**Meet the Bronc Coaching Staff...**



**Head Coach, Angela Hubbard (2<sup>nd</sup> Season)**

Angela Hubbard is entering her second season as Head Volleyball Coach at the University of Texas Pan American. Hubbard is the youngest NCAA Div. 1 head coach at 26.

In her first season with the Lady Broncs, Hubbard guided her team to a 15-17 finish, improving 9 games from the previous season. During this time Hubbard's 2007 team was able to beat Southland Conference foes Texas A&M Corpus Christi and the University of Texas San Antonio. The meeting between UTPA and UTSA was the first ever to be won by UTPA in 28 tries. The Lady Broncs were also able to beat Air Force, a member of the Mountain West Conference, for the first time. During their four match sweep at the Prairie View A&M Tournament, Junior Chelsea Blakely became the all-time career assist leader. This record had previously been held for 11 years. Freshman middle blocker Danielle Reed became only the third player in UTPA history to record 10 or more blocks in a single match, and junior Kellie Phillips hit the 1000<sup>th</sup> kill mark listing her as only the 5<sup>th</sup> player to reach this milestone. Hubbard had three players awarded Player of the Week as well as four All-Independent team selections. Hubbard also saw impressive stats in the classroom. Having five players awarded All-Independent Academic team honors and three of the Lady Broncs receiving a perfect 4.0.

Before coming to the Rio Grand Valley, Hubbard served as the assistant at Nicholls State University, where during her one season with the Colonels, they improved their record by eight wins. Hubbard was instrumental in outside hitter, Atina Porter's success, as she was cited as a Second Team All-Southland Conference selection and was named to three all-tournament teams to go along with Southland Conference Player of the Week.

Prior to joining the coaching staff at Nicholls State, Hubbard served as the assistant coach at the University of Tennessee Martin with former collegiate

coach Amy Draper. Hubbard followed her former collegiate coach from her alma mater, the University of West Georgia, where she was a Graduate Assistant for one season. While at West Georgia Hubbard was the defensive coordinator, guiding the Wolves to their first conference tournament appearance in 16 years.

Hubbard played collegiate volleyball at West Georgia, where she was the program's starting outside hitter during the 2002 campaign before an injury forced her to switch to the libero position in 2003. Hubbard concluded her career listed as eighth on the all time list with 663 career digs. She also holds the record for most digs in a three game match (33). Hubbard played two collegiate seasons at Cedar Valley College where she concluded her sophomore campaign ranked first nationally among all NJCAA players in hitting percentage and fifteenth in kills. She garnered All-American, All-Region, and All-Conference honors during her sophomore campaign as well as a fourth place finish at Nationals. Hubbard also received All-Conference her freshman season where she led the Lady Suns to the Championship match at the NJCAA National Tournament.

Hubbard earned her bachelor degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from the University of West Georgia in 2004. She earned her master's degree of science in education with an emphasis in health and human performances from the University of Tennessee-Martin in 2006.

Hubbard and her husband, Thomas, currently reside in Edinburg with newest addition Kayden who arrived in November



**Assistant Coach/ Recruiting Coordinator, Leah Johnson (2<sup>nd</sup> Season)**

Johnson is going into her second season with the Broncs as Assistant Coach, where she also serves as Recruiting Coordinator. Johnson played her collegiate career at Missouri State, an NCAA Div 1 member of the Missouri Valley Conference, where Johnson was a libero for the Bears. Johnson received her undergraduate degree from Missouri State in 2004 and then received her Masters degree from Missouri State in 2006. She also started a volleyball club in the area, Club 417 and served as Club Owner/Director until moving to the Rio Grande Valley.
