· UTPA will face Utah Valley State College on Saturday (Jan. 28) at the McKay Center in Orem, UT, with a 10:00 p.m. central time tip-off.

· Fans of the Green and Orange can hear the game live via the airwaves with the new voice of the Broncs - Alex del Barrio. The game will be aired on ESPN Radio 1240 AM.

· This will be the third meeting between the two programs with the Wolverines holding a 2-0 lead in the all-time series records.

### In Their Last Meeting

· In their last meeting, Utah Valley State came away with a 75-71 victory over the Broncs at the UTPA Fieldhouse on Feb. 21, 2005.

· Independent Offensive Player of the Year Ronnie Price finished with a game-high 29 points on 11-24 shooting to go along with five rebounds, four assists and two steals in 38 minutes of action.

· The Broncs had four players reach double figures in the game - Chris Fagan (15), Eric Montalvo (14), Derrick East (12) and Sergio Sanchez (11).

· Fagan nearly missed a double-double (points-rebounds) with 15 points and seven rebounds. The same held true to Montalvo and East who both finished two rebounds shy of recording double digits in the rebounding category.

· The Wolverines finished the game shooting 88.9 percent (16-19) from the free throw line while the Broncs had over 20 more attempts from the charity stripe, they would only connect on 68.4 percent (26-38) of them.

· In the second half, Utah Valley State was a perfect 15-15 from the charity stripe compared to 73.1 percent (19-26) for the Broncs.

· The Broncs held the advantage over the Wolverines in rebounding (35-27) and steals (4-3) while Utah Valley State held a 13-8 edge in assists.

· It was the last home game of the season for the Broncs.

### In Their Last Game

- The Broncs dropped an 84-54 decision to Conference USA-foe Southern Methodist University at the UTPA Fieldhouse on Tuesday (Jan. 24) and dropped their record to 5-15 on the season.
- The Mustangs' 84 points were the most points scored by an opponent at the UTPA Fieldhouse this season - surpassing 81 points set by the Air Force Academy on Dec. 3, 2005.
- Dez Willingham and Derrick Roberts finished with a team-high 14 points in the game. Willingham also added five rebounds, three assists and one steal while Roberts collected six rebounds, five assists and one blocked shot in the contest.
- Devon Pearson collected a double-double (points-rebounds) for the Mustangs finishing with a 12-point, 14-rebound performance.
- **Larry Sheppard** finished with a game-high 18 points while collecting a career-high six steals, four assists and two rebounds in 35 minutes.
- The Broncs were playing without two of their top five scorers in **Dexter Shankle** and **Derrick East**. Both sat out due to injury.
- The Mustangs won by 30 points, which was the biggest defeat for the Broncs at the UTPA Fieldhouse since the University of Tulsa defeated UTPA by an 80-50 margin on Nov. 24, 2002.
- SMU finished the game shooting 63.8 percent (30-47) against the Broncs, including a 70.8 percent (17-24) showing in the first half. In the first 20 minutes of the game, the Mustangs only missed two shots (16-18) from inside the three-point line.
- Sophomore **Danny Puente** scored a career-high 11 points in the game, including a career-high three three-pointers.
- **Cori Gaither** finished with a career-high 10 points to go along with two rebounds, two steals and two assists in a season-high 36 minutes.
- The Mustangs held the Broncs to a season-low 20 rebounds in the contest while grabbing 44 caroms - 37 defensive and seven offensive.
- SMU improved its all-time series lead over UTPA to 4-1.

## Bronc Bytes - News And Notes

- **Larry Sheppard** is the only Bronc to start in all 20 games this season.
  - In the last five games, Sheppard has recorded 36 assists and has only committed nine turnovers. He has posted an assist-to-turnover ratio of 4:1. During that span, he is also averaging 10.8 points per game.
- **Dexter Shankle** has already surpassed all of his statistical marks from his rookie campaign as he is currently leading the team, averaging 11.0 points per game compared to 2.1 points per game last season. He has scored in double figures in 12 of 19 games this season and missed his first game against SMU due to injury.
  - Shankle leads the squad with 12 double-digit scoring performances followed by **Colin Lien** (eight), **Kano Edwards** (seven), **Derrick East** (six) **Johnathan Chatman** (six) and Sheppard (five).
  - Lien is second on the team in scoring, averaging 9.3 points per game and leads the team in shooting at 42.9 percent. He is one of three players on the squad that is shooting above 40 percent this season.
  - **Zach Trader** is currently averaging 6.9 points and 3.5 rebounds per game, which have both doubled his numbers from his freshman campaign where he averaged 3.1 points and 2.1 rebounds per game.
  - Trader has been consistent in the scoring department over the last three games as he is averaging 8.0 points per game against Texas State (9), IPFW (8) and SMU (7).
  - The Broncs are 0-9 when they fail to score 60 or more points in a game while opponents have produced a 10-1 mark when scoring 70 or more points in a game this season.
  - The Broncs are 0-7 when they allow opponents to shoot 50.0 percent or higher with two of those games coming at the UTPA Fieldhouse - SMU and Air Force Academy.
  - **Kano Edwards** has recorded a double-digit scoring performance in three of the last five games, including a pair of 20-plus point showings. During the last five games, Edwards is averaging 13.4 points per game.
  - The Broncs are 0-7 when opponents shoot 50 percent or higher in a game with two of those games coming at the UTPA Fieldhouse - SMU and Air Force.
  - In the last three games, **Cori Gaither** has started to find his shooting touch as he is averaging 8.0 points per game and shooting 69.2 percent from the field. The Broncs' sophomore recorded his first double-digit game of the season against SMU, notching 10 points.
  - Sophomore **Danny Puente** scored a career-high 11 points against against SMU, which surpassed his last three games combined.
  - **Alex Robinson** is the only freshman to appear in all 20 games this season - making nine starts at the small forward position.

## Scouting the Opponent - Utah Valley State College

· Utah Valley State College enters the contest with an 8-11 record under fourth-year head coach Dick Hunsaker.

· The Wolverines have been almost unbeatable at the McKay Center this season, recording a 7-1 record at home. Utah Valley State's only home loss this season came at an 82-69 decision to High Point.

· The Wolverines are averaging 73.0 points per game at the McKay Center compared to 60.5 points per game on the road.

· Senior Ben DeVoe is the team's leading scorer, averaging 11.2 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. He has led the team in scoring on five occasions and rebounding eight times.

· DeVoe is shooting nearly 62.0 percent from the floor this season, converting on 93-151 - good for a 61.6 shooting percentage.

· Freshman Matt Peterson has been the only Wolverine to start in all 19 games this season. The UVSC newcomer is second on the team in scoring, posting 10.5 points per game.

· Utah Valley State is ranked third among all Independent schools in shooting percentage, converting on 44.4 percent of its attempts. The only two schools above the Wolverines are Texas A&M - Corpus Christi (50.7 percent) and North Dakota State (46.1 percent).

· The Wolverines are ranked second among all Independent programs in free throw shooting percentage, connecting on 71.0 percent of their attempts. North Dakota State leads the Independent schools in that category by converting on 74.5 percent.

· The Wolverines only have one player who has recorded 10 or more blocks this season in Ben DeVoe (19). As a team, Utah Valley State has swatted 43 shots compared to 61 by opponents.

· Utah Valley State is only shooting 29.9 percent from behind the three-point arc, converting on 91 of 304 attempts. Peterson and David Heck both have connected on a team-high 26 treys this season.

· The Wolverines have eight players on the squad who are shooting 70.0 percent or higher from the charity stripe.

· Along with DeVoe, Chris Bailey and Tika Wesley are both shooting higher than 50.0 percent this season. Bailey has connected on 52.3 percent (46-88) of his shots while Wesley has converted on 51.4 percent (36-70) of his total attempts.

· The Wolverines have six players that are averaging 20.0 or more minutes per contest. Peterson leads the team at 31.3 minutes per contest.

· Earlier this season, Utah Valley State recorded one of its biggest wins in program history with a 75-71 victory over Arizona State University.

· The Wolverines have been out-rebounded 643 to 588 this season.
