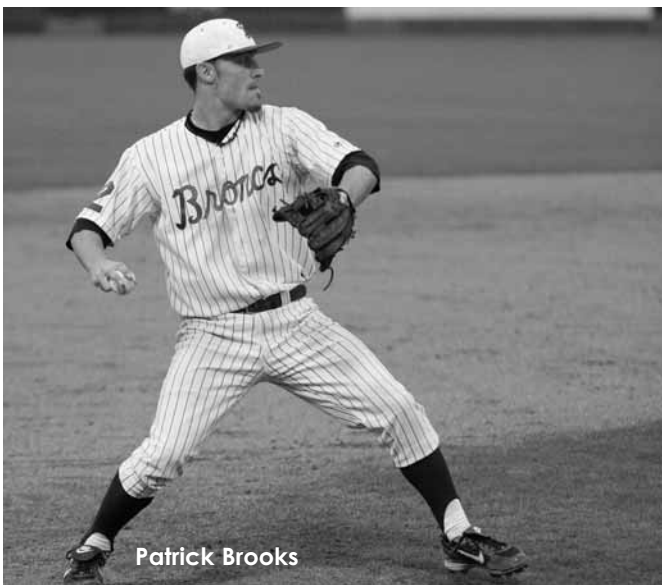

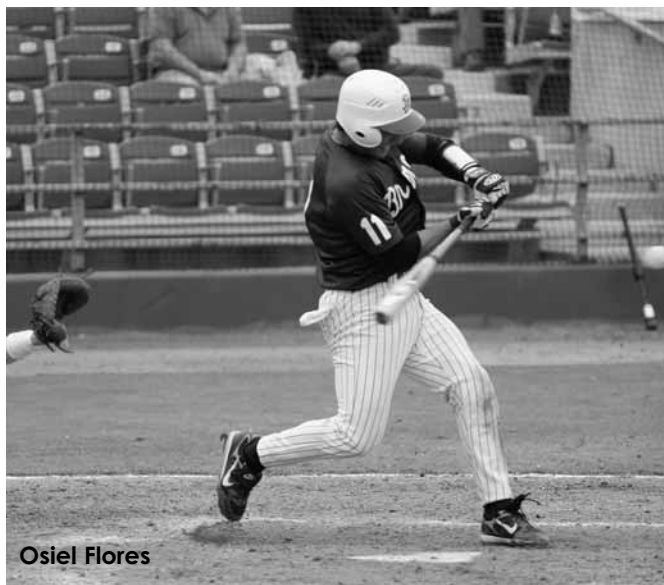

2006 SEASON REVIEW

Two Bronc Hurlers Selected in MLB Amateur Draft

Bobby Gomez and Tim Haines were each selected on Day Two of the 2006 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft that was held this past June.

Gomez was selected in the 24th round (736th overall) by the St. Louis Cardinals. The UTPA left-handed hurler sat out the 2006 season, but made 15 appearances during the 2005 season where he recorded a 1-3 record with a 9.67 earned run average.

Haines was selected in the 27th round (814th overall) by the New York Mets after breaking both the UTPA career and single-season saves record. A first team All-Independent selection, he collected his 10th save of the season against The University of Texas at San Antonio on May 16th. In his two seasons with the Broncs, Haines broke the single-season appearances record in both years, appearing 30 times as a freshman and 31 times during his sophomore campaign.

The Broncs' sophomore finished the 2006 season with a 4-5 record to go along with a 2.06 earned run average in 35.0 innings of action. He also struck out 52 hitters while opponents batted .184 against him this past season. The UTPA closer became the first player to be selected by the Mets since Mike Cox was drafted in the 18th round in the 2000 MLB Amateur Draft.

The pair of Gomez and Haines became the 62nd and 63rd players in UTPA program history to be selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Mason Signs Free Agent Deal with Cincinnati Reds

A day after the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, senior Dane Mason signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Reds.

An honorable mention All-Independent selection in 2006, Mason was the ace of the staff this past season as he posted a 7-5 record with a 5.24 earned run average. The



right-hander hurler was third on the team with 61 strikeouts in 89.1 innings of action. Mason posted a streak of four consecutive starts in which he allowed one earned run or less against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Oregon State, Birmingham-Southern and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi this past season.

Last season, Mason appeared in only six games before sitting out the remainder of the season due to an injury, but collected a 1-4 record with a 3.48 earned run average. His best game of the season came against 10th-ranked Arizona at the Edinburg Baseball Stadium where he threw eight shutout innings en route to the victory.

Mason was the second Bronc in the last two seasons to sign a professional contract with the Cincinnati Reds as Mark Rodriguez was drafted by the organization in the 30th round of the 2005 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Casares and Guerra Join Independent Edinburg Coyotes

UTPA senior hurlers Kelly Casares and Aaron Guerra each signed professional contracts with the Edinburg Coyotes of the United Baseball League.

Casares was one of the top pitchers for the Broncs during the 2006 season where he accumulated a 1-1 record with one save and a 4.19 earned run average. In 24 appearances during his senior campaign, the Broncs' right-hander struck out 39 hitters in 38.1 innings of action while surrendering 18 walks. In his two seasons as part of the UTPA baseball program, Casares posted a 2-5 record in 85.1 innings on the mound where he struck out 71 hitters while allowing 42 walks.

A product of Edinburg High School, Guerra led the Broncs with five victories during the 2005 season while throwing 89 innings, which were the most among UTPA pitchers. He also led the Broncs with 69 strikeouts while surrendering only 18 walks. In his career with UTPA, Guerra has produced victories over Dallas Baptist and Sam Houston State while



tossing a one-hitter during his freshman season against Incarnate Word.

Alamia Concludes Stellar Career with Broncs

At the conclusion of the 2006 season, the UTPA diamondmen said goodbye to one of the great players in program history in Rio Grande Valley product Louie Alamia.

A fixture in the lineup for the Broncs for the past four years, Alamia left his mark and name throughout the UTPA career record books. The UTPA standout set the program's all-time records in at-bats (762), hits (267), total bases (347) and triples (13), second in doubles (40), third in runs scored (149), fifth in RBI (100), batting average (.352) and games played (198) and seventh in base on balls (97).

In the single-season record books, Alamia ranked fifth in triples (5/2004), eighth in hits (72/2005) and ninth in batting average (.382/2003). The former Bronc outfielder was selected as a first team Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball following the 2003 campaign and was a four-time All-Independent selection where he earned first team honors during the 2005 season.

During his collegiate career, Alamia holds three of the top four hitting streak marks in program history at 24 games and 22 games on two occasions. The former UTPA standout also set a program record by reaching base safely in 58 straight games.

Haines Receives Several Awards Following 2006 Season

Following the conclusion of the 2006 season, UTPA sophomore Tim Haines was cited as the lone Bronc representative on the All-South Central Regional Second Team as well as a first team All-Independent selection.

In two seasons with the Broncs, Haines broke the single-season appearances record in both campaigns, appearing 30 times as a freshman and 31 times during his sophomore season. The UTPA right-hander recorded a 4-5 record in his final season with the Broncs, posting victories against Northern Colorado, Sam Houston State, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Stephen F. Austin.

The UTPA closer became the first player selected to the All-South Central Regional squad since Jesse Gutierrez and Leo Salinas earned the honor during the 2000 season.

Four Bronc Baseball Players

Four Bronc Baseball Players Garner All-Independent Honors

Tim Haines, Louie Alamia, Dane Mason and Ricky Ibarz all represented the UTPA diamondmen on the 2006 All-Independent selections.

Haines was the only Bronc to earn first team honors and was joined on the All-Independent squad by second team selection Louie Alamia as well as Dane Mason and Ricky Ibarz who were both honorable mention selections.

Haines led all Independent pitchers with 10 saves, a program record for saves in a season, and finished the season with a 2.06 earned run average.

Alamia completed his senior season with a .351 batting average, 68 hits, 32 runs scored and 25 runs batted in. During the season, he broke the UTPA record for consecutive games with a base-hit, hitting safely in 23-straight games. He also recorded five stolen bases, 11 doubles and three triples. Alamia closed out his career as the all-time leader in hits, triples and at-bats.

Mason led the Broncs in wins during the 2006 season with a 7-5 record and a 5.24 earned run average. The senior righty was third on the team with 61 strikeouts in 89 and 1/3 innings pitched. He had a streak of four-straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less in starts against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (twice), Oregon State and Birmingham-Southern.

Ibarz started 16 games for the Broncs where the left-hander struck out 100 batters, good for ninth-most in a season by a UTPA pitcher. His average of 10.8 strikeouts per nine innings was ranked 20th among all NCAA Division I pitchers. Ibarz had the third-lowest earned run average at 4.75 and held opposing hitters to a .259 batting average.

Powers Selected to Academic All-Independent Squad

Senior Otis Powers represented the Bronc baseball program on the 2006 NCAA Division I Academic All-Independent squad.

Powers recorded a 3.409 grade point average in kinesiology and was a recipient of the Lou Hassel



Award for the UTPA male student-athlete who has achieved the highest grade point average. In his final season with the Broncs, Powers has posted a .205 batting average with nine hits, seven runs scored and a double in 28 games.

Mason Earns Independent Co-Pitcher of the Week Laurels

Dane Mason was named the Independent Co-Pitcher of the Week on April 17th along with Michael Potter from UC-Davis.

Mason earned the weekly honor for his performance against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi where the UTPA senior threw a complete-game shutout, scattering seven hits over 9.0 innings and walking none. He struck out 11 Islander batters and faced only 32 hitters, just five over the minimum, allowing only one base-runner beyond first base. He improved his record to 6-3 on the season and lowered his earned run average to 4.71.

Alamia Receives Independent Player of the Week Honors

Louie Alamia was named the Division I Independent Player of the Week on March 28th for his performance in four games against Texas State and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi

Alamia began the week by going 6-for-8 with a pair of doubles in two Bronc victories at Texas State, driving in three runs and scoring three. Days later, he went 4-for-10 in two games against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi with another double and two runs scored.



Ibarz Cited as Independent Pitcher of the Week

UTPA junior Ricky Ibarz earned Independent Pitcher of the Week honors for his efforts against Prairie View A&M and Arkansas-Little Rock.

The Bronc left-hander started two games this past week and worked 14 innings, scattering seven hits without allowing a single run. Ibarz pitched seven innings against Prairie View A&M

to earn the win while striking out 10 Panther hitters. Four days later, he threw seven innings against Arkansas-Little Rock, struck out 10 batters and did not factor in to the decision.

Valley Product Makes Most of Rookie Campaign

A product of McAllen Memorial High School, Abraham Garcia made the most of his first season with the Broncs as the UTPA newcomer ranked second on the team with a .303 batting average. Garcia recorded 33 hits in 109 at-bats to go along with nine doubles, three triples and one home run while playing 17 runs and driving in 22 runs.

The Bronc utility player finished with a .468 slugging percentage and .403 on-base percentage while finishing with a .920 fielding percentage at second base. Garcia had six multi-hit performances in 42 games with the Broncs and delivered his first collegiate home run against the University of Texas, who was ranked in the top-10 in the nation at the time.

Broncs Take Eventual National Champions to Extra Innings

In the first game of a doubleheader with Oregon State, who would capture the 2006 NCAA Division I National Championship on the diamond, the Broncs gave the Beavers everything that they could handle.

After playing the first three innings of the game on Friday, the Broncs and Beavers had to postpone the remainder of the contest due to rain. The continuation of the game was held on Saturday where UTPA held a 3-1 lead, but were unable to hold off the powerful Beavers as they dropped a 5-4 decision in 10 innings.

Mason threw the first 6.0 innings of the game and allowed just three hits and one earned run while striking out two Oregon State hitters. Haines suffered the loss as he allowed three runs in the final 1.2 innings of action.

Patrick Brooks led the Broncs with a 2-for-4 performance with a RBI double in the first inning while Garcia collected two RBI in the game while going 1-for-3 from the plate.
