PROUD TRADITION

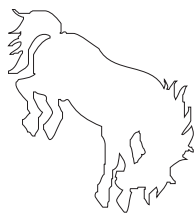
- The Broncos captured their first-ever NAIA National Championship in 1963 after defeating Western Carolina by a score of 73-62.



- UTPA earned a berth in the National Invitation Tournament during the 1980-81 season following an 18-10 campaign against some of the best schools in the nation. The Broncos dropped their first round game to the University of Tulsa, 81-71.
- In their history, the Broncos have had 18 players get drafted by the NBA, including Luke Jackson and Otto Moore who were each top-10 draft picks. Jackson went fourth overall to the Philadelphia 76ers while Moore went sixth overall to the Detroit Pistons.
- Luke Jackson was a NBA All-Star performer in 1965 and was voted to the NBA All-Rookie Team that season. The former Bronc also represented the United States at the 1964 Olympics where Team USA won a gold medal.
- The Broncos have had two players led the nation in scoring in Marshall Rogers (36.8 points per game in 1975-76) and Greg Guy (29.3 points per game in 1992-93).



- UTPA has had 21 players earn All-Americans - both academically and athletically - during their careers donning the Green and Orange.



- Legendary coaches Sam Williams, Abe Lemons and Lon Kruger all walked the sidelines for the Broncos during their career.



- In their history, the Broncos have had 20 players score over 1,000 points during their career with Otto Moore leading the way with 1,880 career points.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- The UTPA Fieldhouse is one of the most difficult places to play among all of the NCAA Division I Independent venues. The Broncos are 46-20 over the last five seasons, and have won 10 or more home games in three of those campaigns.

TOM SCHUBERTH

- Schuberth begins his first season with the UTPA men's basketball program after serving the previous 24 seasons as an assistant coach at some of the best basketball programs - Central Florida, Memphis, University of Alabama-Birmingham, Southeast Missouri State, South Alabama and University of Louisiana-Monroe
- Schuberth's resume as a collegiate coach includes 11 NCAA Tournaments, two Sweet Sixteen appearances as well as a trip to both the Elite Eight and Final Four.
- Schuberth has been a part of 12 different 20-win programs and has coached 14 conference championship squads in five separate NCAA Division I Conferences.



INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT

- Coach Schuberth and his coaching staff work with each athlete on an individual basis to develop and improve all of his basketball skills in every aspect.

- The UTPA Department of Intercollegiate Athletics has a strong commitment to ensuring that all student-athletes receive the full benefits of the educational experience while assuring that participation in NCAA Division I varsity athletics enhances, rather than detracts from, the realization of earning a UTPA diploma.
